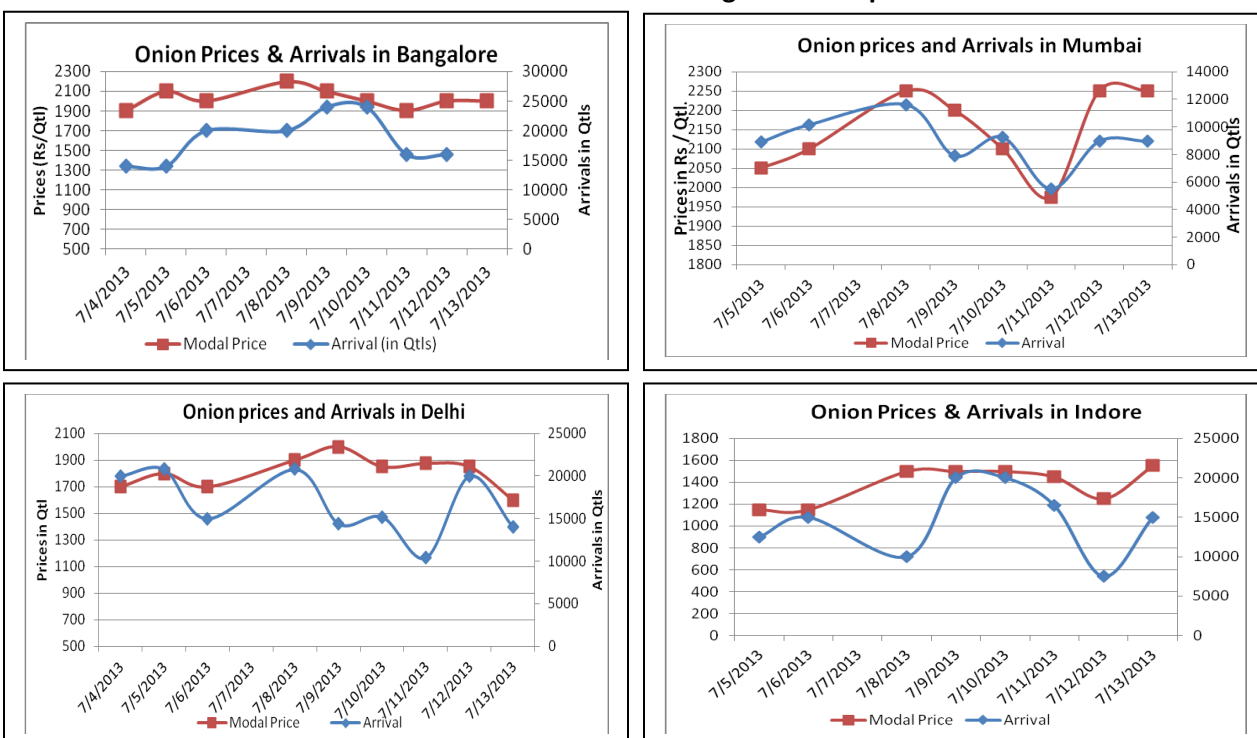


### Onion Fundamentals:

- In Lasalgaon and Pimpalgaon, prices are ranging between Rs 1600 to Rs 2000/ quintal depending upon the quality of onion.
- Large farmers and stockiest are releasing onion into market slowly in anticipation of higher prices in near future.
- Retail prices in most of the cities have reached near Rs. 25-30/Kg due to lesser arrivals of onion in market and higher prices of other green vegetables.
- According to news source, Srilankan Govt has increased import duty on big onions from Srilankan rupee 15 to 30/Kg (1 srilankan rupee=0.46 Indian rupee). This step is taken to discourage import of big onion in the market and to ensure reasonable price for local growers.
