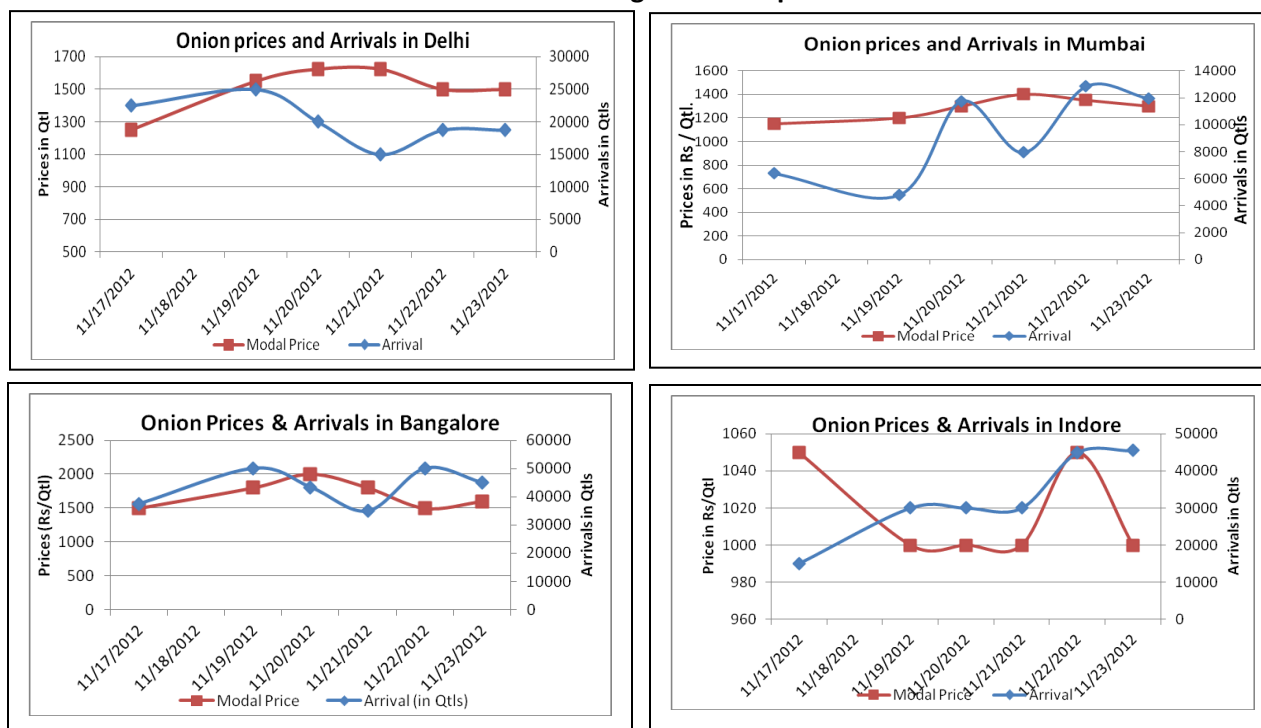


Onion Fundamentals:

- In Belgaum (Karnataka), 95% of onion is from local region only whereas rest 5% of onion arrives in market from Maharashtra region.
- In Belgaum it is expected that pace of arrival of fresh onion in market may decrease after 2-3 weeks which may result into increase in prices.
- In Delhi, onion prices are hovering in the range of Rs 1400 to Rs 1800/ quintal. According to trade sources, approximately 70% of fresh onion is arriving in market and rest 30% is stored onion.
- In Lasalgaon, supply of kharif onion has increased and expected to pick up pace further in a couple of weeks.
