Highlights

- Pulses markets noticed mostly steady to firm tone during the week.
- Market participants revealed that --
 - ✓ In M.P. spot markets, arrival of new chana crop is not of good quality.
 - ✓ In Kanpur spot market, masoor continued firm tone on good demand and lower arrivals.
 - ✓ Urad prices in Guntur noticed good buying from millers around current levels.
 - ✓ Good buying in the beginning of financial year lent some support to the market.
- Arrival of new chana and peas crop will increase in the coming days.
- Sowing of summer pulses has started in Gujarat. According to the state agricultural department, sowing under moong is reported at 16400 hectares as on 18th March 2013 compared to 30300 hectares during the previous year.
- Lower arrivals and good demand from stockists lent some support to prices.
- According to IBIS, imports of chickpea in the month of March declined to 0.11 lakh metric tonnes compared to 0.46 lakh metric tonnes during the previous month.
- MOA revealed that Rabi pulses sowing increased to 150.82 lakh ha. as on Feb. 15th, 2013 in comparison with 147.46 lakh ha. During the same period in last year. Meanwhile, chana sown area surged to 94.99 lakh ha. as compared from 89.95 lakh ha. in last year.
- Lentils markets in Canada noticed firm tone during the week amid tight stocks and good demand from India and other countries.
- According to trade sources, chickpea crop in Queensland, Australia is expected to touch record harvest this season.
- International dry edible bean markets finished the week's trading on a relatively quit note amid the Eastern weekend observances in several key countries. (Source-Canadian Grain Commission).

- The USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation office here is seeking offers of 13,280 metric tons (MT) of peas for shipment as food aid. Purchases are for shipment from interior plants between May 1 to May 22 and between May 23 to June 13 for plants located at port.

Weekly Outlook: - Pulses prices are likely to notice sideways to firm tone amid good buying in the ready market.

- At Mumbai port, 65 containers of Burma tur, 50 containers of Tanzania tur, 5 containers of Burma tur dal, 13 containers of Burma urad, 21 containers of Burma moong, 4 containers of Argentina moong, 44 containers of Burma choulra, 16 containers of Kenya moong, 17 containers of Burma rajma, 25 containers of China rajma, 20 containers of Australia chana, 5 containers of Australia masoor, 70 containers of Canada masoor, 1 containers of Burma bamboo beans and 1 containers of Madagascar of lima beans has arrived.
- At Chennai port, 484 containers of urad, 71 containers of green moong beans, 7 containers of masoor, 14 containers of yellow peas, 21 containers of tur, 9 containers of green peas, 9 containers of cow peas and 15 containers of black eye beans has arrived.

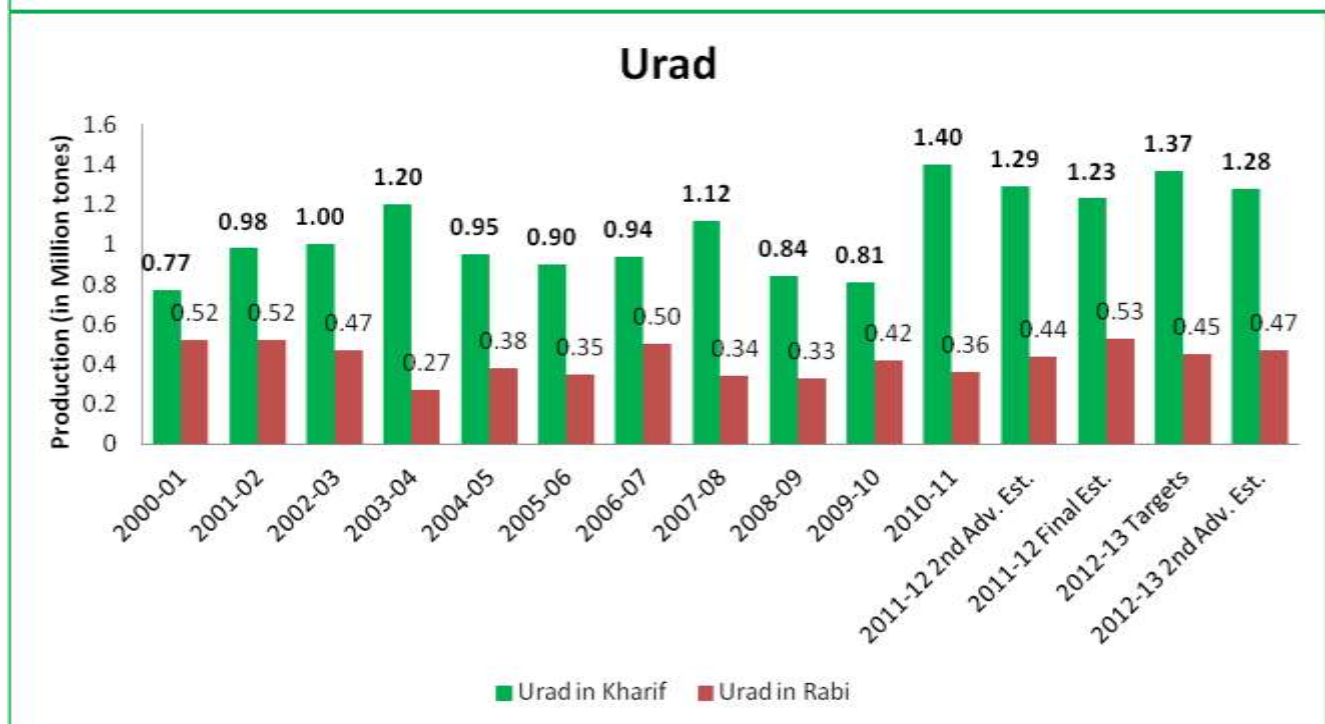
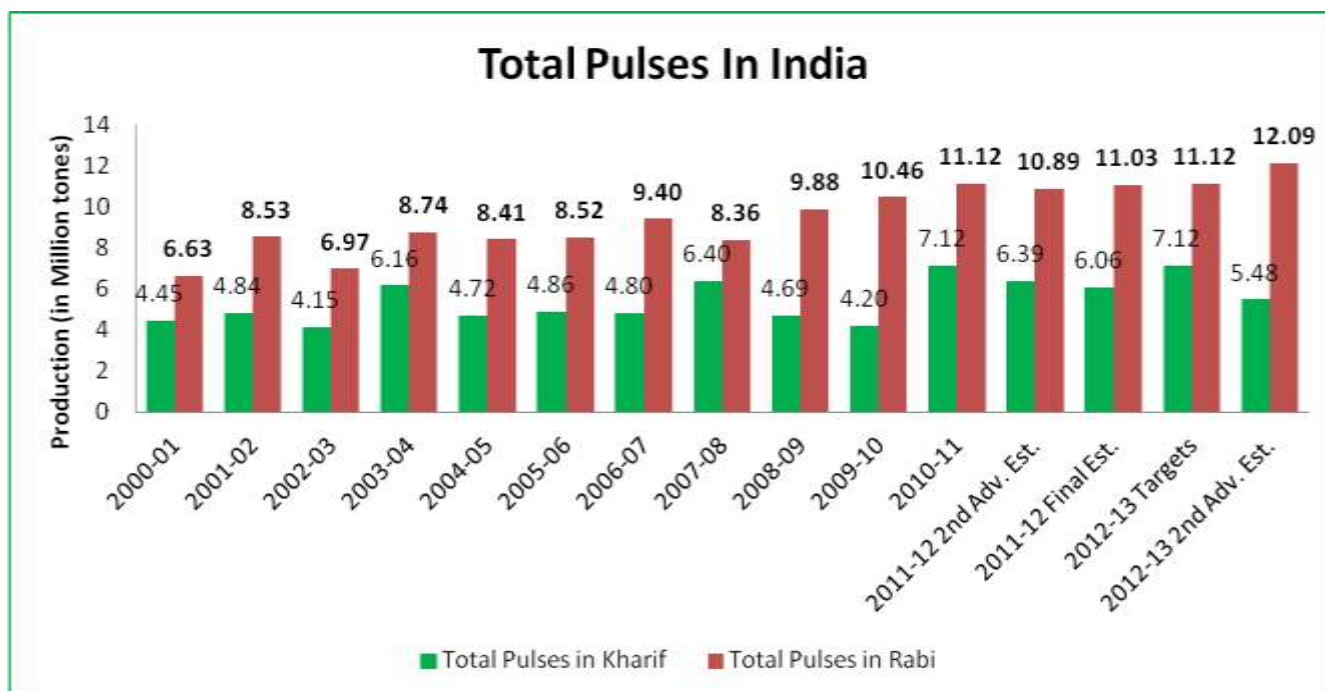

