



#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Hyderabad, onion is arriving from Kurnool (Local region) and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 85% and 15%. According to trade sources, demand of fresh onion comes from Kolkata side and fresh onion is able to fetch high prices.
- In Lasalgaon, arrivals are stable ranging between 7000-8500 quintals per day but prices are continuously rising and reached up to Rs 675/ quintal from Rs 525/ quintal in last 4-5 days.
- According to trade sources in Bangalore, onion is arriving in market from local region only in which approximately 80% of onion is fresh crop and rest 20% is stored onion.
- Across the country prices of onion has started increasing and expected to increase until the arrival of
  next crop which is expected to arrive in the mid November. In wholesale market, maximum prices were
  seen in Gangatok at Rs 1400/ quintal and minimum prices were in Surat at Rs 550/ quintal.
