



Potato Fundamentals:


- Off-take has increased from Khandauli region of Agra. Yesterday arrivals increased from 13500 qtls to 20000 qtls. Farmers have increased their sell from cold store as prices have become stable near Rs. 1000/Qtl.
- Traders are optimistic about potato prices and expect further increase in near future due to stable demand and lower supply from West Bengal.
- Major short covering is seen in MCX and NCDEX platform across all contracts. It seems market participants are expecting further price increase.
- Cold store in Hooghly districts of West Bengal have opened only. Other cold store region like Burdwan and New Jalpaiguri will open from 20th May.
- As per trader's information Potato sowing could be delayed in Ooty region of Karnataka due to insufficient rain.
