


### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Government has hiked the Minimum Export price (MEP) to \$900/MT from \$650/MT to curb down soaring onion prices.
- In retail market, prices of onion in Delhi market has decreased to Rs 6500/ quintal from Rs 7000/ quintal few days back.
- In Lasalgaon and Pimpalgaon market prices have dropped down to Rs 4450/ quintal each from Rs 5500 and Rs 5530/ quintal respectively.
- Higher arrivals were reported in Delhi and Mumbai Market which have bought down modal prices to Rs 4750 and Rs 4000/ quintal.
- Sources revealed that, fresh crop arrival from Maharashtra region is expected to be during 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> week of
  October and prices are expected to correct after that only.
