Commodity-wise Domestic, International Prices and Arrivals at Different Centers along with Processed pulses and wholesale Prices.

Highlights

- Pulses markets noticed mixed tone during the week except slight firmness in peas and masoor markets.
- Market participants revealed that –
 - ✓ New moong crop commenced at Pipariya (M.P.), traded at 4620 Rs/Qtl.
 - ✓ Ludhiana (Puj.) local market, reported new arrival of moong desi will come after 15 days.
 - ✓ New Delhi spot market, witnessed positive tone in chana (Raj. and M.P.) prices on enhanced demand.
 - ✓ Jaipur (Raj.) cash market, noticed dense tone in chana desi price on superior demand but turn down tone in moong price on sluggish demand.
 - ✓ Jalgaon, Latur (Mah.) and Guntur (A.P.) local markets, recorded unchanged tone in pulses prices on normal demand.
 - ✓ Bikaner (Raj.), Badnagar and Biaora (M.P.) spot markets, featured steady tone in chana price on slow demand.
 - ✓ Kanpur (U.P.), Akola (Mah.), Gotegaon and Neemuch (M.P.) cash markets, witnessed positive tone in pulses prices on good demand.
 - ✓ Gulbarga (Kar.) and Rajgarh (M.P.) local markets, reported bearish tone in chana prices on higher arrivals.
 - ✓ Dabra (M.P.) cash market, witnessed bearish tone in masoor medium price on higher arrivals.
- Chana prices noticed slight recovery in between amid buying interest around lower levels.
- Moong prices are likely to continue weak tone in the domestic market amid lack of demand and increasing new crop arrivals.
- Under the National Food Security Mission, subsidy is given to farmers who undertake sowing of moong as third crop during March –April period. Farmers have started this in the districts of Hoshanagabad and Harda of Madhya Pradesh.
- There is not much activity in lentils in Canada during the previous week amid seeding progress.

- Warm and favourable weather has allowed seeding to pick up in parts of southwestern and west-central Saskatchewan during the week (May 14 –May 20, 2013) and twenty -seven percent of the seeding has been completed, according to Saskatchewan Agriculture's Weekly Crop Report compared to last week's eight percent. It is lower than five year's average progress of forty –four percent.

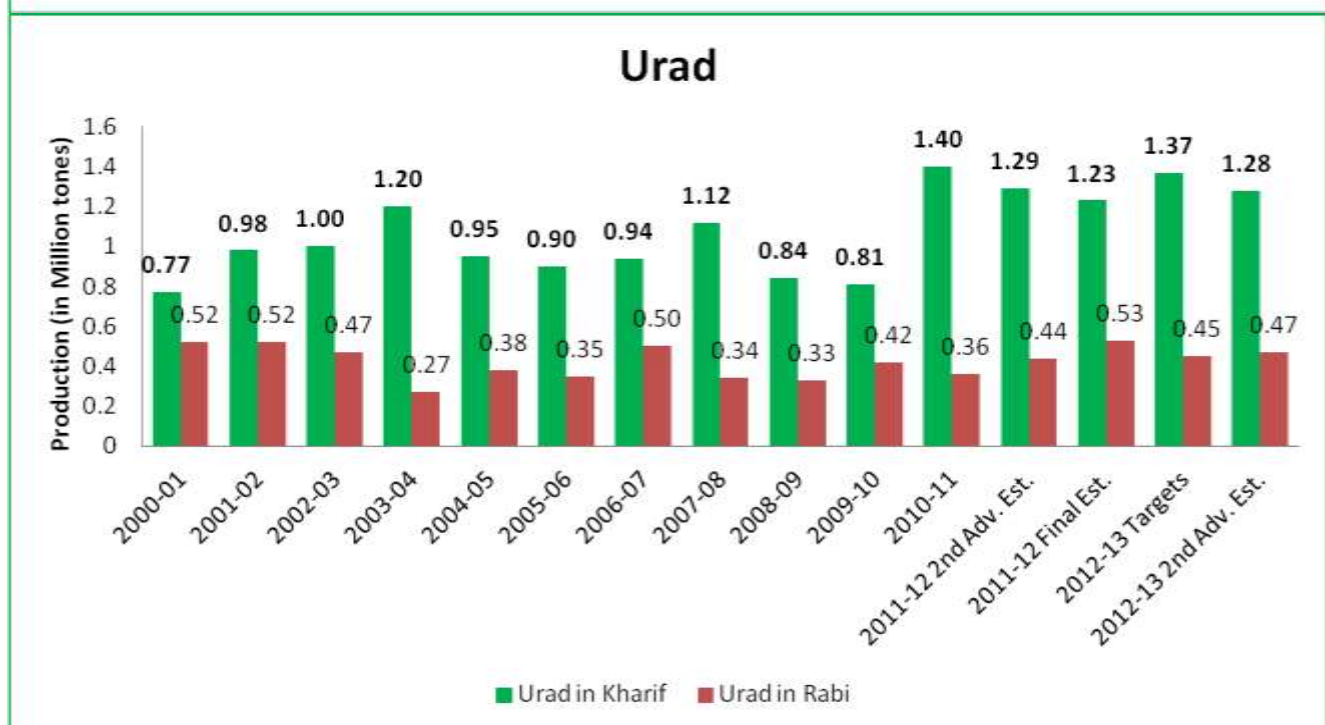
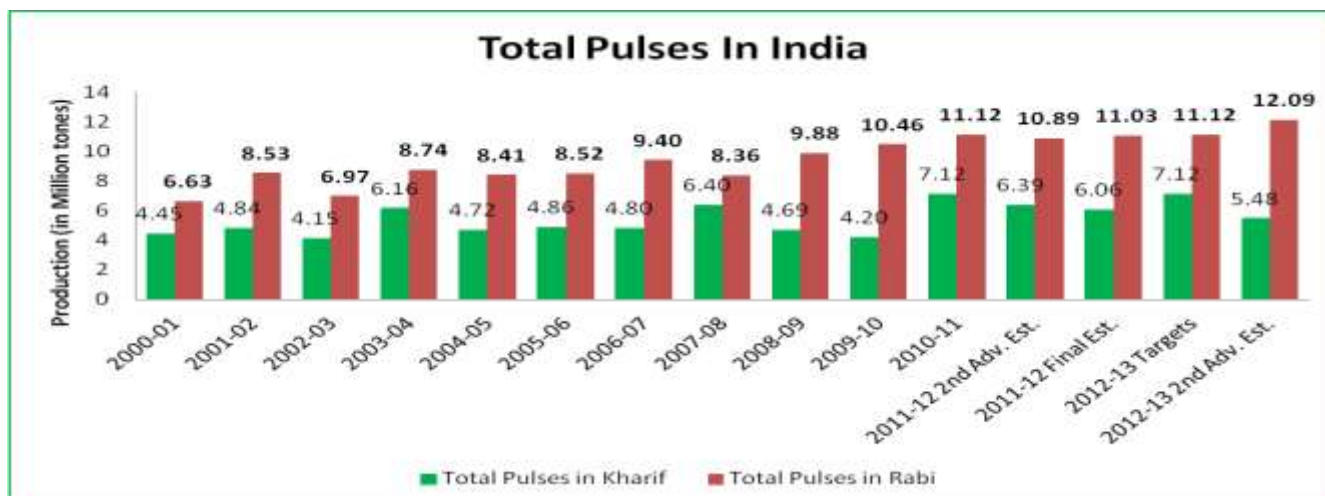

