


Onion Fundamentals:

- Prices have increased across markets in major producing regions as the auspicious festival season is going when consumption decreases to some extent which shows further firmness in market
- In Indore local produced onion is available in market. According to traders usually onion last till Diwali but this year it may go till November last because of higher stock as compared to previous years. Prices are expected to increase ahead.
- In Hyderabad, onion is arriving from Kurnool (Local region) and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 85% and 15%. According to trade sources, demand of fresh onion comes from Kolkata side and fresh onion is able to fetch high prices.
- Across the country, prices were hovering in the range of Rs 1100 to Rs 2000/ quintal. Maximum prices were seen in Dehradun at Rs2000/quintal followed by Gangatok and Ranchi at Rs 1800 and Rs 1600/ quintal.
