


Onion Fundamentals:


- India's total onion export till March (14.3.2013) in the current FY 2012-13 has reached to around 1635452 MT. During 2011-12, total onion export till March was around 1552904 MT. According to official sources, onion export in the month of February 2013 has declined to 100319 tons from January figure of 121261 tons due to higher prices in domestic markets.
- Prices of onion in Maharashtra are expected to range bound till crop from 'Mahuva' and 'Sukhsagar'
 variety from West Bengal gets over. Once this crop gets over, prices in Maharashtra are expected to
 strengthen as Rabi crop is less due to lesser rainfalls.
- Farmers of Maharashtra as well as Gujarat states which planted rabi onion crop little early in anticipation of less availability of ground water at later stage. Therefore harvesting of rabi onion crop started early and at present arriving in the markets. The main crop harvesting will be taken place in April.