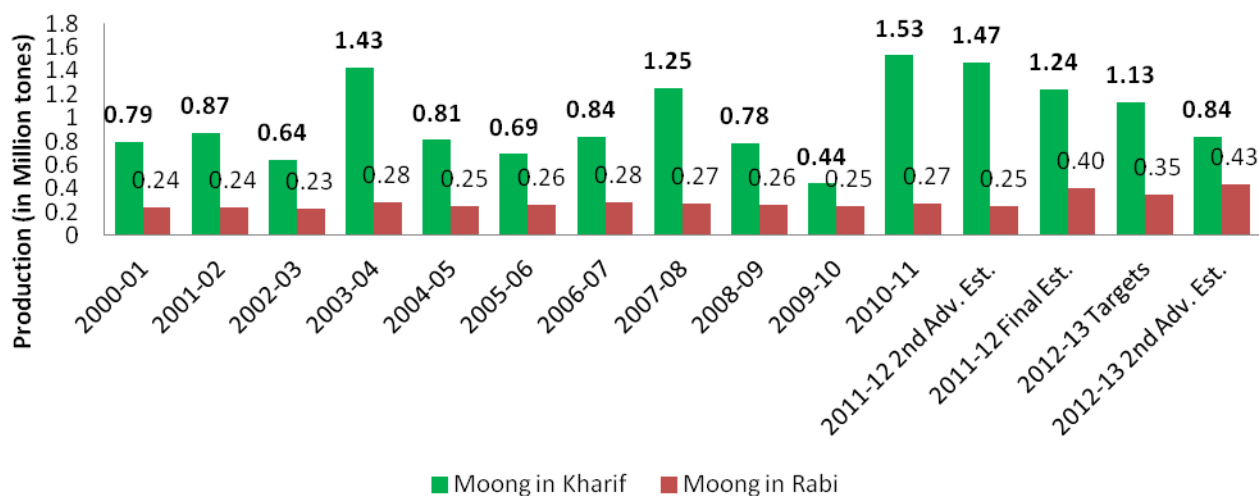

2ND Advance Estimates by MOA: Pulses output over 17.5 mn tonnes

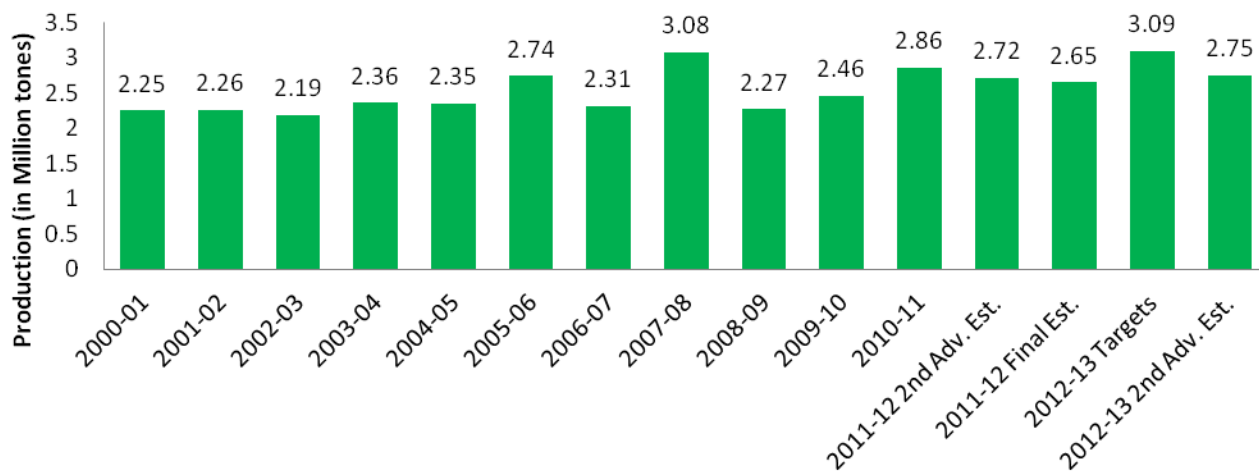
- MOA revealed that the country pulses production in 2012-13 is likely to around 17.58 million tonnes
- The target for pulses has been set at 18.24 million tonnes during the year.
- India needs imports as its required pulses domestic production is insufficient to meet the rising demand. The country's import bill on pulses stood at \$1.83 billion in 2011-12.



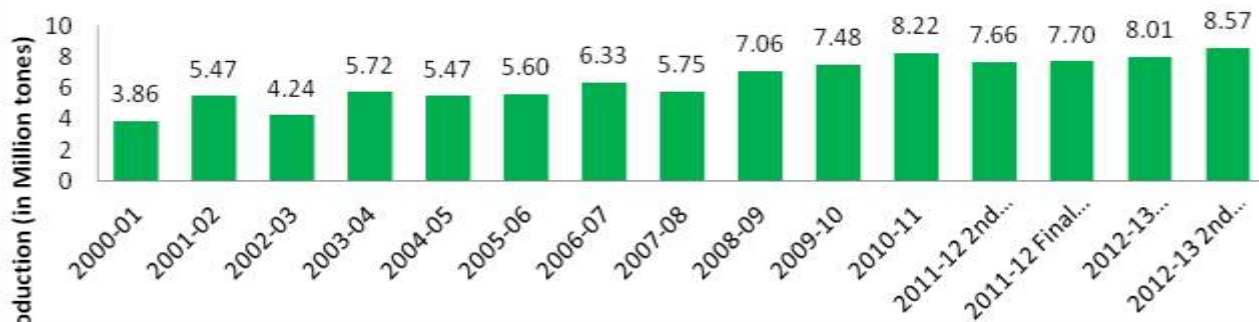

Chana prices noticed firm tone during the week.

