

Onion Fundamentals:

- In Delhi, Bangalore and Mumbai onion prices reported down on Tuesday.
- On Monday, the Government had cut onion MEP about 30 per cent—-from \$1,150 a tonne to \$800 a tonne. As per market information, domestic traders push for Govt to cut onion MEP to \$300/tonne which was earlier \$1150/tonne.
- Farmer's agitation has started in Nashik district after average onion prices fell below Rs. 1000/Qtl yesterday in Pimplagaon mandi. They are demanding complete removal of MEP to support prices.
- In Lasalgaon market, modal prices of onion are hovering in the range of Rs 1000/ quintal. Daily average arrivals are approximately 20000 22000 quintals.
