

Onion Fundamentals:

- In **Kanpur**, onion arrivals have fallen by almost 50% due to heavy rainfall from last two days. Prices which are hovering in the range of Rs 1400 to Rs 1500/ quintal are expected to increase further.
- In **Karnataka**, total targeted kharif area is approximately 99506 hectare from which 8745 hectare of area has been sown. In Karnataka last year kharif sown area was approximately 22299 ha.
- In **AP**, a total of 27950 Ha is expected to be sown of which 1035 ha has been sown as of now. But last year approximately 612 Ha of area was sown at same time.
- According to trade sources, Kharif onion crop production is expected to be good and may arrive before time this year due to timely arrival of monsoon.