Current Scenario:

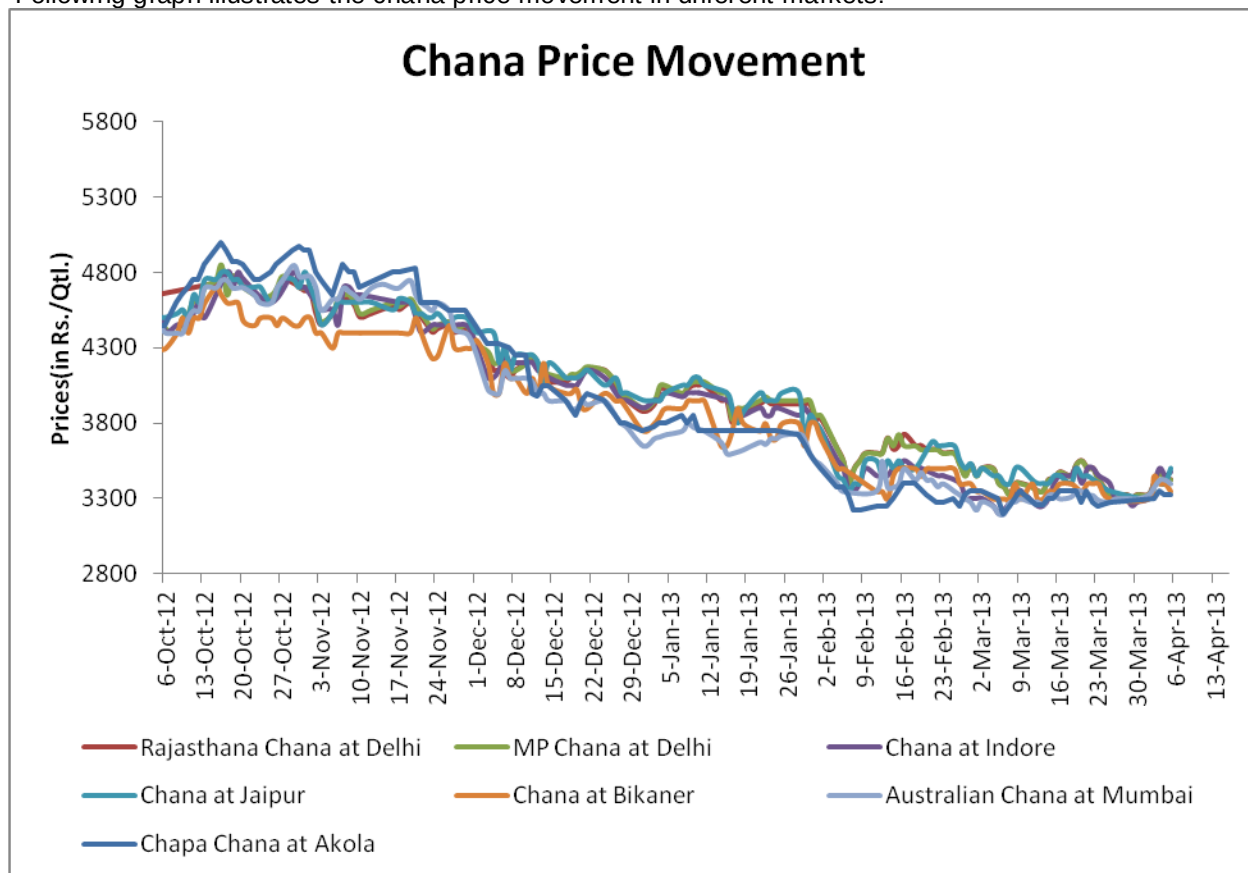
In this week, average prices at all centers remained mostly firm and increased by Rs.100 -125 per quintal.

In benchmark market Delhi "Lawrence Road", the average chana prices (of M.P. origin) remained firm and reached at Rs.3425 per quintal on higher arrivals. Chana at Indore market increased to Rs.3450 per quintal. Australian chana remained firm at Rs.3425 per quintal level. Moreover, chana at Bikaner markets remained firm at Rs.3400 per quintal.

Market participants revealed that --

- ✓ Delhi spot market, witnessed firm tone in chana (Rajasthan and M.P.) price on lower arrivals.
- ✓ Bikaner (Raj.) and Kanpur (U.P.) cash market, noticed firm tone in pulses on stockists buying.
- ✓ Indore (Raj.) local market, noticed positive tone in chana desi prices amid lack of availability of good quality chana.

Desi peas prices noticed firm tone on good demand during the week.

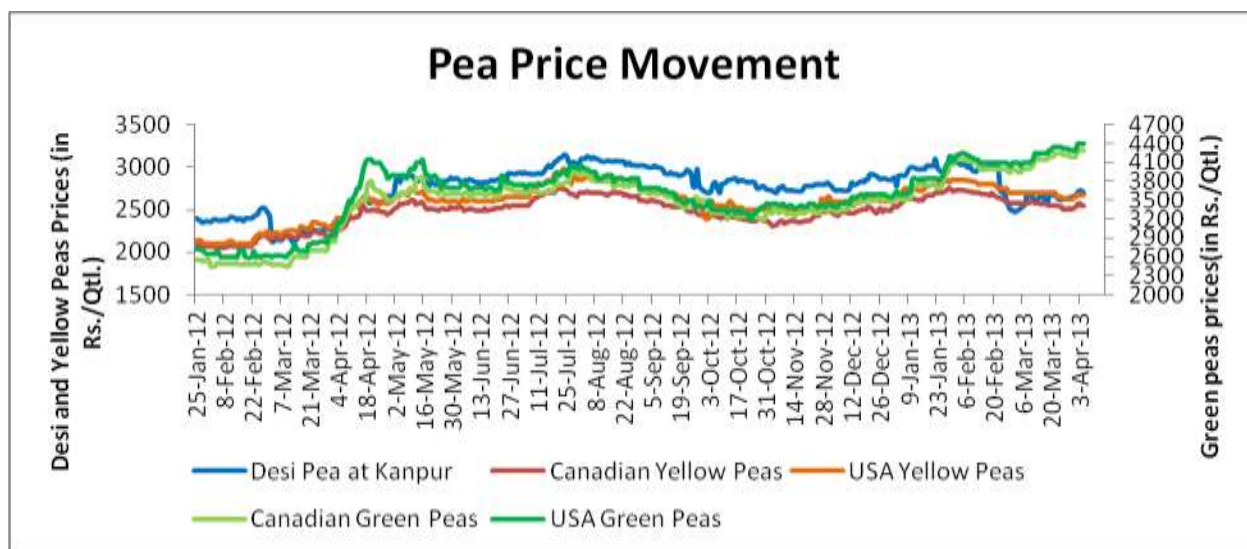
Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

