


Onion Fundamentals:


- According to trade sources, prices of onion in Katmandu has increased by Rs 15 compared to previous month and prices are hovering near Rs 45/kg. The reason for increase in prices is due to short supply and soaring prices in India.
- In Solapur (Maharashtra), prices of onion have increased to Rs 2000/ quintal from 1600/ quintal whereas arrivals have dropped down by 40% to 18000 quintal in last 3-4 days.
- In Lasalgaon market which control the prices across the country, prices are continuously rising and have reached almost five fold compared to previous year at same time. In today's market prices were in the range of Rs 1500 to Rs 2200/ quintal.
- According to news sources, exports are already negligible or have stopped as Indian onion is not competitive compared with supplies from nations like Pakistan. The price of Indian onion is \$460 per ton while the Pakistan onion is \$285 per ton.
