


### Onion Fundamentals:

- In Lasalgaon market of Maharashtra, market was opened today with modal price of Rs 930/ quintal which showed a jump of 10% in prices.
- According to news sources, government has ruled out banning export of onion saying the rise in domestic prices was “temporary” caused by unseasonable rains and mandi closures.
- In Bangalore, onion is arriving in market from Maharashtra region and local region which are contributing approximately 70% and 30% respectively.
- In North East part of India maximum retail prices were in Itanagar and Aizwal at Rs 3500/ quintal followed by Dimapur and Shillong at Rs 3000 and Rs 2100/ quintal respectively.