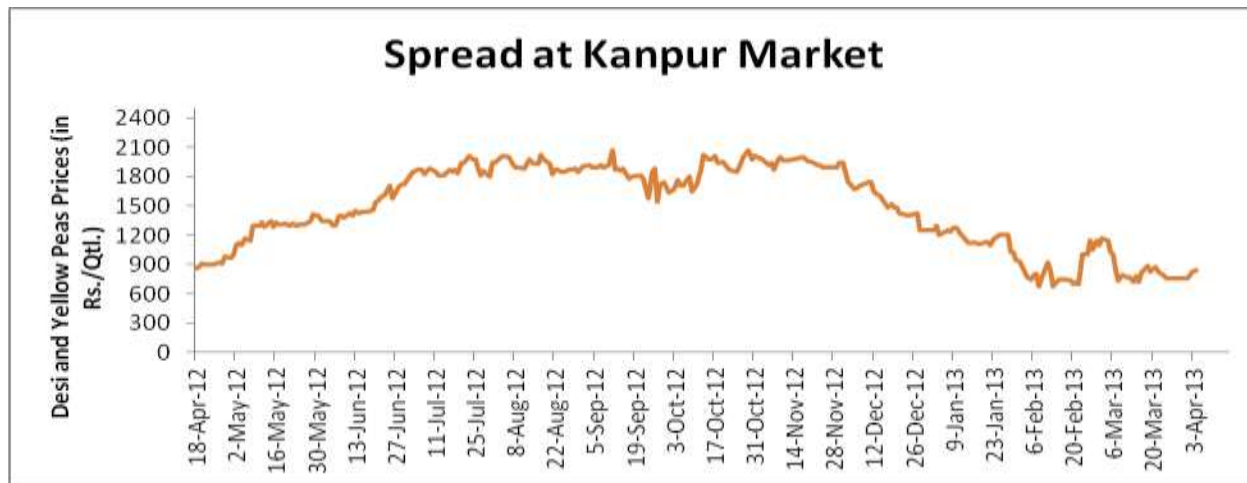
Market participants revealed that --

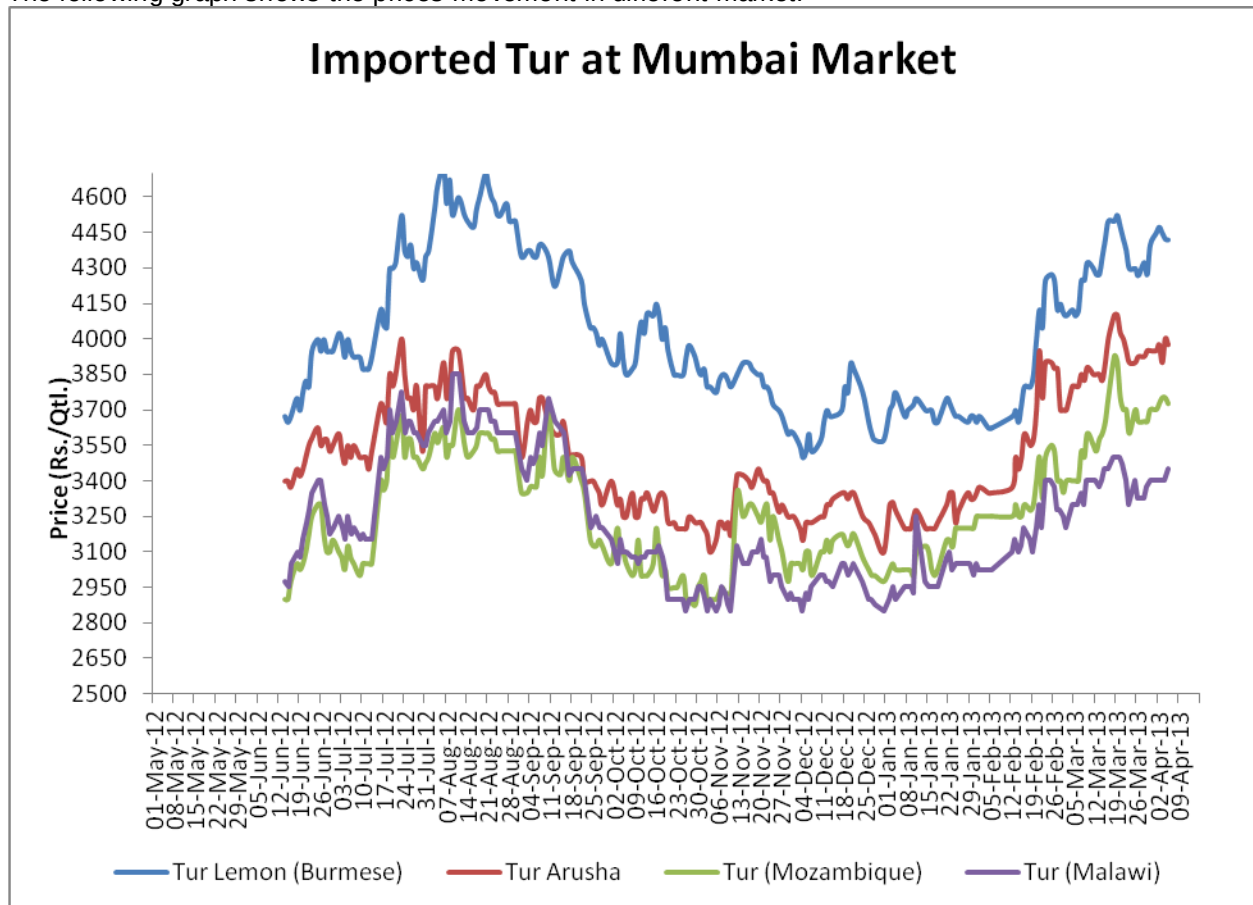
The price of imported Burmese lemon tur at Mumbai market up by Rs.100 per quintal to Rs.4425 per quintal.

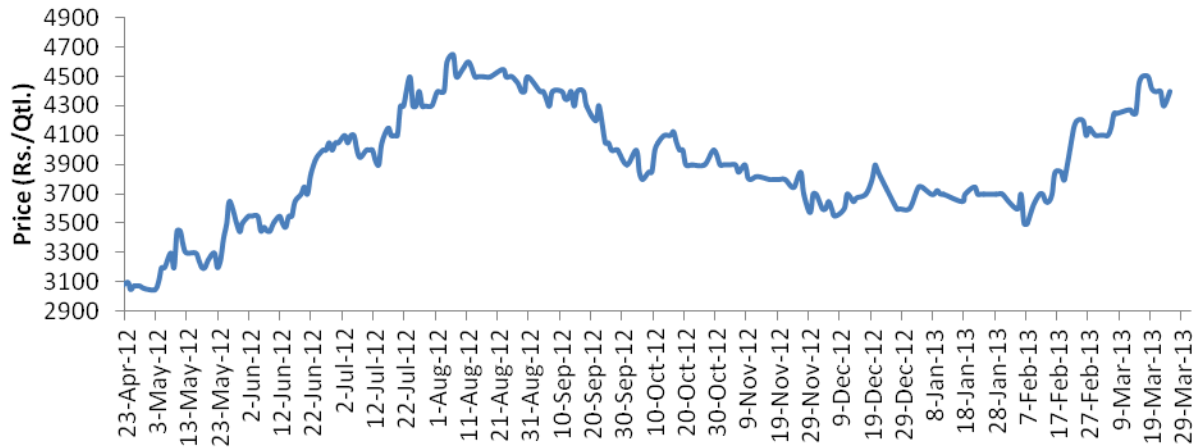

- ✓ Latur (Mah.) local market noticed firm tone in prices amid good demand from the millers.

