

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- Indian wheat cash market remained steady to flat on Monday.
- Record highest ever production of food grains during 2011-12 was reported. Foodgrain production is likely to reach at 250.42 million tonnes.
- Commencement of new crop speed up Arrivals from new crop in Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh are on the rise
- In Kharif 2012 strategy conference, Mr. Sharad Pawar(Indian Agriculture Minister) states that India have enough stocks to allow export of at least one more million tonne of wheat. However, in the past six months sluggish wheat exports are reported and were estimated at 5.5 lakh tonnes.

Wheat International Fundamental:

- In Chicago Board, Profit booking and position squaring was witnessed in expectation of upcoming USDA's march supply&demand and world crop production reports.
- Australian wheat output is likely to fall down by 15% in 2012-13 due to lower global prices which may prompt farmers to shift to other competing crops.
- The Iraq grain board seeks an international tender of 50,000 tonnes of wheat of any origin.

Domestic market outlook: Wheat market is expected to trade steady with weak bias for short term.
