


### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Bangalore, onion is arriving in market from local region and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 30% and 70% respectively.
- According to news sources in West Bengal, government's has taken up a plan for cultivation of onion crop over 800 hectares of area so that it can become self reliance in onion production.
- In Indore, local produced onion is arriving in market and its prices are stable and hovering in the range of Rs 500 to 800/ quintal.
- Across the country maximum retail prices were seen in Shimla and Srinagar at Rs 2000/ quintal followed by Surat and Bangalore at Rs 1800 and Rs 1700/ quintal respectively.
