

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Both, future and cash market continued to witness steady sentiments on dull trading activity on Friday.
- India's Commerce Ministry cancels the pulses import by public sector units-STC, MMTC and PEC due to the recent losses incurred by them on past. Moreover, Food ministry plan to revive the scheme of selling pulses at subsidy of Rs.20 per Kg through ration shops is also continued to remain off.
- At JNPT port, 2 containers of Malawi tur, 13 containers of Tanzania tur, 15 containers of Tanzania tur dal, 59 containers of Tanzania moong, 17 containers of moong, 19 containers of yellow peas, 75 containers of Russia split chickpeas, 10 containers of Russia split chana, 3 containers of USA chana arrived on 28 Aug, 2012.
- While, 63 containers of Burma tur, 28 containers of Ethiopia chana, 5 containers of Tanzania moong and 1 containers of moong arrived on 29 Aug, 2012.
- Following are the lowest bid for TNCSC pulses tender, opened on 30 Aug, 2012:-
 - Rs.5316 per qtl. of 10,000 MT of urad dal FAQ
 - Rs.6745 per qtl. Of 15000 MT of tur dal phataka
- Currently, 40,000 bags of moong are lying with the traders in Karnataka as per market participants

Sowing Progress

- According to the latest information received from Ministry of Agriculture on 31 Aug, 2012, pulses has been sown in 97.70 lakh hectare, as compared to 88.30 lakh ha, a week back. Normal area under pulses for this week is 101.31 lakh ha.
- Haryana state Agri. Dept revealed that this year kharif pulses area in the state have been reduced to 0.35 lakh ha. as compared from 0.94 lakh ha. in previous year.

- In Vidarbha region of Maharashtra, Pigeon Pea is through vegetative phase and Greengram, black gram at grain development stage.
- In Marathwada region of Maharashtra, pigeon pea are at development stage, green gram and black gram are in grain formation to grain development stage,
- In Haryana, pigeonpea in grand growth phase.
- In Odisha, sowing of pulses is in progress.
- In Karnataka, sowing of sunflower, inter-cultivation in pigeon pea crops are in progress. Pigeonpea is at seedling to branching stage And the crop are at establishment to 3-4 leaves stage. Weeding is also in progress
- In MP and Gujarat, green gram is at pod development stage/maturity stage, pigeonpea and castor are through vegetative phase.
- In Chhattisgarh, black gram and groundnut are at flower initiation to flowering stage.
- In U.P, sowing, weeding and thinning in greengram, pigeon pea and transplanting of vegetable crops are progress. Pigeon pea is in vegetative stage.

Indian Monsoon:- (Source-IMD)

- Fairly wide spread rainfall would also occur over central India, Gujarat and Rajasthan during next two days and decrease in the middle of the week. However, the rainfall activity would again increase over Central India towards the end of the coming week.
- Recent rainfall will help the pulses crop and it also improves the prospect of winter crop. Water reservoir levels have also rise after recent rains.
- Recent Rains will help Rice, Oil seed Crops. Winter Crop prospect improves after recent rains. Water Reservoir Level have risen after rains.

International Fundamental:

- During the week ended on 26 Aug, visible field pea stock in Canada's licensed elevator system totaled 392,400 MT, up by 107,900 from previous week total stock of 284,500 MT. Moreover, it is up by 37,400 MT from 355000 MT by this time of the season during the last year. The total export during this period, totaled at 53,600 MT as compared with 20,000 MT in last week. Export shipments so far in this season total at 74000 MT of peas down by 11400 MT from 85400 MT in last year.
- Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report for the period August 21 to 27, 2012 revealed that producers in the province are busy desiccating pulses, combining and swathing. Following is the crop wise harvesting progress in province:-
