


Onion Fundamentals:


- In Maharashtra region, there has been a reduction in the wholesale price of onions due to the news in the markets from past few days that government is going to take serious measures against rise in prices.
- According to trade sources, prices of onion have fallen in major growing areas like Maharashtra,
 Karnataka and Gujarat which may decline the prices across the country.
- According to news sources in Bhubaneswar, Government has asked district collector to take steps against the traders to ensure that there should be no hoardings and prices remains below Rs 30/kg.
- In Jaipur, prices are hovering in the range of Rs 1700 to Rs 2200/ quintal. This situation is going to improve after February when the mandi will start getting supply produced in Jaipur, Sikar and Jhunjhunu districts.
