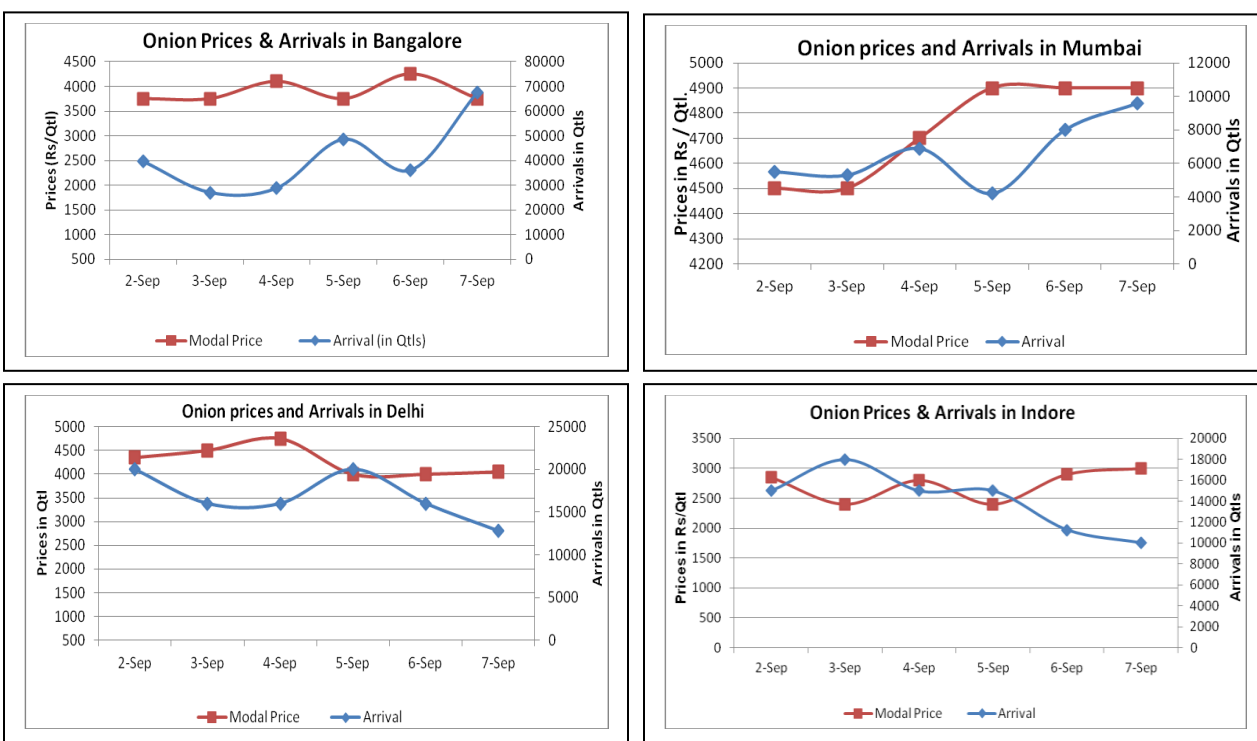


Onion Fundamentals:

- In Karnataka, fresh onion crop from 'Chitradurga' district is arriving in market continuously with full pace. On a daily basis approximately 30000 quintal of onion is arriving in market per day in Bangalore market.
- All India, cumulative arrival of Onion in the month of August is approximately 30 % less compared to last year during same time.
- In A.P, onion acreage for kharif season is approximately 27,950 ha. So far 25,222 hectares of area is sown as compared to previous year's 19,610 hectare area. The sown area has increased compared to previous year because of timely arrival of monsoon this year.
- In Lasalgaon market, prices have increased by 15% which are hovering in the range of Rs 4200 to Rs 4400/ quintal.
