


Potato Fundamentals:


- Prices of potato in Agra market is still varying between Rs 1000-1060. Traders are expecting that as soon
 as monsoon will arrive prices of green vegetables will be on peak so consumption of potato will
 increase which will give hike in the prices
- As per the trader from Agra, 60% of potato in cold store belongs to farmers and they are expected to sell it in the month of July later on during festive seasons .
- In last few days prices have fallen in Agra market but it has not affected the supply as traders kept releasing their stocks in small quantities and they don't wait for the best prices.
- The retail prices are trading between 1200-2600/Qtl and highest prices of Rs. 2600/Qtl was recorded in Trivendrum and lowest of Rs. 1200 was reported in Bhopal

Potato prices on MCX platform is trading in small range of 1065-1080 and could not able to close above 1080 which is 4-day exponential moving average. If prices could manage to trade above 1080, it is likely that it would reach near 1100 in short term.
