



#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Lower arrivals were reported in major onion market on Wednesday.
- New crop of onion from Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka has started arriving in the markets. Arrivals will
  increase in coming days and put cap on prices.
- Sources revealed that, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh together produce in the range of 38-40 lakh tonnes in a year, while the country's total output is estimated at 166.55 lakh tonnes in 2012-13.
- As per mandi information, arrival of onion in wholesale mandi has increased almost three times to 30,000 tonnes in Bengaluru and 10,000 tonnes in Hyderabad in the last one month.
- In Karnataka district Onion sowing area reported till 19th August 2013, 78328 hectares as compared to the last year same period 17107 hectares. State Government target area for this year is 145344 hectares.
- In Andhra Pradesh district Onion sowing area reported till 28<sup>th</sup> August 2013, 13762 hectares as compared to the last year same period 19550 hectares.