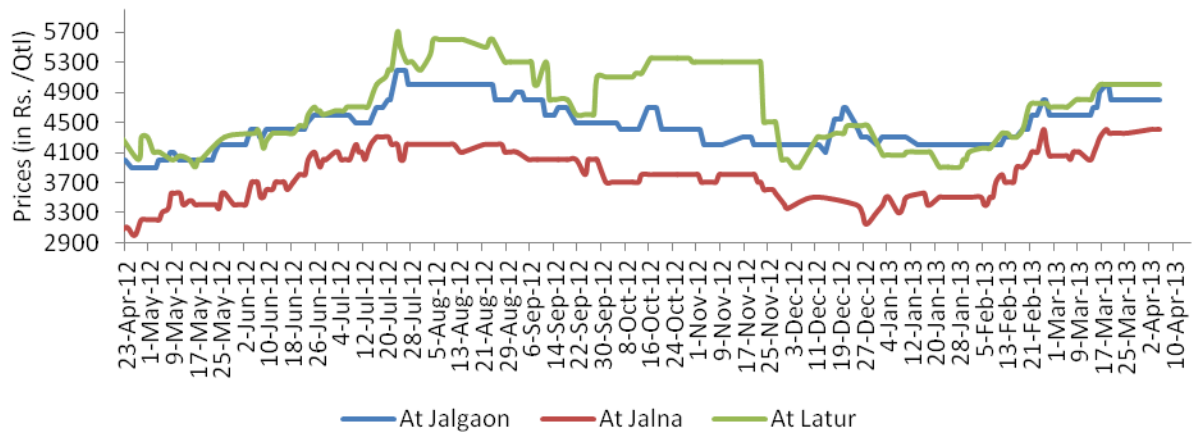

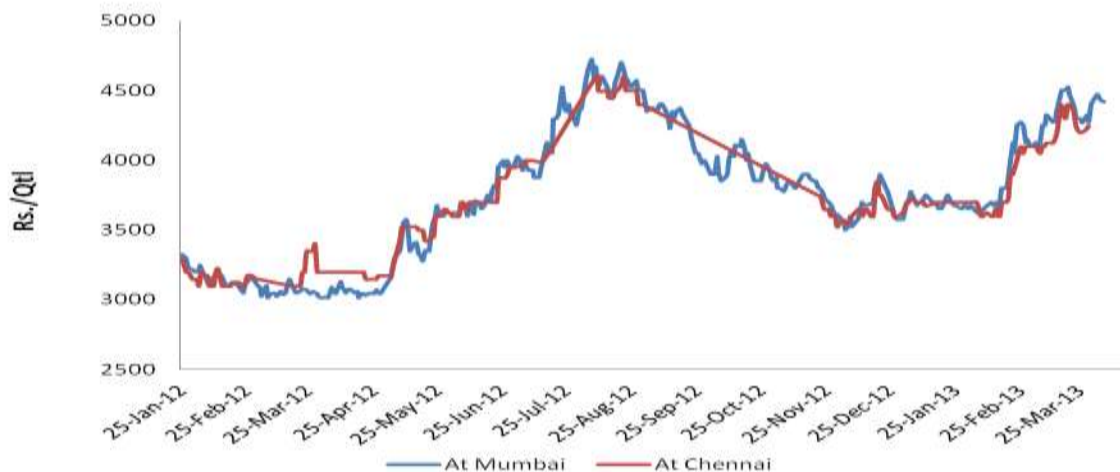

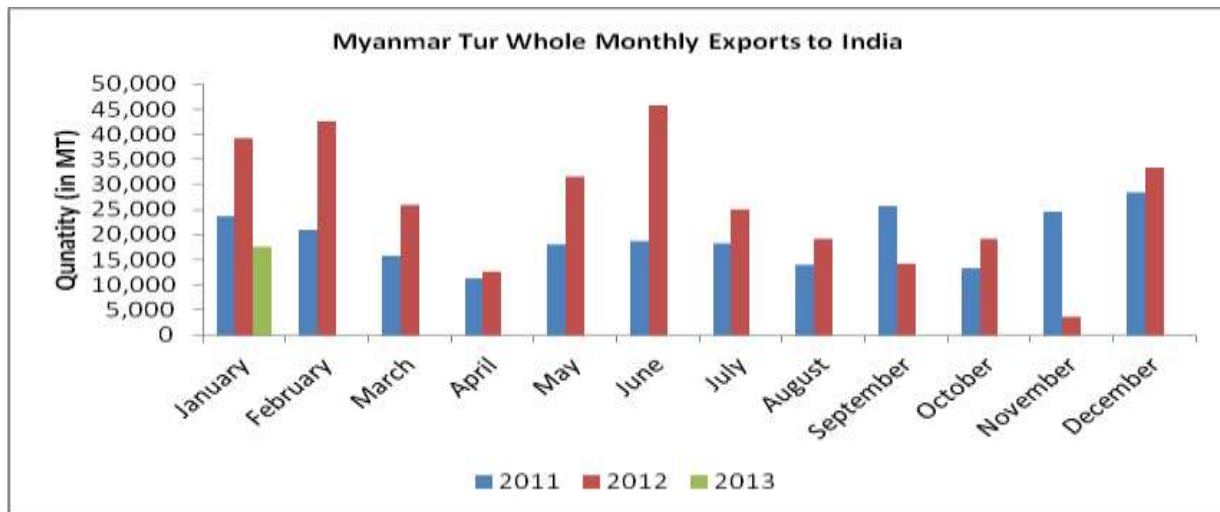

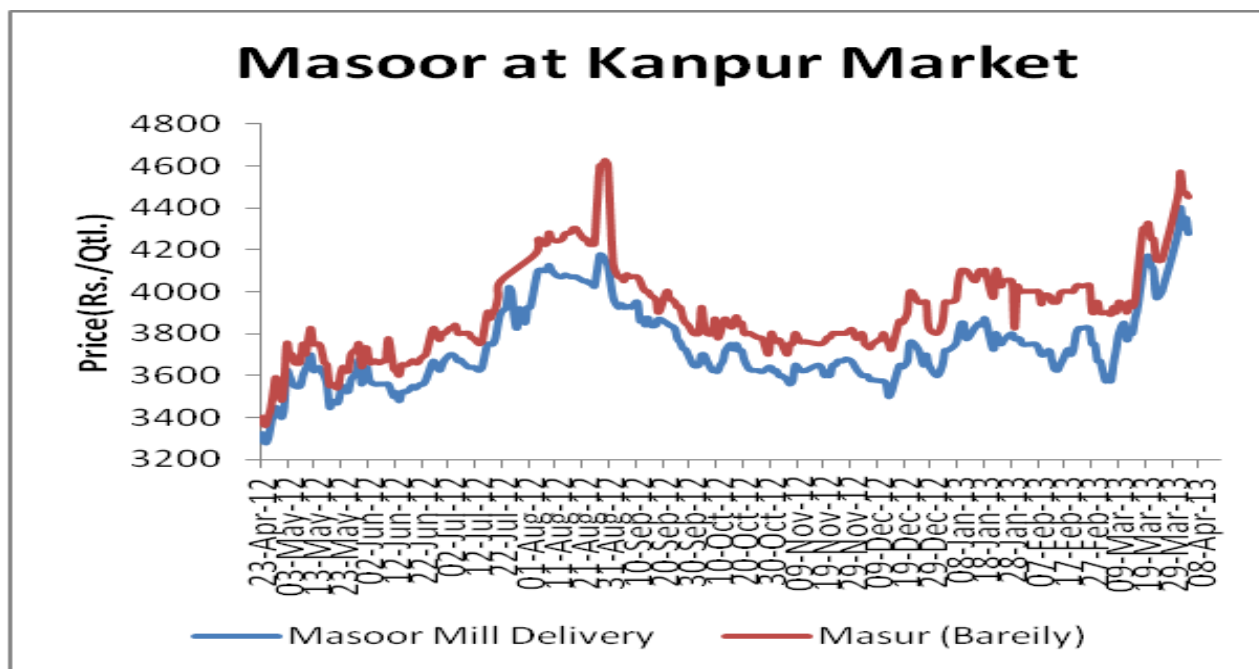
At Delhi prices remained firm at Rs.4150 per quintal. Moreover, prices remained firm at Rs.4275 per quintal at Indore market.

