Summary

- Pulses markets noticed mostly steady to firm tone during the week.
- Market participants revealed that:-
 - ✓ Desi Chana at Delhi market opened firm amid festival demand in the market.
 - ✓ Dabra (MP.) chana noticed steady tone on sluggish demand in the market.
 - ✓ Indore (M.P.) masoor offered steady amid slow demand at local market.
 - ✓ Burmese Lemon Tur in Mumbai (Mah.) noticed firm tone on fresh buying inquiry in the market.
- Urad and moong will be steady to firm in the coming days on lower crop arrivals in various mandis.
- Chana prices are likely to decline in the medium -term amid slow demand, adequate stocks and arrival of imported chana in the domestic market.
- Lower arrivals of urad and moong in various mandis is adding to the positive tone of the market.
- PEC has issued a tender for sale of imported chickpeas (chana) and different varieties of pigeon pea (tur). Tender will close on 1st November 2013.
- Rabi Pulses Sowing in Maharashtra till 25th October, 2013 (in '00 Ha)- Chana sowing has been done in 695.75 hectares, Other pulses in 66.27 hectares.
- According to government of Andhra Pradesh, total pulses sowing in the state have been covered in 3.63 lakh hectares compared to 2.15 lakh hectares during the same period last year as on 30th October, 2013 in the current rabi season.
- According to Ministry of Agriculture, acreage under rabi pulses till date is reported at 8.8 lakh hectares compared to 5.98 lakh hectares during the same period last year.
- According to sources, Ministry of Agriculture has proposed levy of import duty on pulses.
- According to IBIS, imports of urad and moong in the month of September increased to 0.48 lakh metric tonnes compared to 0.41 lakh metric tonnes during the previous month.
- Pulses markets in Burma noticed steady tone amid sluggish demand in the ready market.

- According to Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, import of pulses during the period July –September in the current year declined to 116,685 metric tonnes compared to 173,199 metric tonnes during the same period previous year.
- Chickpeas prices in Canada noticed weak tone amid large –carryover stocks in the domestic market and lower demand from India.
- Lentils prices in Canada noticed firm tone amid good demand from Turkey.
- Ninety –nine percent of the 2013 crop in Saskatchewan has been harvested during the week (October 15 -21) according to the Saskatchewan Agriculture's Weekly Crop Report. Weather has been favourable for harvesting and some of the chickpeas are being combined in the region.

