

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Pulses cash market continued to witness weak sentiments on thin trading activity at higher prices on Thursday.
- Chana at future market remained range-bound due to uncertainty among market participants.
- Assocham estimates, 21 million tonnes of pulses demand in 2012-13 and likely to reach at 21.42 million tonnes (MT) in 2013-14 and 21.91 MT in 2014-15.
- At JNPT port, 54 containers of Burma tur, 92 containers of Mozambique tur,36 containers of Malavi tur,25 containers of Burma urad,8 containers of Australia moong, 25 containers of moong,10 containers of Argentina green peas,30 containers of Russia chana, 10 containers of Russia split chana, 5 containers of Ethiopia chana, 2 containers of Burma chana,42 containers of Russia yellow peas arrived on 22 Aug,2012.

Sowing Progress

- Pulses' sowing is in progress and early sown crop is in vegetative stage.
- Meanwhile, farmers are engaged in sowing, hoeing and weeding processes.
- As per Ministry of Agriculture, India, sown area under Kharif pulses as on 16 Aug,2012 is down by 12.06 lakh
 ha. to 85.32 lakh ha. against 97.38 lakh ha. area planted during the corresponding period of last year. Area
 is also down by 11.80 lakh ha. from 97.11 lakh ha., the normal area sown during the corresponding period.
 Following table illustrates the all- India pulses wise area (in lakh ha.):-

- This year less area has been reported in , Chhattisgarh (down by 0.17 lakh ha.), Gujarat (down by 1.29 lakh ha.), Haryana (down by 0.14 lakh ha.), Himachal Pradesh (down by 0.13 lakh ha.), J&K (down by 0.01 lakh ha.), ,Orissa (down by 0.30 lakh ha.), Rajasthan (10.68 lakh ha.), Tamil Nadu (down by 0.03 lakh ha.) and Karnataka (down by 1.87 lakh ha.). Higher area is reported in Bihar (up by 0.02 lakh ha.) Jharkhand (up by 1.51 lakh ha.), Madhya Pradesh (up by 0.52 lakh ha.), Uttar Pradesh (up by 1.42 lakh ha.) and Punjab (up by 0.04 lakh ha.).
- In Gujarat, Kharif pulses area this year is down by 1.5 lakh ha. to 3.48 lakh ha. from 4.98 lakh ha. in last year.
- As per Rajasthan Agriculture State Dept., pulses sown area in state as on 21 Aug, 2012-(Area in Lakh ha.)

Sowed crop is in early vegetative stage and recent rains are very much useful for the crop. Meanwhile, tur at Nalgonda district suspect with RHC, moong at Khammam, Nalgonda and Rangareddy districts suspects with spodopters, aphids, YMV, sucking pest and helicoverpa and urad also suspects with helicoverpa in Rangareddy district.

Indian Monsoon Forecast Up to 25th Aug :- (Source-IMD)

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over West Bengal and at many places over Punjab, Haryana, Delhi & Chandigarh, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, east Rajasthan, Gujarat region, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Vidarbha and Gangetic West Bengal during next 48 hours.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over rest parts of the country.
- Dry weather prevailed in North Karnataka region of Karnataka state during past few days. Sowing of tur crops are in progress.
- Light to moderate rainfall received in Marathwada (Maharashtra) state during past few days.
- Andhra Pradesh state received an average rainfall of 372.5 mm against the normal rainfall of 368.8 mm.
- Karnataka state as a whole received 141.46 mm of rainfall as against the normal of 592.6 mm rainfall leading to deficit of (-) 30%.

International Fundamental:

Australian Pulses Outlook 30July,2012

- As per Pulses Australia, higher area planted under pulses in current year and delayed rainfall has minimal impact on pulses sowing. Average yields of pulses crop is expected in most of the region.

- Lower area planted under lentil crop as compared from last year, but still near to historical area averages. Most of the lentil crop in Australia were sown on time and average production is expected on good yields.
- In Australia, this year more of area planted under "Kaspa type" field pea as compared to "dun type" field pea. In South Australia and Victoria, area shift from lentils towards field pea is reported and crop is in extremely good conditions in this region. Meanwhile, in Esperance region (Western Australia), higher canola prices reduced the field pea area, but the standing crop is in good conditions.
- In Australia, northern region have seen significant rainfall and higher planted area under chana likely to produce considerable amount of crop, but some incidence of Ascochyta reported in Southern Qld region with low threat capacity. In Western Australia, lower area sowed under the crop and low rainfall and cold temperature is likely to affect the standing crop. In Southern New South Wales, higher area planted under the crop and average to above average yield is also expected. In South Australia and Victoria, higher area planted under chana crop and more area is sowed under "Kabuli type" chana.
