

### Onion Fundamentals:

- **In Nashik**, modal prices have increased to Rs 1800/ quintal from Rs 1600/ quintal in last one week because of higher export and domestic demand.
- **In Pimpalgaon**, prices have increased from Rs 1290 to Rs 1700/ quintal in last one week whereas arrivals are almost same.
- **In Bangalore**, onions are arriving in market from local region (Bijapur) and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 30% and 70% respectively.
- **In Delhi**, onion is arriving in market from Rajasthan, M.P, Maharashtra and Haryana. According to trade sources, maximum onion prices are being fetched by Nasik and M.P region crop which is approximately Rs 1900- 2000/ quintal.