Weekly Port Updates

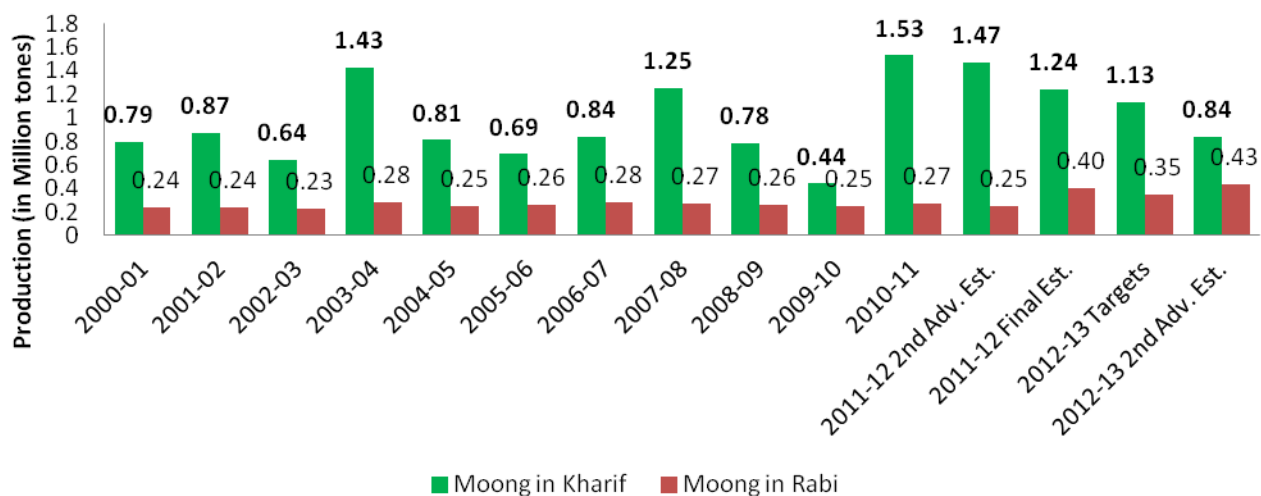
- At Mumbai port, 30 containers of Burma tur, 6 containers of Burma tur dal, 10 containers of Burma urad, 17 containers of Burma moong, 8 containers of Canada masoor, 5 containers of China chitra rajma, 2 containers of China red rajma, 3 containers of Ethiopia red rajma, 1 containers of Madagascar choulra, 2 containers of Madagascar rajma, 10 containers of Burma rajma and 12 containers of Burma choulra has arrived.
- At Chennai port, 159 containers of urad, 46 containers of green moong beans, 14 containers of tur whole, 102 containers of masoor, 18 containers of yellow peas, 2 containers of green peas, 2 containers of kidney beans, 7 containers of cow peas and 6 containers of mausmi chana has arrived.
- Vessel named Aruna Ismail containing 53660 MTS of Yellow Peas and Lentils arrived at Mumbai port.

3rd Advance Estimates by MOA: Pulses output at 18.00 mn tonnes

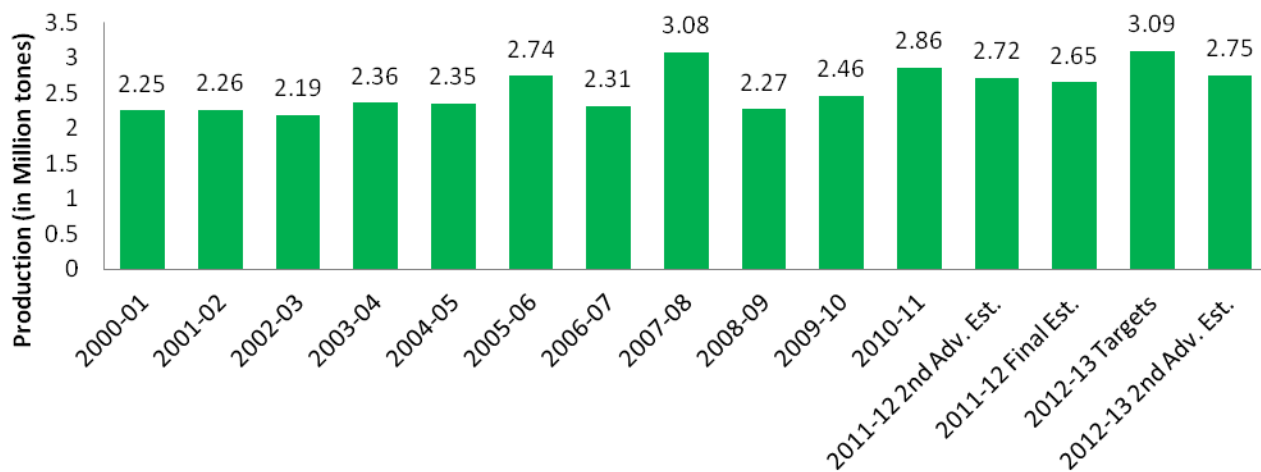
- MOA revealed that the country pulses production in 2012-13 is likely to around 18.00 million tonnes according to 3rd advance estimates.
- In the 3rd advance estimates, urad production has been increased to 1.87 million tonnes, tur to 3.04 million tonnes and chana and moong production has declined to 8.49 million tonnes and 1.18 million tonnes respectively. The graph below shows the 2nd advance estimates.
- The target for pulses has been set at 18.24 million tonnes during the year.
- India needs to import as its required pulses domestic production is insufficient to meet the rising demand. The country's import bill on pulses stood at \$1.83 billion in 2011-12.



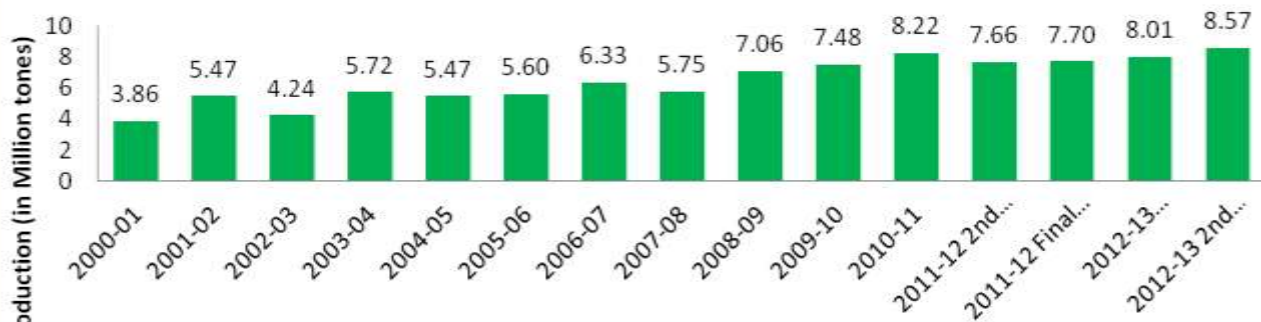

Rabi Sowing Progress:-

- MOA revealed that Rabi pulses sowing increased to 150.82 lakh ha. as on Feb. 15th, 2013 in comparison with 147.46 lakh ha. during the same period in last year. Meanwhile, chana sown area surged to 94.99 lakh ha. as compared from 89.95 lakh ha. in last year.

