



Onion Fundamentals:


- In Lasalgaon and Pimplagaon markets of Maharashtra, there is strike for indefinite period due to dispute between mapari (official grain measurers) and traders over weighing charges and putting receipt numbers on onion bags. This would affect the auction process.
- In Bangalore, approximately 70% of total arrival is fresh onion. Around 70% harvesting of early crop completed in Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh.
- According to NHRDF, about 53% area in Haryana (2000 ha) and 44% area in Bihar (1200 ha) is expected to be covered under kharif onion as compared to previous year, whereas in Uttar Pradesh around 80% area under kharif onion (3000 ha) expected to be covered.
- In Nasik (Maharashtra), farmers are facing inconvenience while bring their produce to markets as of ongoing differences between Mapari and traders.
