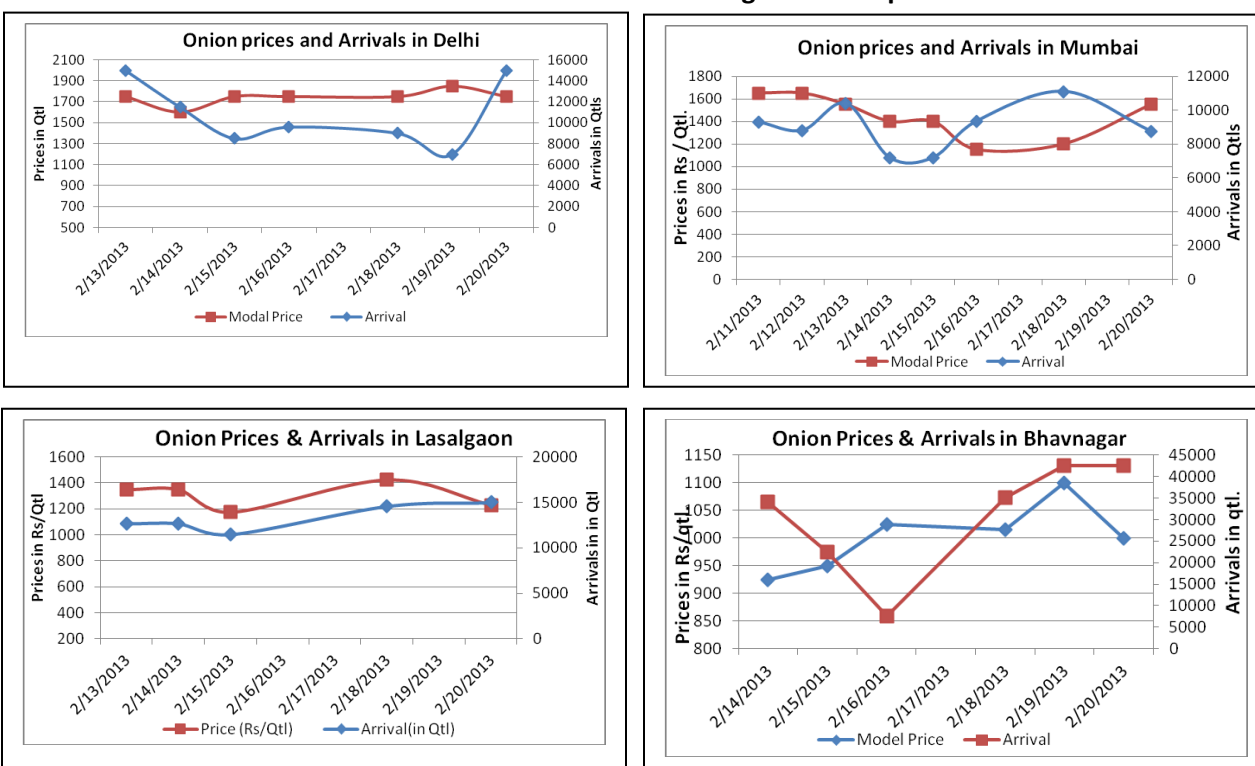


Onion Fundamentals:

- At Lasalgaon in Maharashtra, the average price quoted yesterday was Rs 1230/Qtl as against Rs 2,150/Qtl on January 30
- In Bhavnagar (Gujarat), prices are low as compared to Maharashtra region because of good late Kharif crop. Daily average arrivals are approximately 35000qtls/ day.
- Prices have fallen in last few days across the country because of increase in release from stockiest and higher supply from producing region like Maharashtra and Gujarat.
- Average retail prices in Delhi have come down to Rs. 25/Kg from Rs. 30/kg, two weeks ago.
- In Belgaum (Karnataka), onion is coming from Maharashtra, Bhavnagar and local region which are contributing approximately 10%, 25% and 65% respectively to total arrival.