Market Recap:

Chana prices continued mostly weak tone during the week.

Current Scenario:

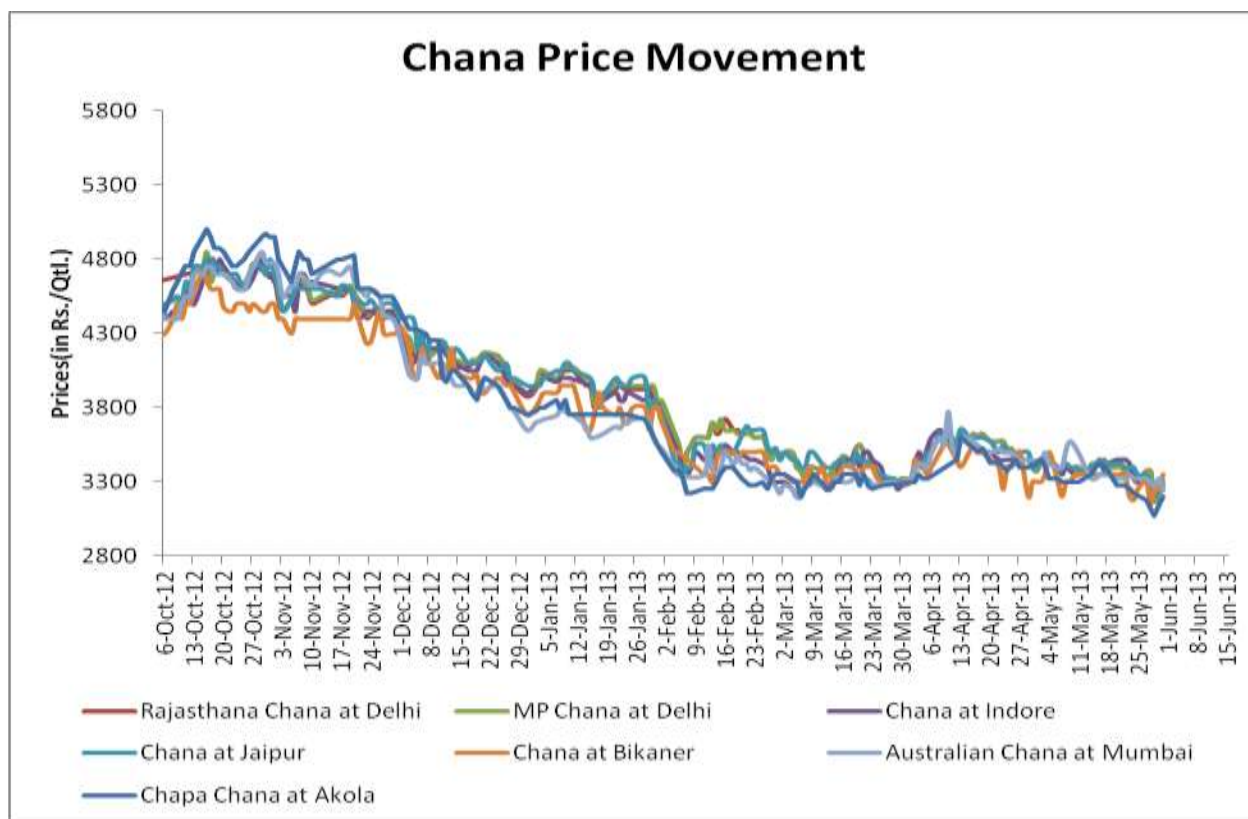
In this week, average prices at all centers remained mostly weak and prices declined by Rs. 100 -150 per quintal on an average..

In benchmark market Delhi "Lawrence Road", the average chana prices (of M.P. origin) remained weak and reached at Rs.3225 per quintal on higher arrivals. Chana at Indore market remained weak at Rs.3300 per quintal. Australian chana remained weak at Rs.3325 per quintal level. Moreover, chana at Bikaner market remained firm at Rs.3250 per quintal.

Market participants revealed that --

- ✓ Delhi spot market, witnessed bearish tone in chana prices on higher arrivals.
- ✓ Bikaner (Raj.) spot market noticed firm tone on buying interest around lower levels in the ready market.
- ✓ Australian chana continued weak tone amid lack of fresh buying inquiry.

Following graph illustrates the chana price movement in different markets:-

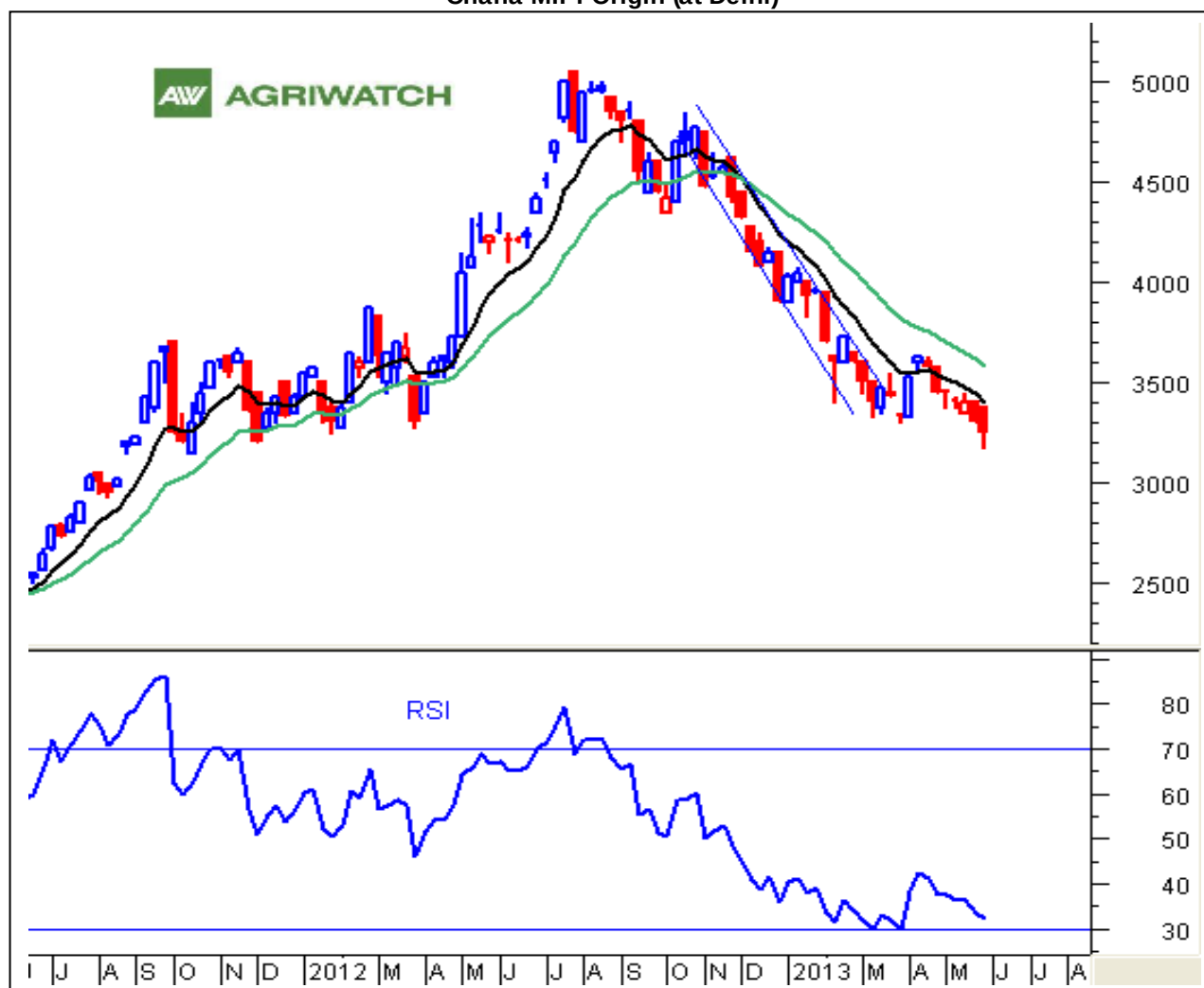

Desi peas prices noticed steady to firm tone during the week.