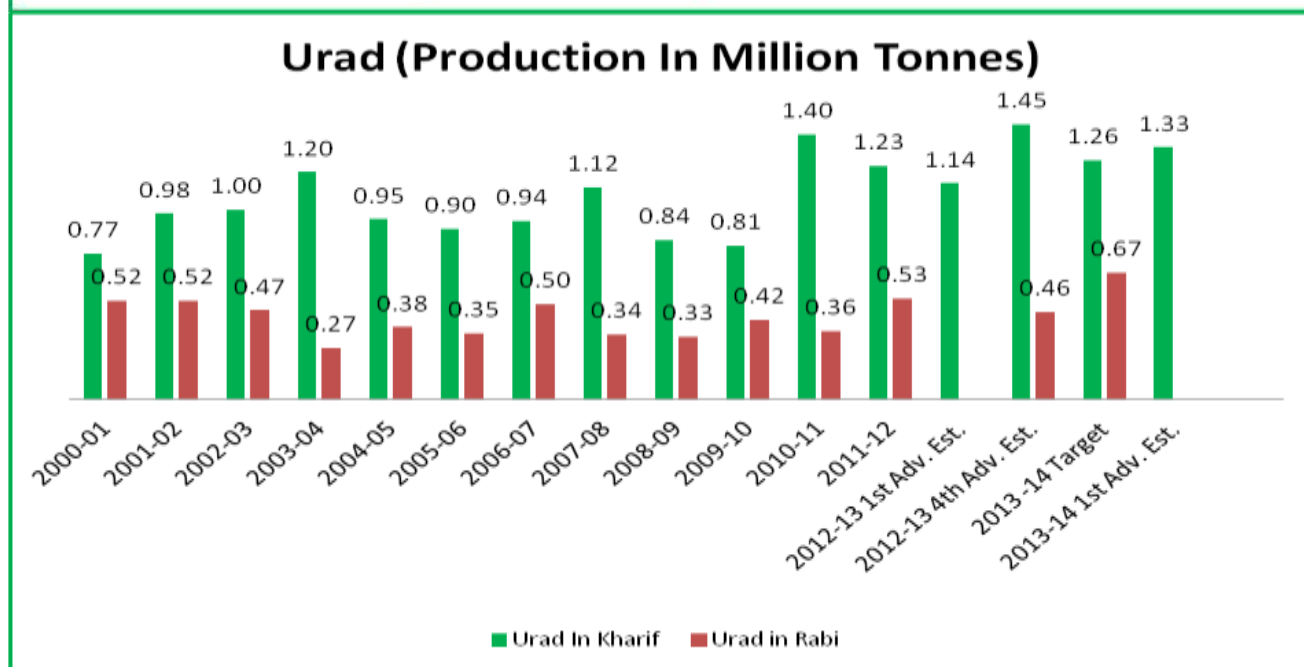
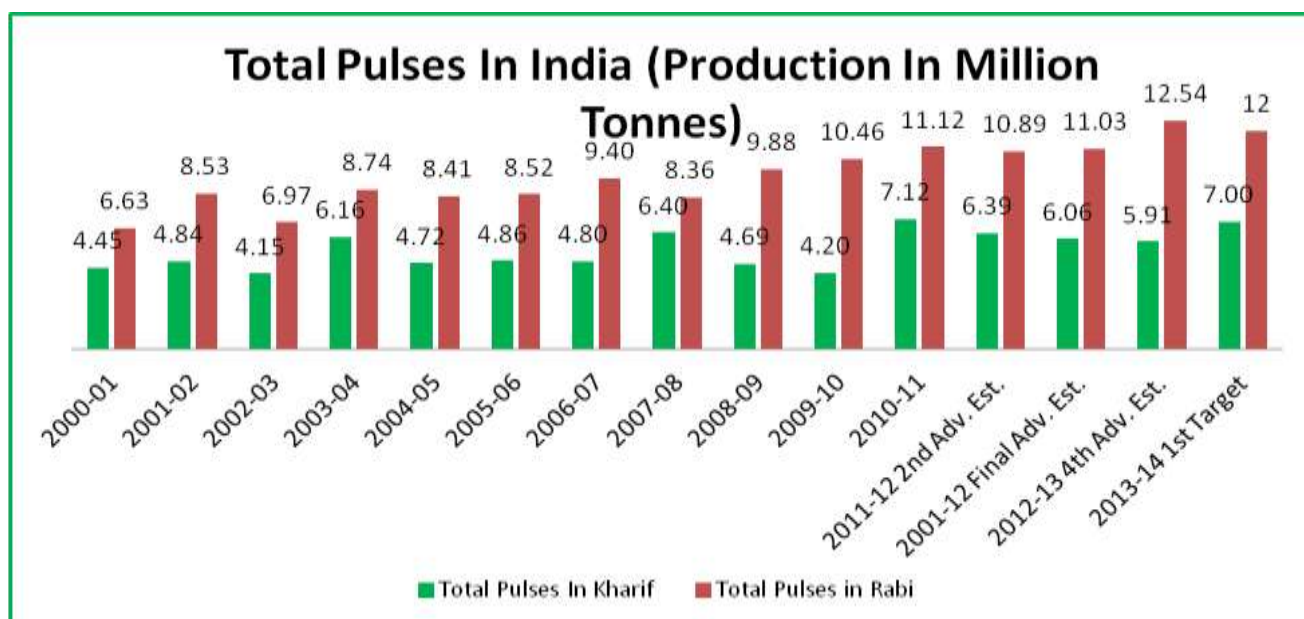
Weekly Outlook: -Pulses prices are likely to notice range –bound to firm tone in the near –term amid festival demand in the market.

