

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- Wheat cash market firmed up slightly on Tuesday on increasing possibility of delayed harvesting in Punjab, Haryana, U.P., and Rajasthan. Recent rains may extend maturity period by a week or two. Besides, more rains is likely in north India and fear of hails storm may cause some damage to the standing crop.
- No major trade has been reported today as bulk buyers are waiting for stabilization in the market. Wheat prices are expected to gain further on back of higher MSP and dwindling stocks in private hands. Export demand is negligible due to disparity.
- New wheat in Gujarat is being traded at the rate of Rs 1200 per qtl. with 13 percent moisture level. Wheat in M.P. was traded at Rs 1250-1260 per qtl and prices are expected to move up as commencement of procurement is at hand now.

Wheat International Fundamental:

- US wheat futures ended higher, boosted by rising corn prices and short-covering ahead of the March contract's expiration Wednesday. Wheat and corn are tied as the crops compete for acreage and can both be used as animal feed. CBOT May futures rise 8 1/4c to \$6.51 1/4 a bushel while KCBT May climbs 12c to \$6.96 and MGEX May jumps 14 1/2c to \$8.19 1/2.
- Global wheat production for MY 2012 is set to breach all records as FAO pegged world
 wheat production to as high as 690 million tons. Higher acreage in Asia and optimistic
 outlook for CIS countries results into higher production and subsequent global surplus.