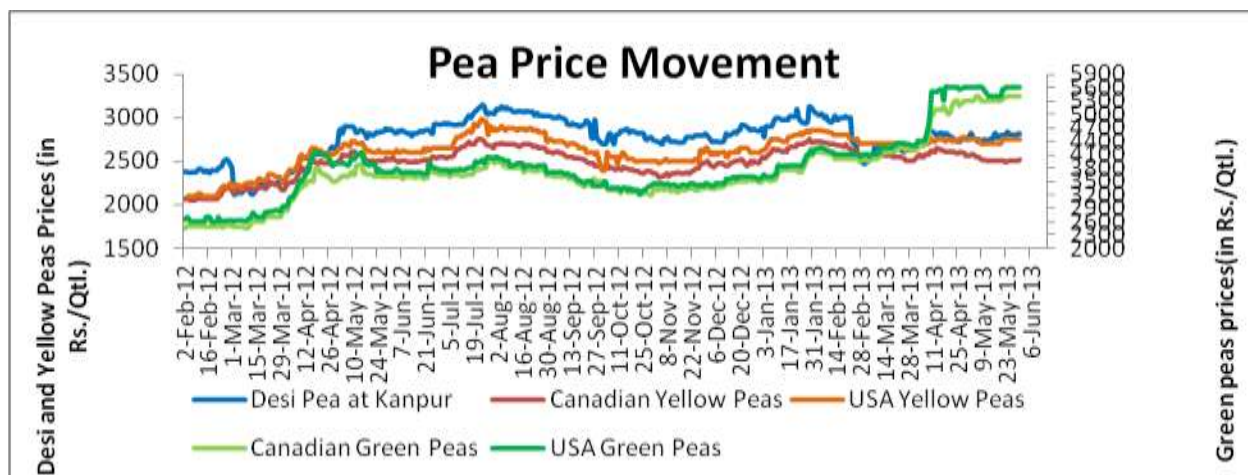
Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