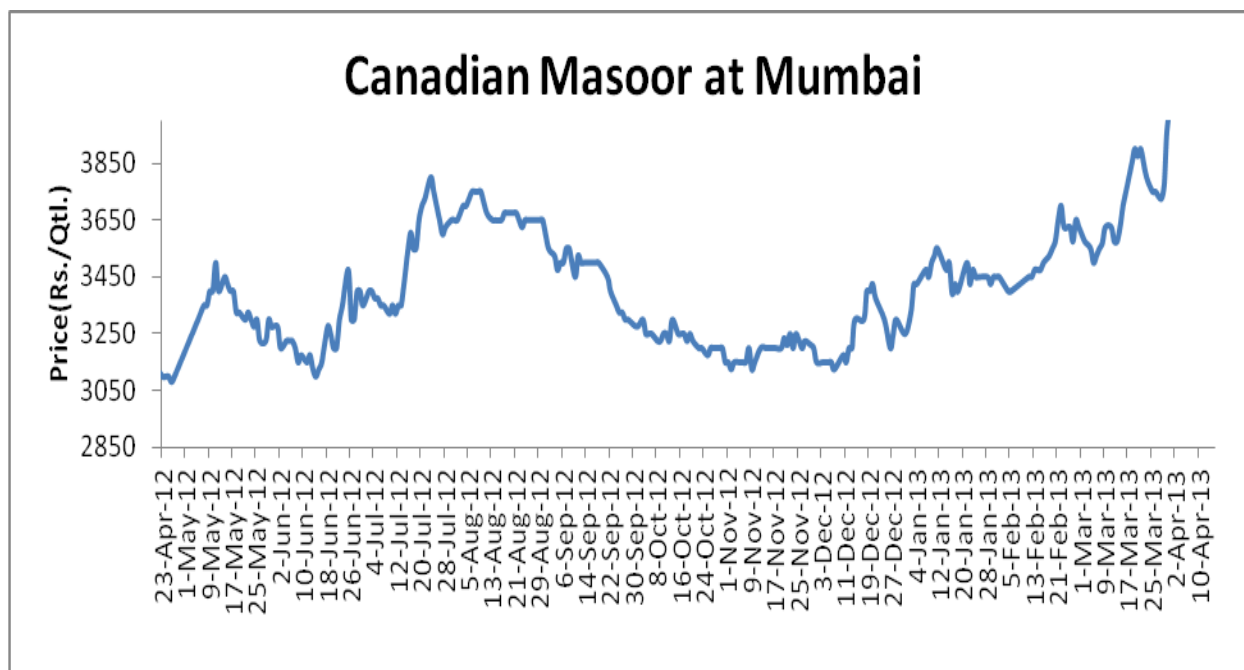
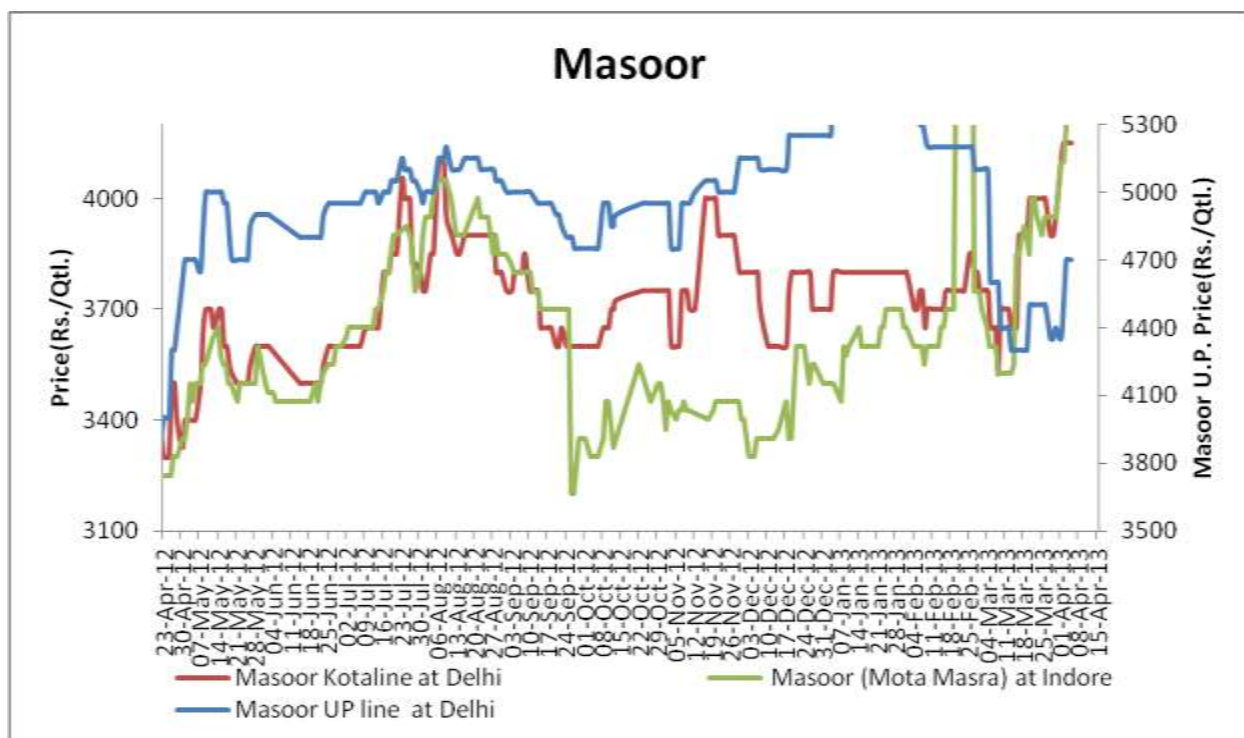
Moreover, the imported Canadian red lentils noticed bullish tone and prices increased by Rs.275 to Rs.4050 per quintal.

