


Onion Fundamentals:


- As per initial estimate, rabi onion crop in Maharashtra and Karanataka could be down by 35% and 25% respectively due to less acreage and shortage of water.
- Onion prices in different markets are stable amid adequate supply from producing region. But prices are relatively very high when compared to last year due less production in kharif and late kharif season. Rabi crop is also expected to be down in Maharashtra and Karnataka. Prices are expected to be firm are not expected to come down much as happened last year.
- Wholesale modal average price of onion is 1600/Qtl and Retail modal average price in India is hovering near Rs. 20-21/kg.
- This year till December total onion export is 12.95 Lakh tons where as last year at the same time total onion export was 11.04 Lakh tons. The largest importers of India onion are Bangladesh, Malaysia, Gulf Countries and Sri Lanka.