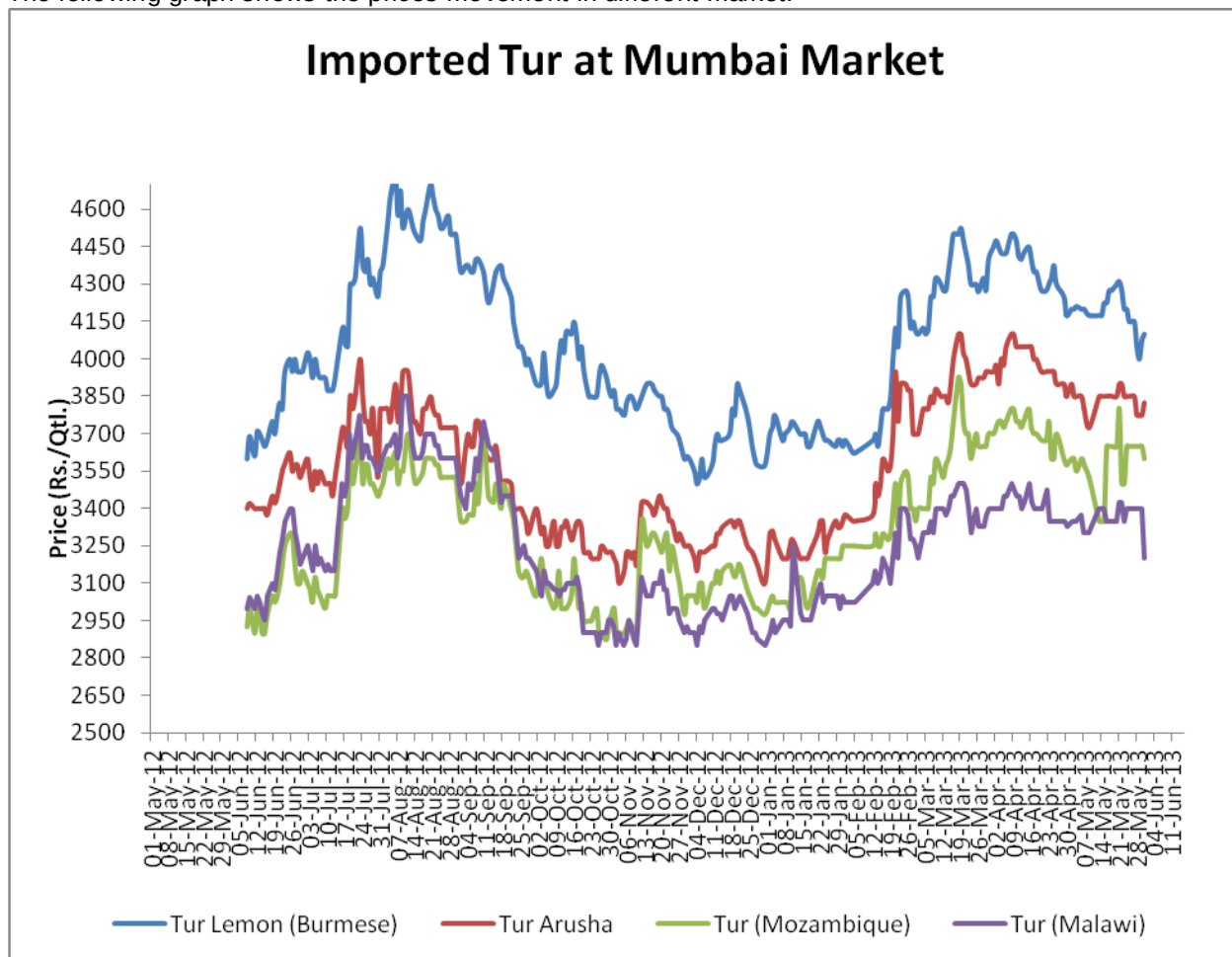

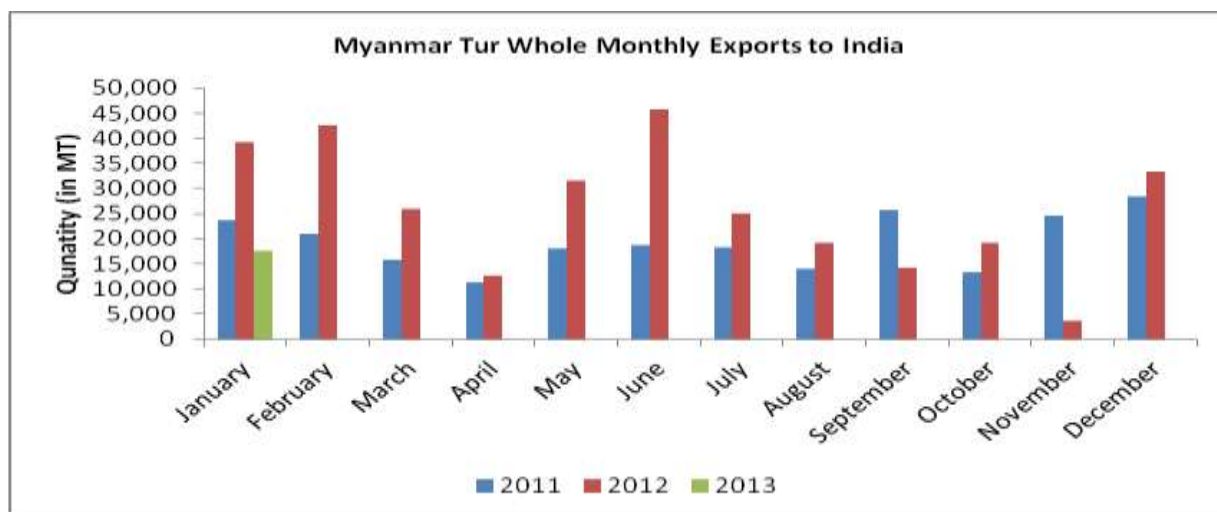


Red Tur at Gulbarga Market

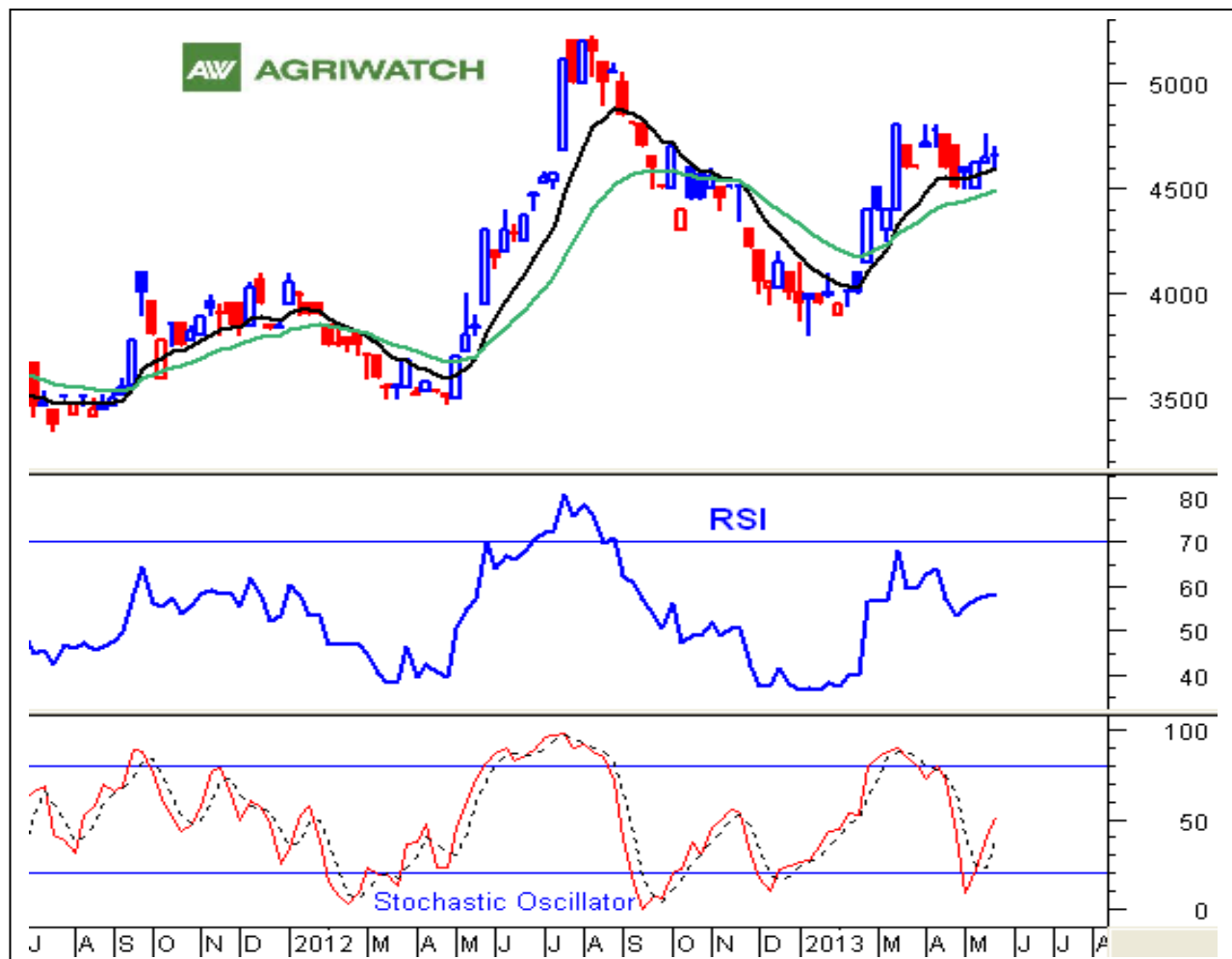