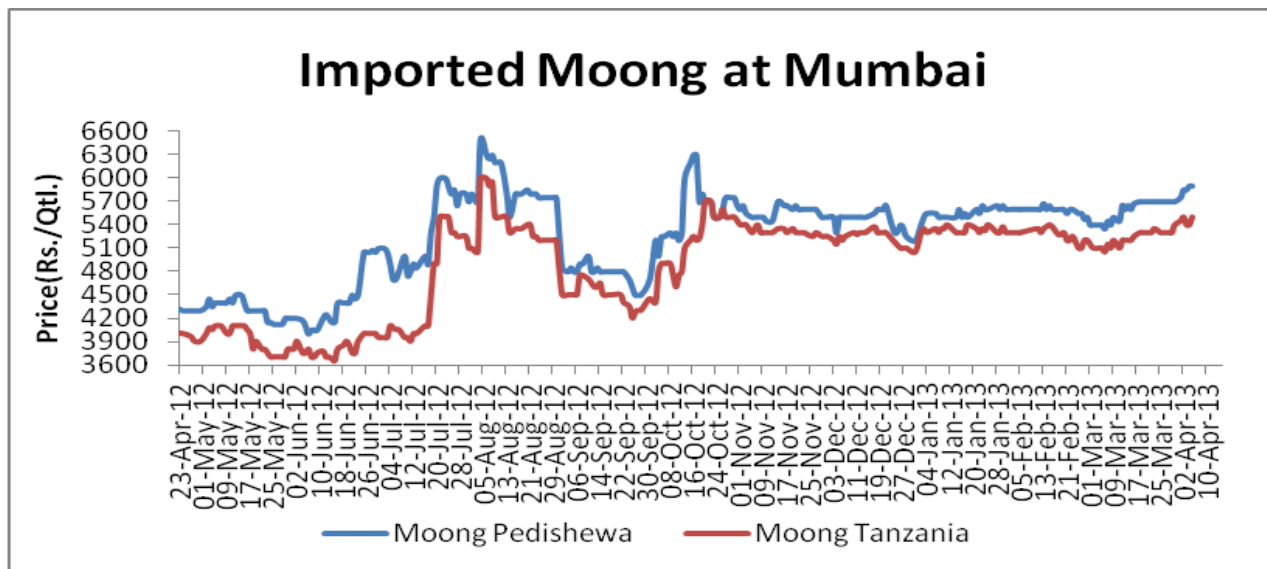

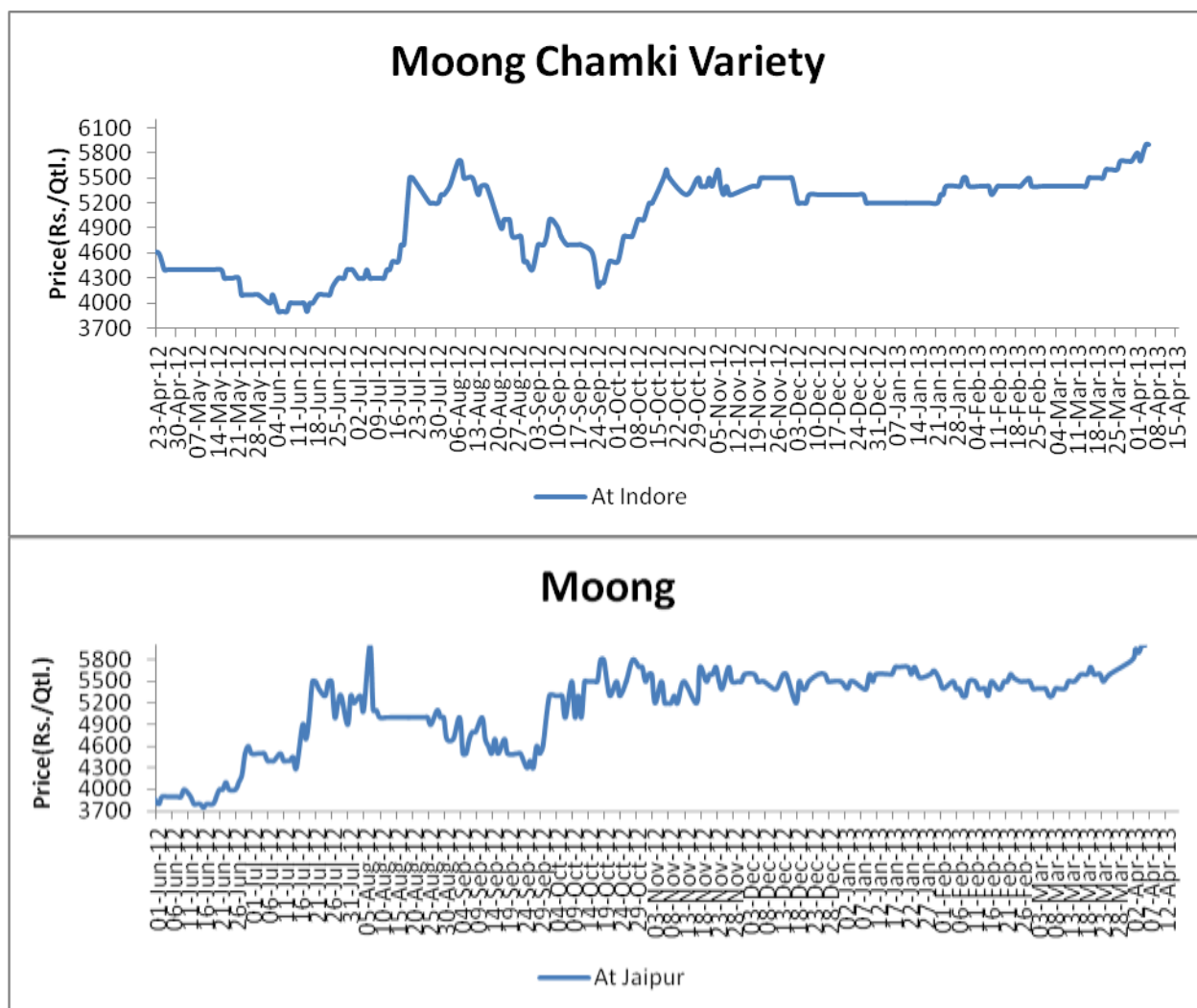

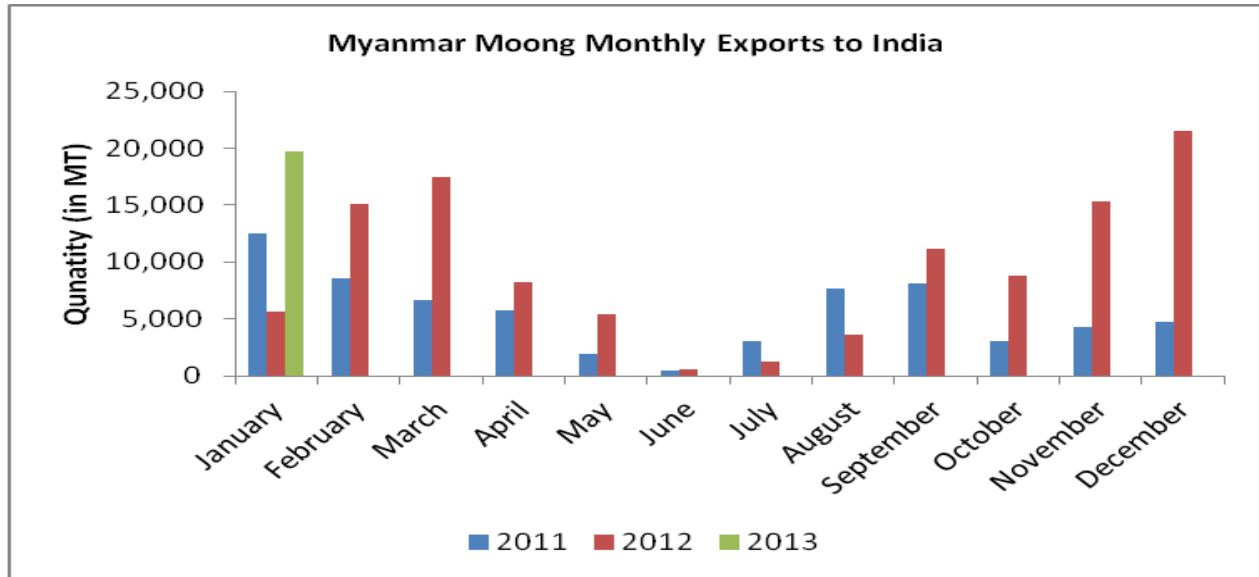

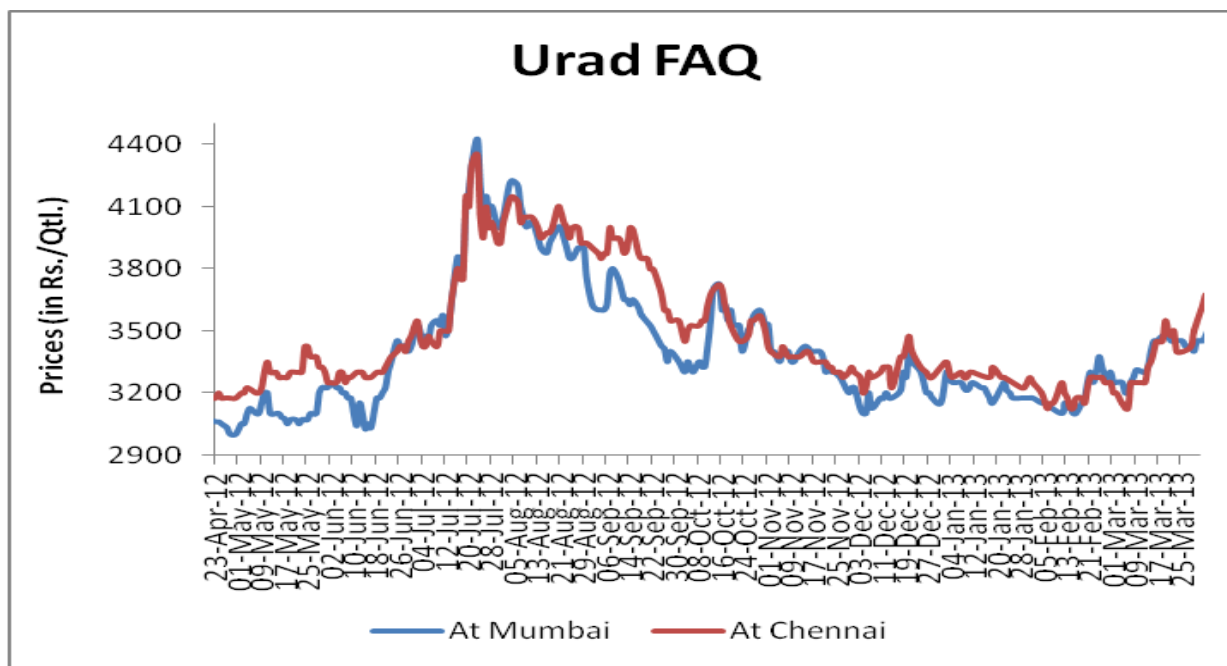

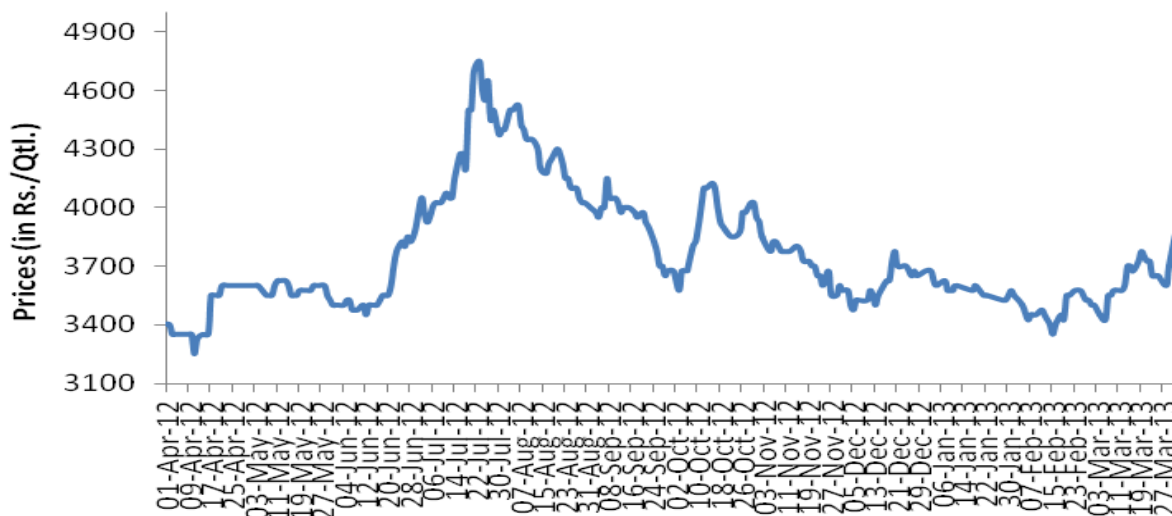

