

### Onion Fundamentals:

- Prices have fallen in last few days across the country because of increase in release from stockiest and higher supply from producing region like Maharashtra and Gujarat.
- According to trade sources in Bhavnagar (Gujarat) arrivals are expected to be high for next two weeks and prices may remain stable.
- In Northern part of India, maximum retail prices were in Dehradun and Kanpur at Rs 30/kg each and lowest prices were in Bhatinda, Hisar and Chandigarh at Rs 30/ kg.
- In Delhi market, prices have fallen down to Rs 1250/ quintal from Rs 1850/ quintal in last 2 days as arrivals have increased by 60%, compared to previous 2 days arrivals.
