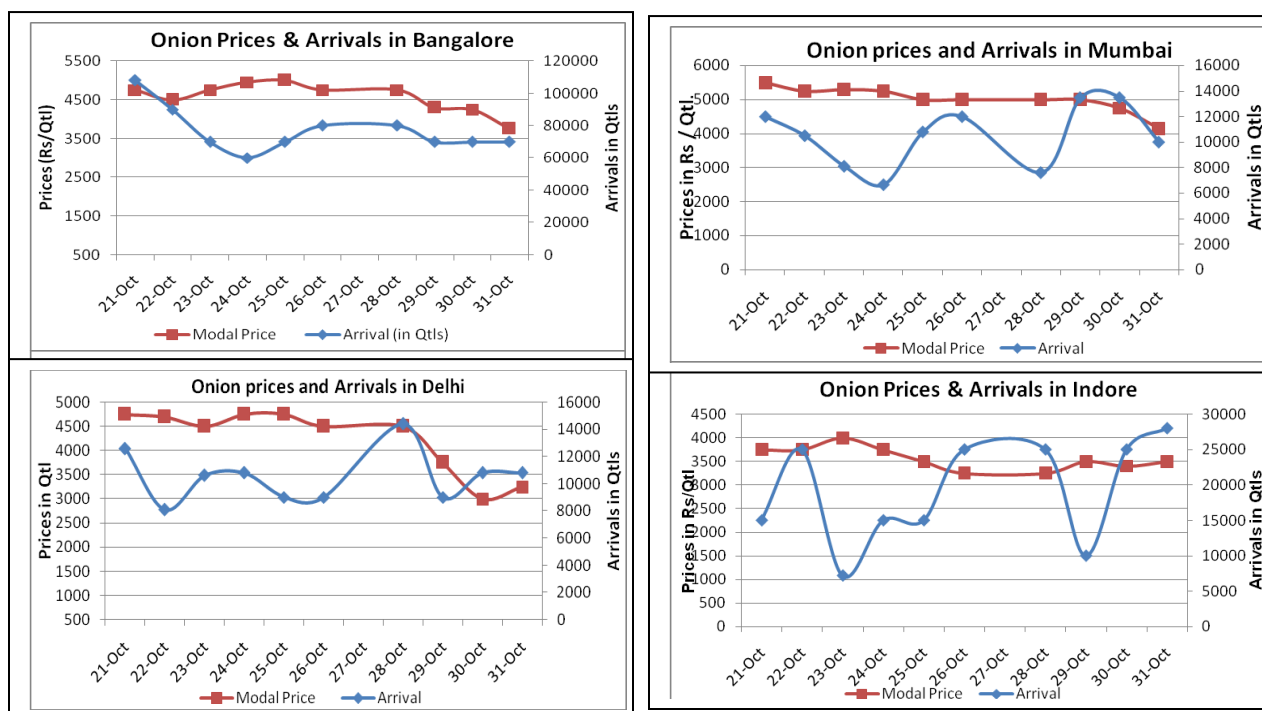


Onion Fundamentals:

- Arrivals have started increase in Lasalgaon mandi of Nasik district. Other important markets like Pimplagaon and Niphad are closed on account of Diwali holidays. After diwali, arrivals will increase further.
- Weather is also clear in Nasik district which could prompt farmers to start harvesting of onion in volumes.
- Increasing Onion arrivals were reported in the major domestic market. In Indore market, higher arrivals were reported due to dry weather condition. Onion arrivals will increase further after Diwali festivals.
- Late kharif sowing is progressing well and acreage is expected to be higher this year due to good availability of water. Late kharif sowing is estimated to be by higher by 20% than previous year.
- Delhi traders are preferring onion from Alwar (Rajasthan) than Maharashtra due to lower transportation cost. Modal prices in Delhi market have come down to Rs. 3600/Qtl from Rs. 4500/Qtl, a week ago.
- In Bangalore, daily average arrivals are hovering in the range 60000-75000 Qtl quintals from last one week. Prices range have also come down to Rs. 3500-4000 from 4000-4500/Qtl