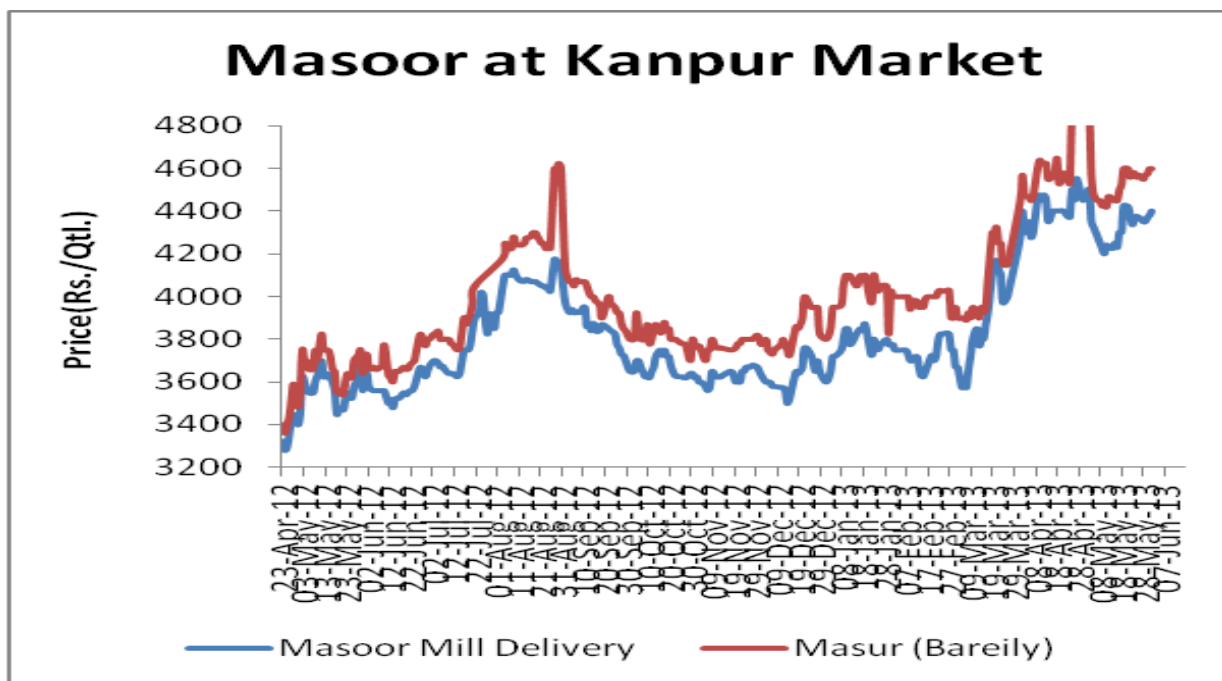
At Delhi prices remained firm at Rs.4300/Qtl. Moreover, prices remained weak at Rs.4275 per quintal at Indore market.

