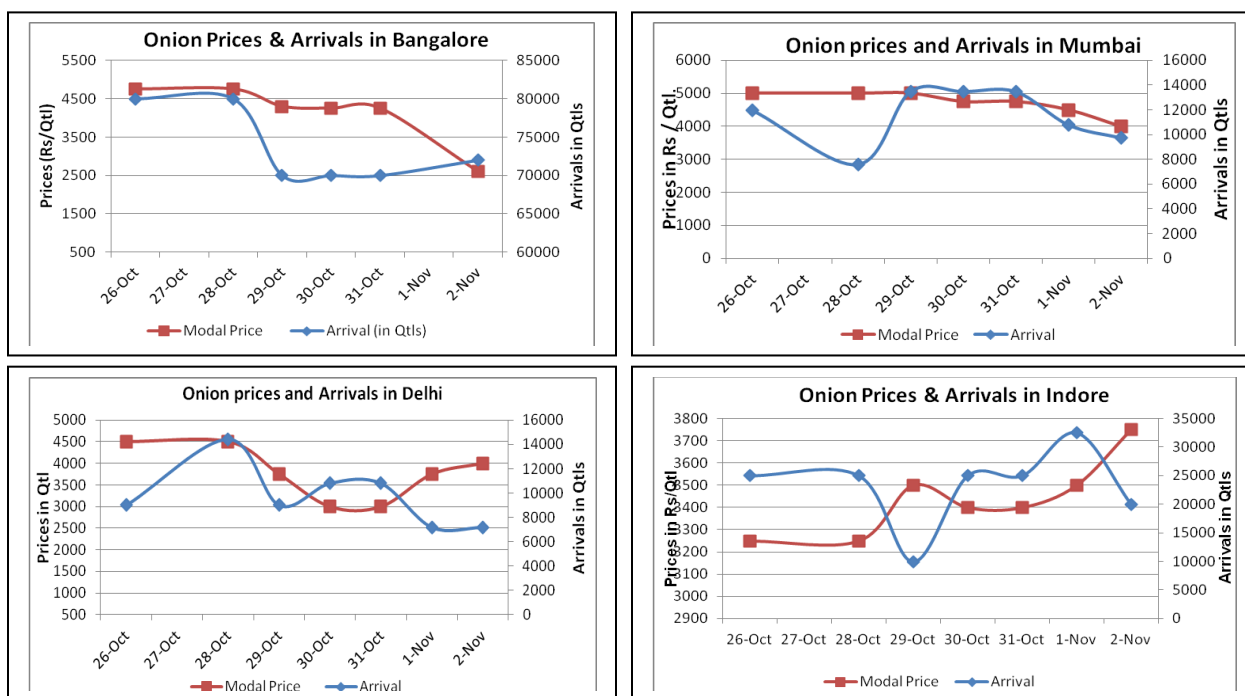


Onion Fundamentals:

- Government has increased Minimum Export Price (MEP) of onion by \$1150 / ton. It is expected that impact of increased MEP may bring down the prices down once traders are back from Diwali holidays.
- Arrivals have started to increase in Nashik district. Other important markets like Ahmednagar and Sholapur have reported higher arrivals on day by day basis. Onion arrivals will increase further in coming days.
- In Maharashtra, approximately 80% of late kharif sowing is completed in major growing districts. Nursery preparation for Rabi has started in few places and expected to pick up pace in next coming days.
- In Maharashtra, yield for late kharif crop is expected to be higher than kharif and early kharif crop due to supporting weather conditions for onion crop.
