

### Onion Fundamentals:

- According to trade sources, prices of onion in Katmandu has increased by Rs 15 compared to previous month and prices are hovering near Rs 45/kg. The reason for increase in prices is due to short supply and soaring prices in India.
- In Maharashtra, prices of onion are hovering around Rs 1450/ quintal compared to previous year's Rs 365 / quintal at same time. Prices are approximately 3 times higher than last year and expected to drop down only after arrival of Rabi crop.
- Fresh arrivals from Bhavnagar (Gujarat) region have started arriving in various consuming markets.
- In Guwahati, prices of onion in retail market are hovering in the range of Rs 2200/ quintal which is approximately 25% higher compared to corresponding previous year at Rs 1800/ quintal.