Moreover, the imported Canadian red lentils noticed steady tone and prices remained at Rs.4050 per quintal.

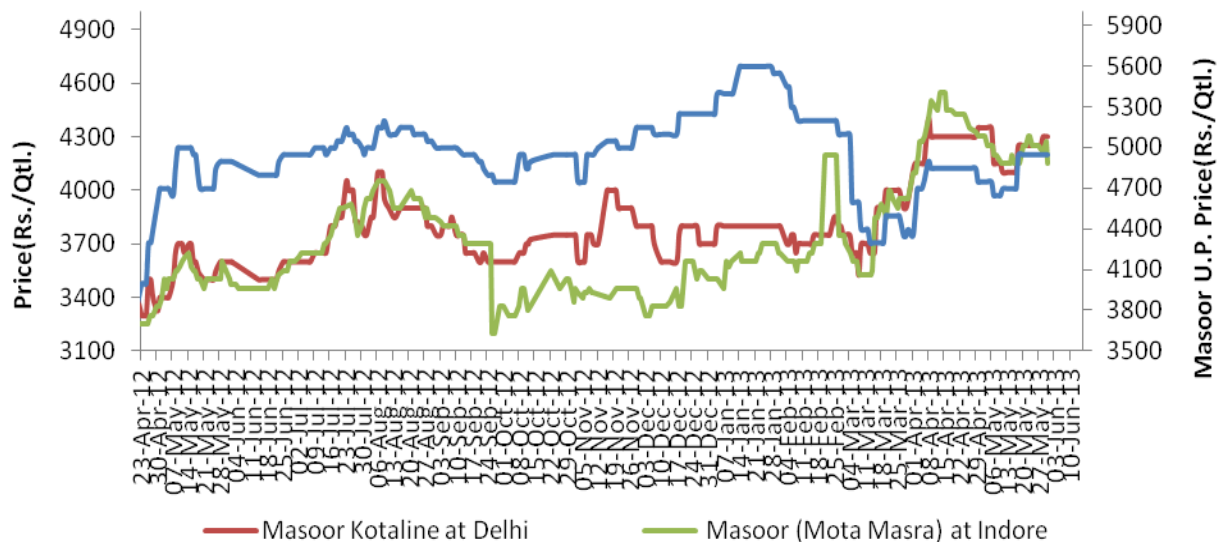

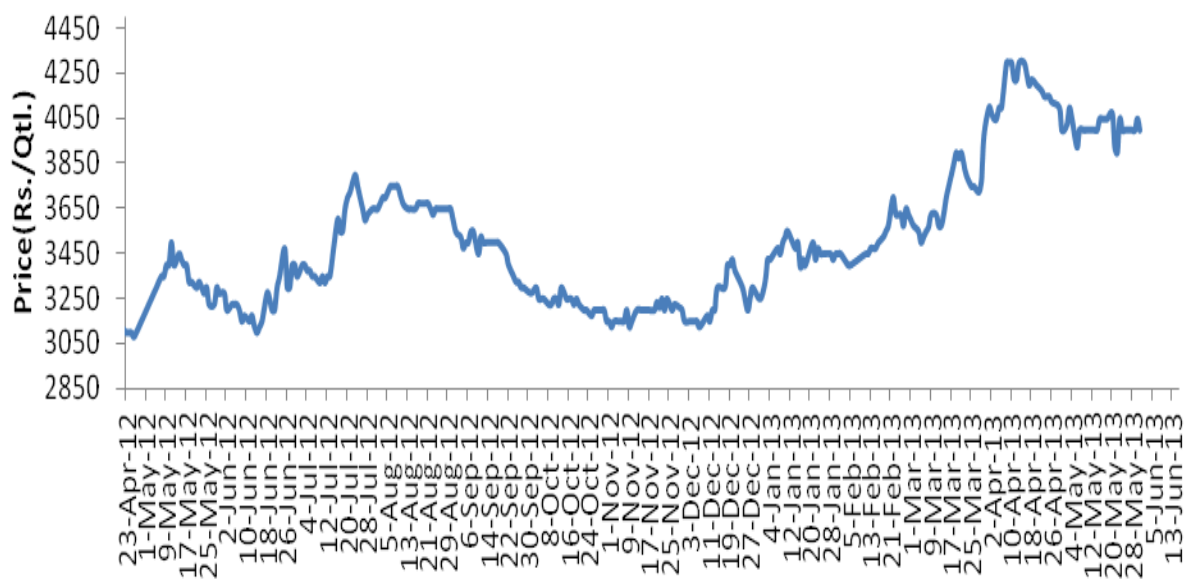

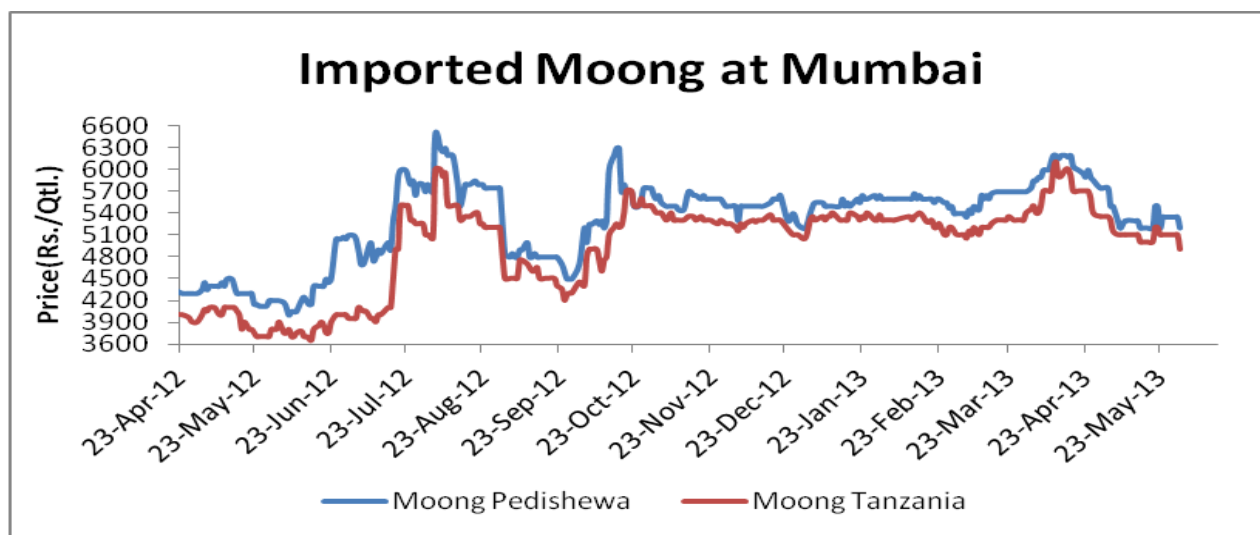

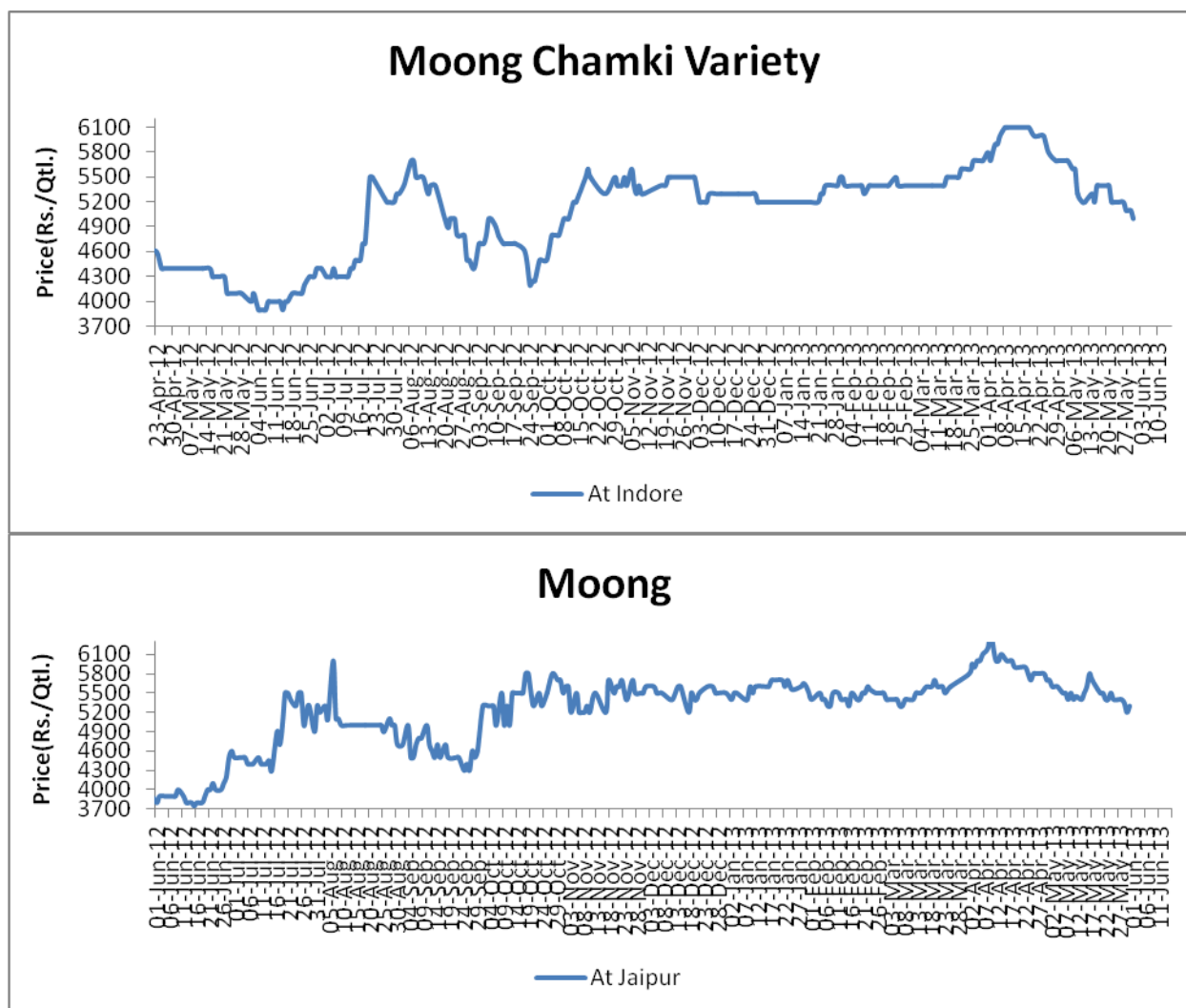

- ✓ In Indore (M.P.), arrival of new moong reported in mandis and trading around Rs.5100/Qtl.

