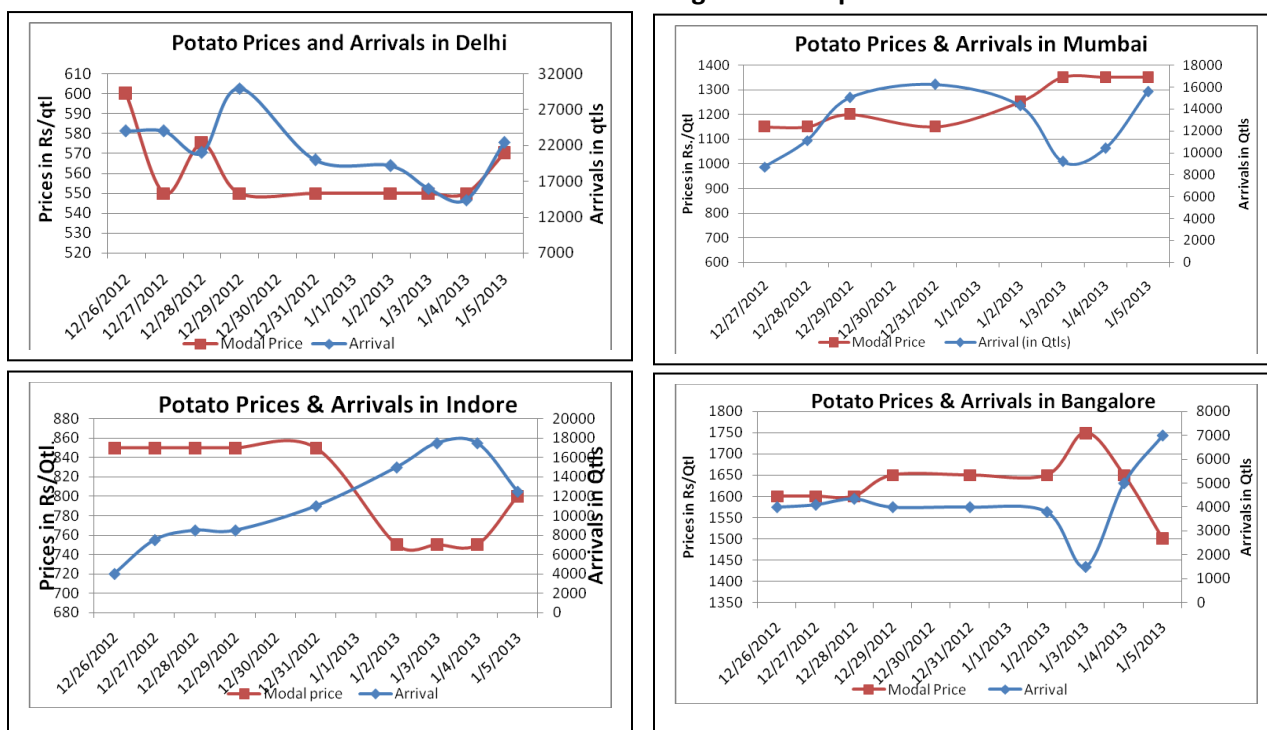


## Potato Fundamentals:

- Potato futures in MCX were up by Rs. 5-10/Qtl in various contracts due to short covering at support levels. Yesterday March contract touched low of Rs. 744 but closed at Rs. 748/Qtl.
- Present weather is conducive for potato crop in UP and West Bengal. Traders expect, yield would be better this year as compared to last year.
- As per traders estimate, area under potato in west Bengal is higher by 6-7% from previous year. But potato prices are not expected to fall much from this level as farmer's expectations are high this year.
- Potato prices in Southern cities like Bangalore and Chennai are ruling higher and trading near 1500-1800/Qtl due their dependence on supply from UP as local supply is minimal.

Short-covering was seen in March and May contract of potato futures which is visible from increase in open interest as well as prices. At the same time, long –build up was seen in April contract. Candlestick pattern of March contract also shows, price could increase further if it breaches 755 level.
