



Potato Fundamentals:


- In Begusarai (Bihar), cold storages are approximately filled by 75% compared to previous year's 90%. It is expected that total cold storage capacity last year was 14 lakh packets (1packet=50kg) which has increased to 18 lakh packets this year.
- According to trade sources this year in U.P, potato demand from North East region has declined as West Bengal potato is available at less price compared to U.P.
- In Khandauli (U.P), on an average 200-250 trucks are being released everyday in which major demand is coming from Karnataka region. According to trade sources, prices are expected to increase further once loose potato is over in market.
- In Tarkeshwar (West Bengal), prices of potato have increased by 25% in last one week. Prices have gone up from Rs 650/ quintal to Rs 820/ quintal.
