


Onion Fundamentals:


- In Gujarat, onion is coming from local region only. 'Red' variety onion is fetching a price of Rs 1040 to Rs 1625/ quintal whereas 'White' variety onion is able to fetch a price of Rs 850 to Rs 1375/ quintal.
- In Kanpur market, today onion arrived from Nashik region and Bhavnagar region which are contributing approximately 70% and 30% to the total arrival. According to trade sources, onion from Nashik region is able to fetch the highest prices of Rs 1800 to 1850/ quintal.
- Indian exporters are executing orders from Middle Eastern importers at \$420 a ton whereas onion exported from Pakistan is cheaper by \$30-40/ ton than India.
- According to news sources, government is considering levying MEP on onion export at \$ 700 a ton to discourage export due to increase in prices in domestic market.