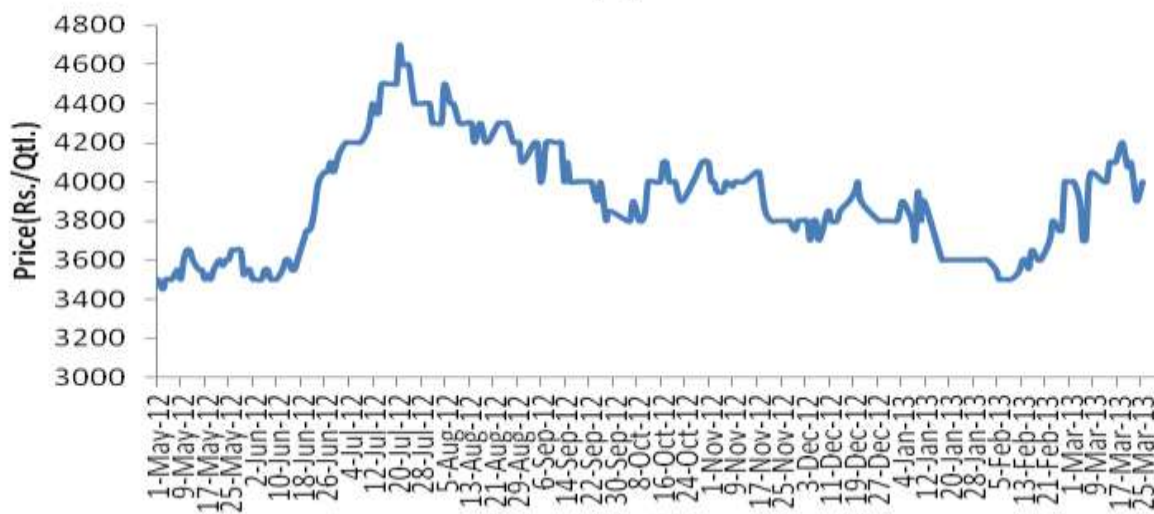
The following chart shows the urad prices movement in key markets:-



Urad SQ at Chennai



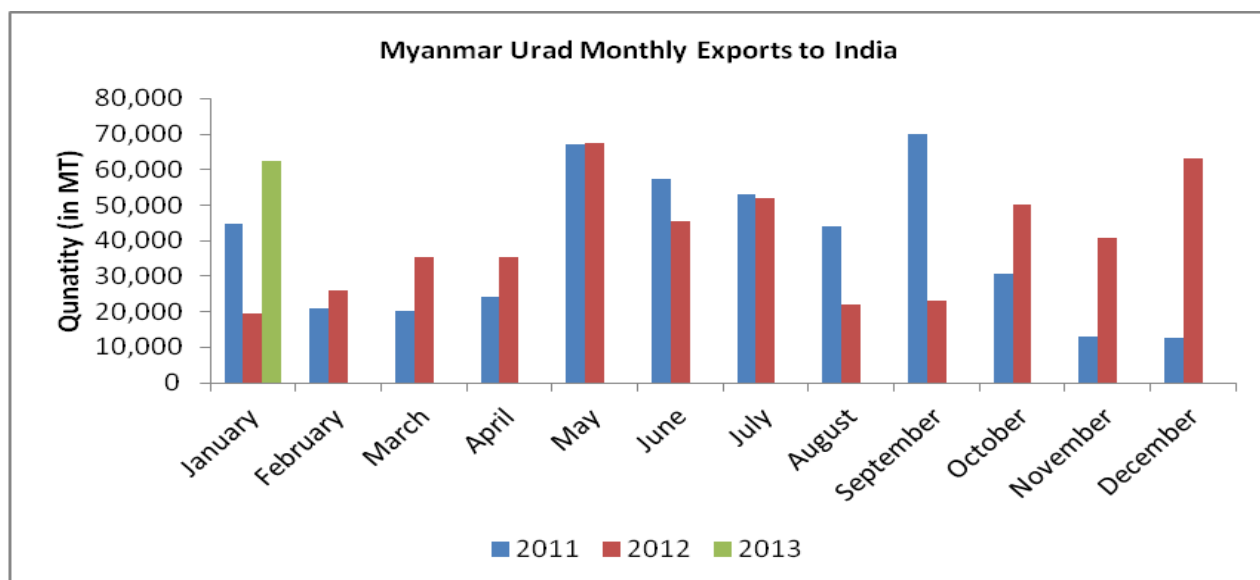
Urad Polished at Vijaywada market
