

Wheat Daily Report 9th November 2012

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to Traders, Wheat spot market has not witnessed major demand today as market participants are waiting for after Diwali OMSS release by Government.
- MMTC got the highest bid of USD 318.67/T for wheat export form Louis Dreyfus for 100000 tonnes.
- We expect wheat prices to come down with release for OMSS next week and availability will increase. Govt. may allow private trade to export from central pool and it will help stabilizing the prices in the cash market as private trades/exporters will be able to source wheat directly from public stock. Decision over it is expected after Diwali.
- The cabinet is ready to offload more wheat through OMSS and decision is expected next week any time. Quantity in question may be 60 to 70 lakh tones for December and January.
- Hefty burden of wheat stock (Over 40 million Tonne as on Nov.1st, 2012), possibility of bumper crop once again and the ongoing paddy procurement have encouraged govt. to offload more wheat in time and check spiraling prices in the cash market.

International Market Update:

- Winter crop of Russia is better than last year but it is below than average crop condition. Seeds has not sprouted due to drought of September and October.
- Ukraine had increased the wheat exportable surplus to 5.5 million tonnes for this season starting from 1 July 2012. So far it is expected that Ukraine has exported 4.5 million tonnes since July 1 2012.
- US and EU Sanction hit Iran has imported wheat from 7 countries. According to the Iran Deputy Minister for Industry and Trade, Iran has purchased 50,000 tonnes from Germany and 359,900 tonnes from Russia between July and September 2012.
- Kansas State of US has completed 99% of winter wheat planting. The emerging crop's condition as 13 percent poor to very poor, 50 percent fair, 35 percent good and 2 percent excellent.

Domestic market Outlook: We expect prices to rule steady to slightly weak on increasing possibility of higher allocation from govt.'s stock and unchanged MSP for this crop year.
