
Market Intelligence System

Onion Fundamentals:

- According to news sources in Delhi onion to be sold out through 150 mobile vans, on no-profit-no-loss basis from August 17 onwards.
- Government has increased the minimum export prices (MEP) of onion to \$650 ton per metric ton FOB, so that rising prices in domestic market may come down.
- In Lasalgaon and Pimpalgaon market prices of onion have fallen by Rs 200-Rs300/ quintal in last one day because of rumour in the market that government may take serious steps against hoarders/traders.
- At Present, Bangalore, Kurnool and Indore mandi have become important to track as they are reporting the higher arrivals compared to different mandis of Nashik.
- According to trade sources, prices of onion are expected to decline after one week as arrival of fresh crop from Karnataka will pick up pace which is major supplier to Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.
