


Onion Fundamentals:


- Prices of onion have dropped down by 15-20% in last four days because of lack of available transport. As Railway administration has closed booking of rakes for transportation due to ongoing Kumbh mela in Allahabad. Because of this traders are unable to send the consignments timely.
- In Belgaum (Karnataka), onion is coming from Maharashtra and Karnataka region which are contributing approximately 70 and 30% respectively to the total arrival.
- In Pune, farmers are bringing maximum of their produce in market in fear of further decline in prices. According to trade sources, maximum arrivals are arriving in market in anticipation of low prices ahead.
- In North India, maximum onion retail prices are in Dehradun at Rs 3000/ quintal whereas lowest prices are in Chandigarh at Rs 2000/ quintal.