Weekly Port Updates

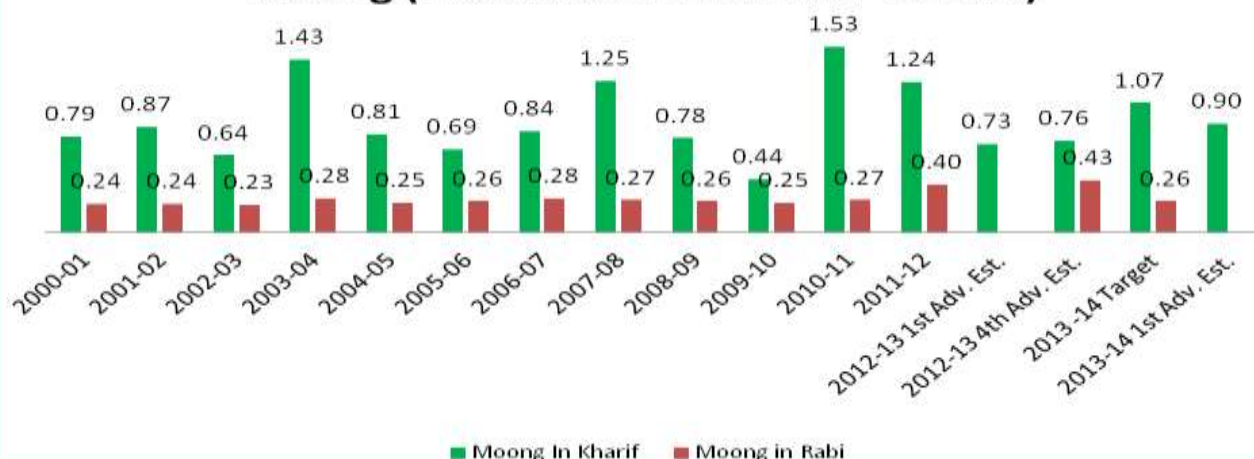
- At Mumbai port, 10 containers of Chickpeas (Chana), 42 containers of Lentils (Masoor), 5 containers of Moong, 5 containers of Green peas, 62 containers of Pigeon Pea (Tur) and 115 containers of Black Mapte (Urad) have arrived.
- At Chennai port, 81 containers of urad, 30 containers of tur, and 30 containers of yellow peas have arrived.

1st Advance Estimates by MOA: Pulses output at 19.00 mn tonnes

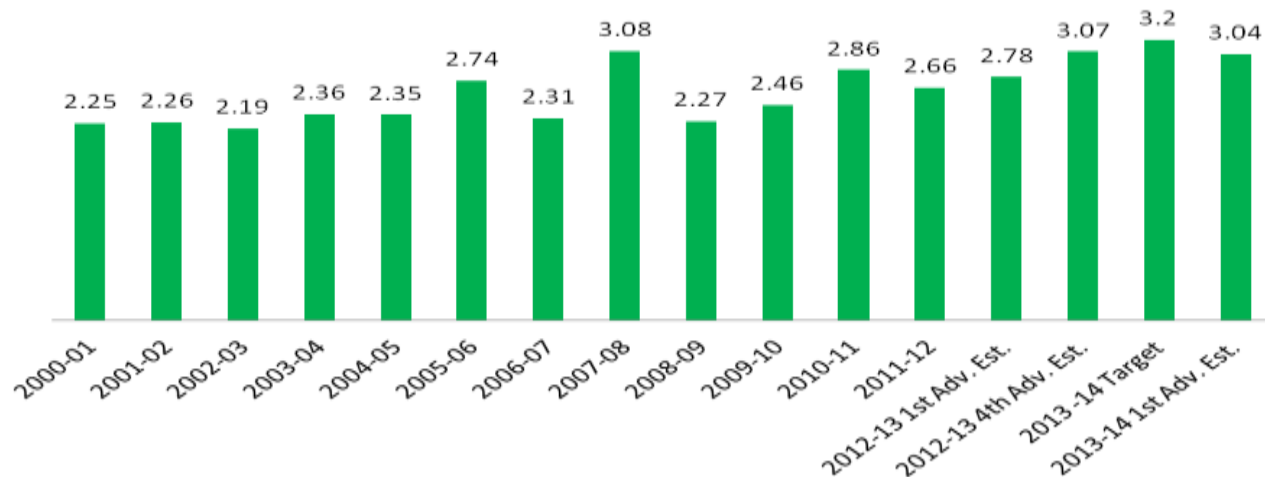
- MOA revealed that the country's pulses production in 2013-14 is estimated to be 19.00 million tonnes according to 1st advance estimates.
- In the 1st advance estimates, Tur production is estimated at 3.04 million metric tonnes compared to 3.07 million metric tonnes, urad prod is estimated at 1.33 million metric tonnes compared to 1.45 million metric tonnes and moong production is estimated at 0.90 million metric tonnes compared to 0.76 million metric tonnes during the previous season. The graph below shows the 1st advance estimates.
- The target for pulses had been set at 19.00 million tonnes during the year.
- India needs to import as its required pulses domestic production is insufficient to meet the rising demand. The country's import bill on pulses stood at \$1.83 billion in 2011-12.



