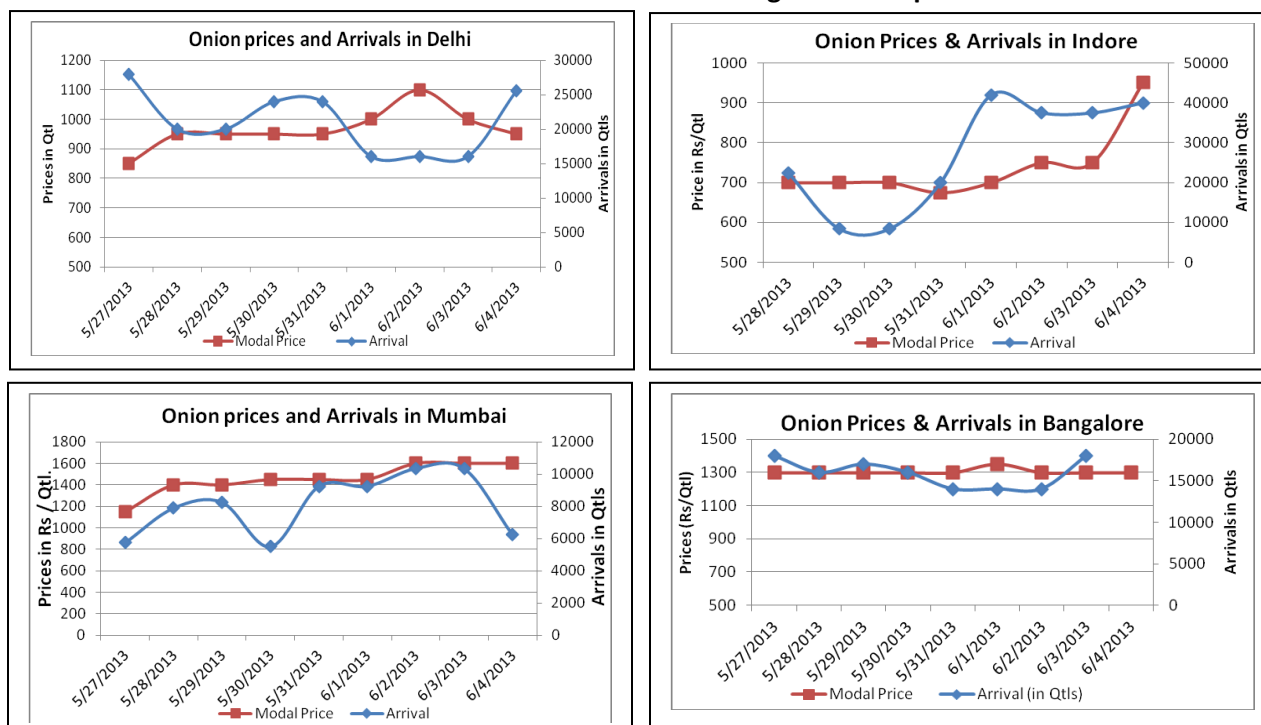


Onion Fundamentals:

- **In Nashik**, modal prices have increased to Rs 1100/ quintal from Rs 950/ quintal because of lower arrivals from nearby regions as farmers/traders are stocking onion to fetch high prices in future.
- **In Lasalgaon**, prices have Increased to a level of Rs 1118/ quintal from a level of Rs 990 in last few days as of higher demand as arrival are low in market and demand is high.
- **In Nashik**, Prices have reached to Rs 1400/ quintal from a level of Rs 1100/ quintal in last 2-3 days. Prices are continuously increasing because of higher demand.
- **In Bhavnagar**, onion arrivals have decreased by approximately 75-80% compared to previous week. According to trade sources, onion may be available in market for next couple of days.
