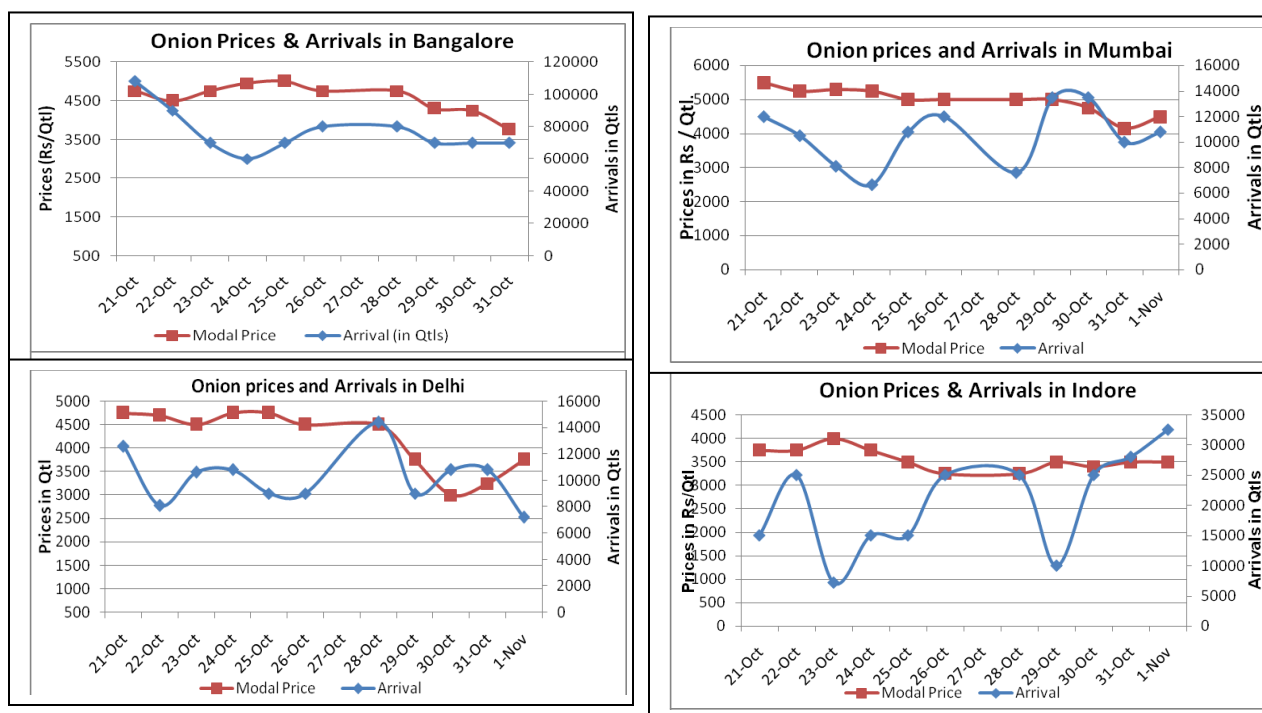


Onion Fundamentals:

- Some of Maharashtra and Karnataka markets are closed on Diwali holidays. This could affect onion supply in consuming centers.
- Arrivals have started to increase in Nasik district. Other important markets like Ahmednagar and Sholapur have reported higher arrivals on day by day basis. Onion arrivals will increase further after Diwali festivals
- In Bangalore, daily average arrivals are hovering in the range 60000-75000 Qtl quintals from last one week. Prices ranges have also come down to Rs. 3500-4000 from 4000-4500/Qtl.
- There are discussions in news papers about use of dehydrated/dried onion during higher price due to supply shortage. In India, most of dehydrated onion plants are located in Maharashtra and Gujarat. They export their produce outside India. Domestic use of dry onion is very less as people in India prefer to have fresh onion and awareness about the use of dried onion is much less.
