Guar Daily Fundamental Report 29th October, 2012

Domestic Fundamentals:

- Guar seed and guar gum prices noticed mixed tone on Saturday.
- Lack of demand around current levels weighed on the market.
- Good quality crop arrival is expected by November.
- Export demand is expected to be lower this season as oil and gas companies in overseas markets have stocked up guar.
- Arrivals are expected to pick up by next week.
- Anticipation of lower output compared to initial estimates will lend support to the market in the medium –term.
- According to trade sources, arrival of new crop in Bhiwani market has 10 -15% moisture content.
- There is less demand from millers around current levels.
- Weather is expected to be dry in the guar –seed growing regions.
- FMC has send a report to the Food Ministry on re –launching guar complex futures. Decision is likely to be taken this month.
- According to the first advance estimates of Haryana agricultural department, guar production in the current season is estimated at 3.75 lakh metric tonnes compared to 2.0 lakh metric tonnes in the previous season.
- According to State Agricultural sources, acreage under guar seed in Gujarat till 1st October 2012 is reported at 237500 hectares compared to 126900 hectares during the same period last year.

Outlook: Prices are likely to notice steady to weak tone in the near –term.

FMC has stopped trading in all guar seed and guar gum futures contracts effective March 28, 2012.
