



Onion Fundamentals:


- According to trade sources, export demand has decreased because of unavailability of good quality of onion. On an average 25% of total good quality onion arriving in Pimpalgaon market is exported to countries like Indonesia and Srilanka.
- Approximately, 80% area is expected to be covered under kharif onion in Rajasthan through seedling and bulblets in comparison to last year i.e. around 17000 ha.
- According to trade sources, arrivals have declined all across the market in the country and prices
 have fallen down in all the wholesale market but it has not impacted the retail market which is stable
 from last few weeks, which shows strengthen in market.
- In Nasik, market was closed because of strike of labours as discussion between onion traders and labours (those who weigh the commodity) over using electronic weighing machine for onions which is not favoured by the labours union.
