


Onion Fundamentals:


- In Delhi, onion is arriving in market from Maharashtra, Gujarat and Rajasthan. The contribution of fresh and stored onion is 80% and 20% respectively to the total arrival.
- In Bangalore, locally produced good quality of onion is available in market and easily able to fetch a price of Rs 1800- 2200 /quintal. Price is high because of premium quality of onion.
- According to news sources, Srilankan government has requested permission to continue import taxation on onions for further 6 months. The import tariff increased from Rs 25 to Rs 50 back in August which has significantly reduced imports and domestic growers are attracting reasonable price for their produce.
- Meanwhile in Indian retail market, prices are hovering in the range of Rs 1500 to Rs 2400/ quintal.
 Maximum prices were seen in Chennai at Rs 2400/ quintal followed by Trivandrum and Bangalore at Rs 2200/ quintal.
