


Onion Fundamentals:


- The National Horticultural Research and Development Foundation (NHRDF) is planning to focus on intercrop farming for onion crop in the major onion growing states across the country which are Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh. This will help farmers in growing two crops at a time and is also expected to increase onion yield.
- In Maharashtra region prices of onion has almost doubled in last couple of weeks. According to trade sources, increase in prices is due to unavailability of good quality of onion and delay of kharif crop.
- In Lasalgaon, average modal price were hovering around Rs 925/ quintal whereas quality onion were able to fetch Rs 1100/ quintal. According to trade sources, export demand has improved and mainly coming from Gulf Malaysia and Indonesia.
