Wheat Daily Report 21stJuly, 2012

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- Record production of wheat in the country, government's procurement of the key food staple increased by 36 per cent to a record 37.85 million tonnes (mt) in the current marketing season so far. The government had purchased 27.85 mt of wheat in the 2011-12 wheat marketing season (April-March).
- Wheat cash market constantly increasing on strong demand from exporters from previous week and is expected to stay firm at current level as higher demand is likely to support the cash market.
- India's Ministry of Agriculture has released it 'fourth advance estimates' for the 2011-12 crop season. As per the latest estimates, India has produced 12.66 million tonnes more to 257.44 million tonnes of food grains during 2011-12 compared to 244.78 million tonnes in the previous year. This is highest ever food grains production, surpassing all earlier records. Record production has been achieved in the case of wheat at 93.9 MT in 2011-12.
- There is not much wheat available in open market and private trades/whole sellers are unwilling to sell their stock at current prices in anticipation of higher realization.

Wheat International Fundamental:

- Zimbabwe will import wheat to meet its domestic demand. As per the estimates of USDA Zimbabwe will produce only 20,000 MT of wheat in the 2012-13 MY from 10,000 hectares.
- It is estimated that Zimbabwe will import 250,000 Tons of wheat for MY 2012-13.
- According to Food and Agricultural Organization (FOA), due to dry and hot weather conditions in US and Black sea region especially in Russian federation has risen Global wheat prices by 21% to USD 347 per tonnes during first three weeks of July. Rising international prices can benefit India as India has surplus wheat stocks.

Domestic market Outlook: Wheat cash market constantly increasing on strong demand from exporters.
