



#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Onion arrivals in Indore mandi is affected to rains. Yesterday arrivals dip to 7000 Qtl from 22000 Qtl.
- Delay in harvesting of Kharif onion sowing is causing price to rise. Normally, kharif onion starts coming to
  market by mid of October, but this year due to rains during 1<sup>st</sup> week of Oct, harvesting has shifted by 1015 days. According to market sources, onion arrivals should start from 1<sup>st</sup> week of November.
- Late kharif sowing has also started in some pockets of Maharashtra. In some parts, it is also delayed due
  to rain. As per our initial intention survey of farmer, late kharif sowing is estimated to be by higher by
  20% than previous year.
- In Bangalore, daily average arrivals are hovering in the range 60000-75000 Qtl quintals from last 3-4 days. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 4200-5000/ quintal.
- In Delhi, premium quality of fresh onion from Maharashtra and Karnataka is trading at Rs 5250 and Rs 4875/ quintal. Onion from Rajasthan and Haryana are sold between Rs 3500 4000/ quintal.