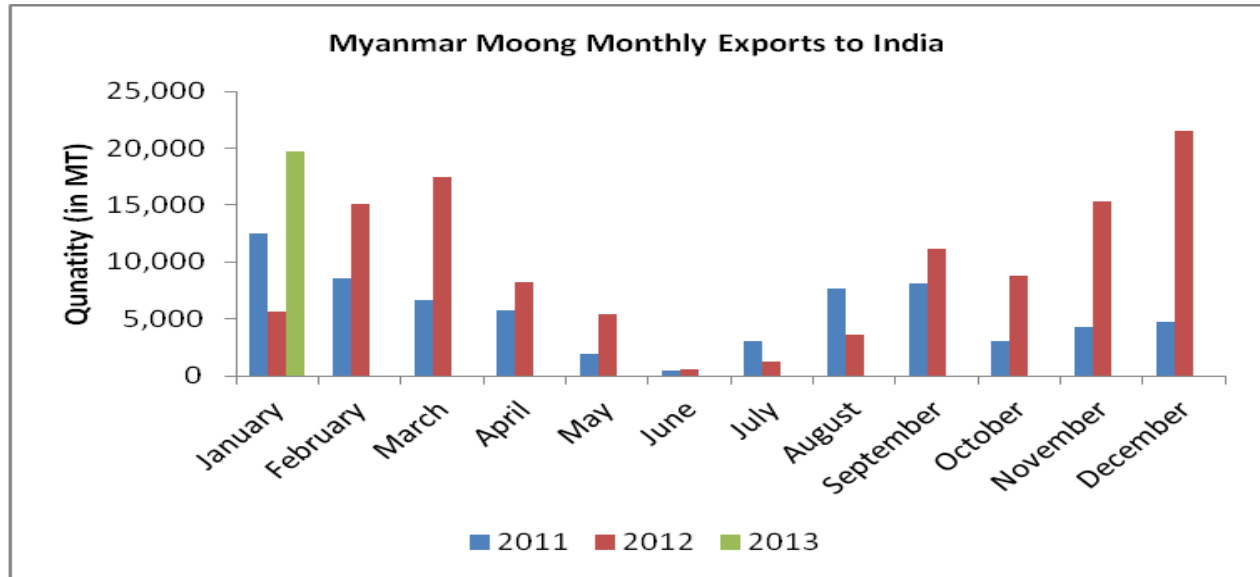

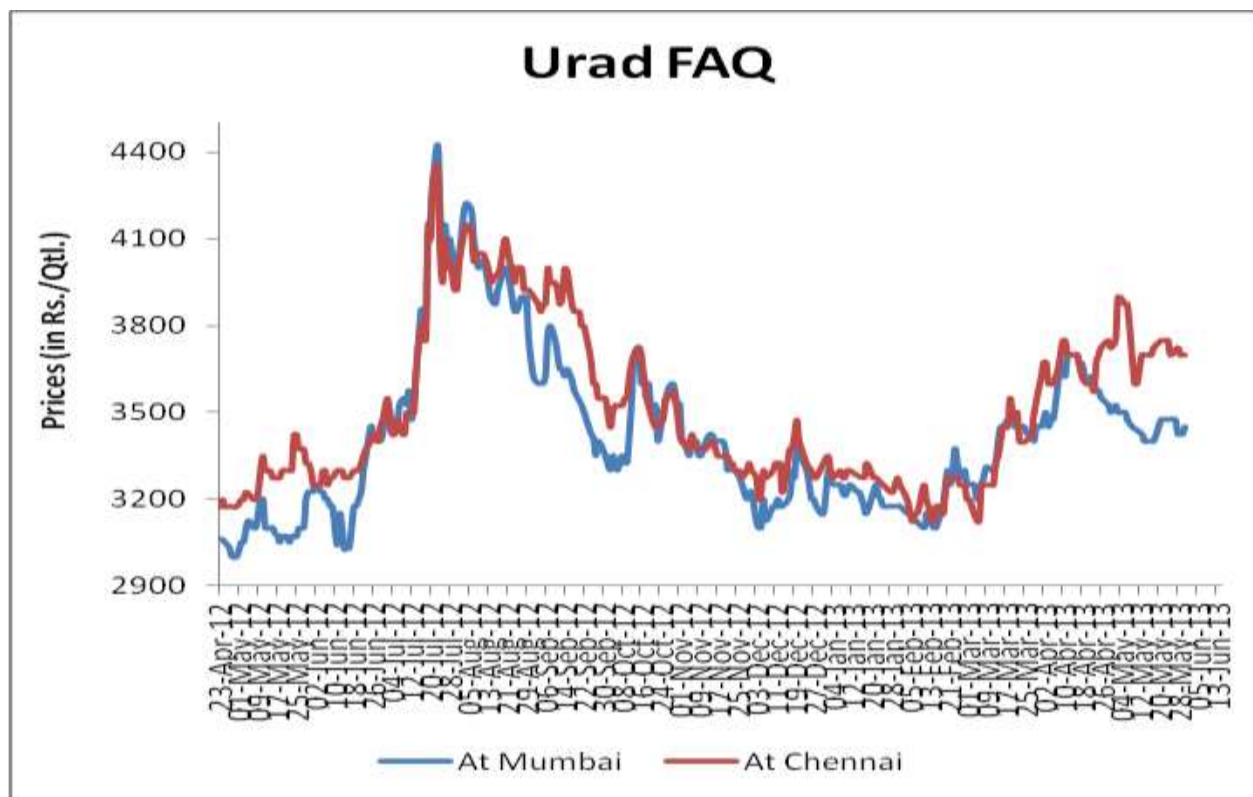

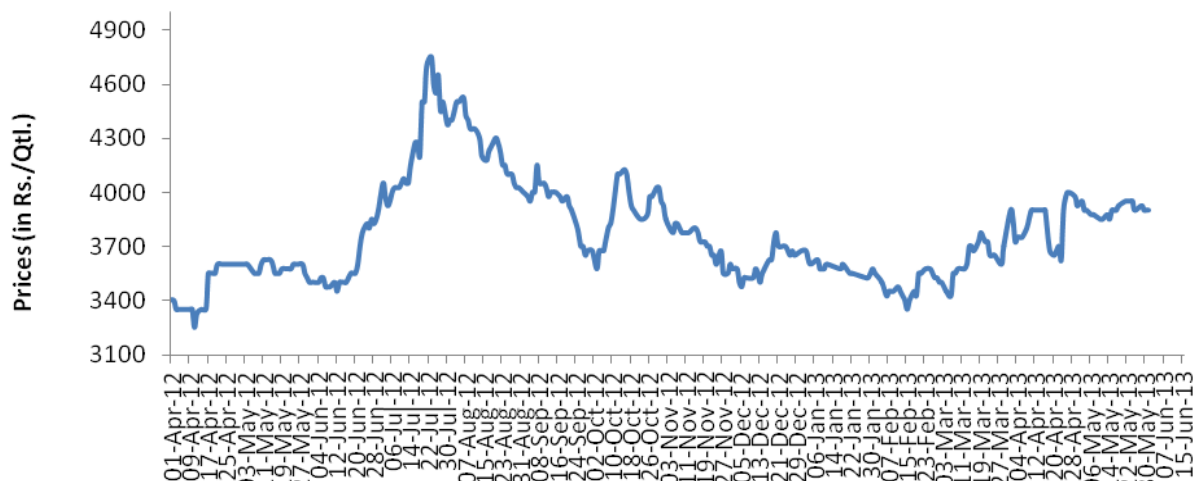

Urad SQ at Chennai



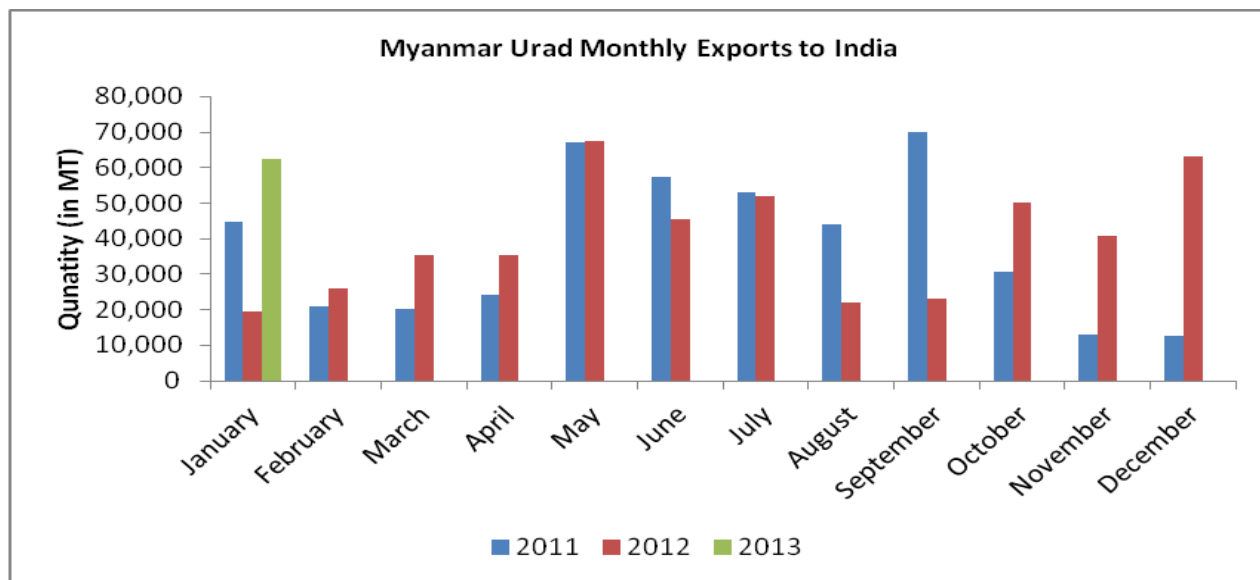