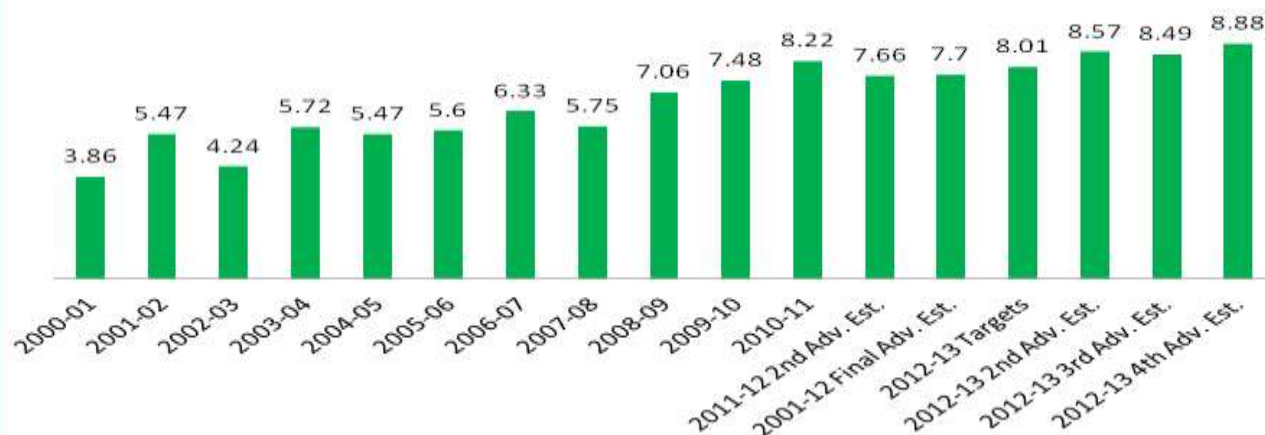
Moong (Production In Million Tonnes)

Market Recap:

Chana prices noticed steady to firm tone during the week.

Current Scenario:

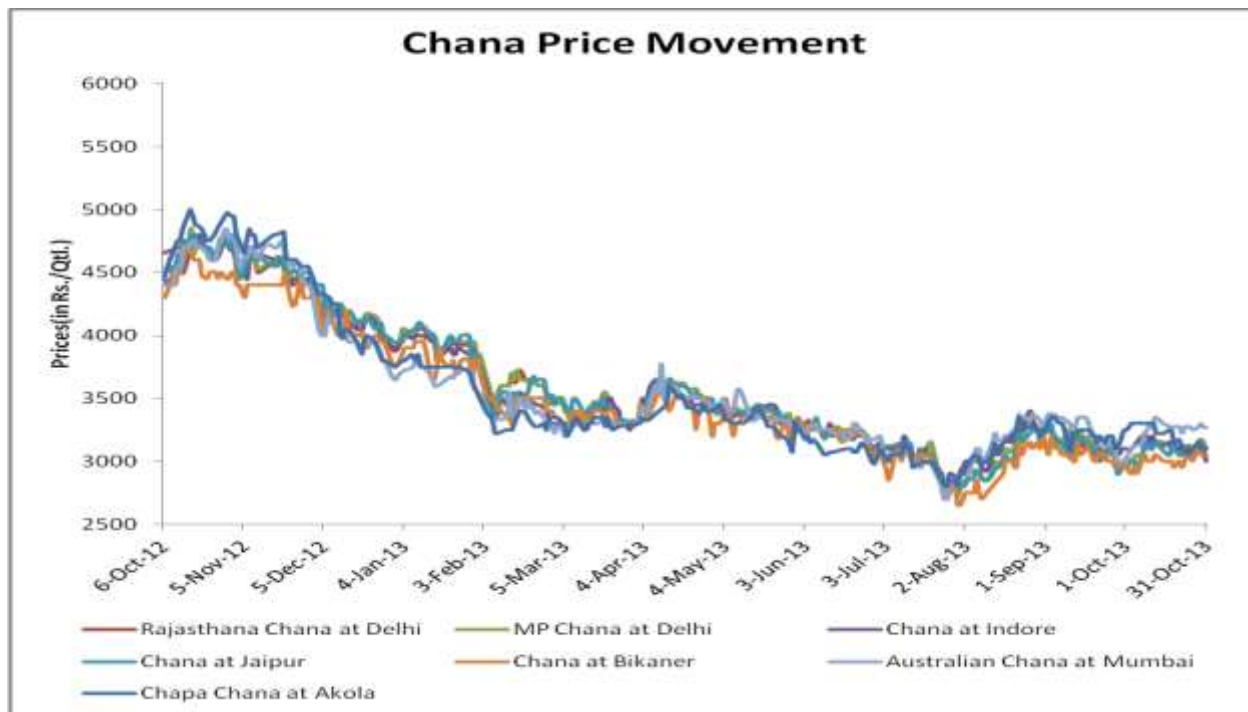
In this week, prices at key centers noticed steady to firm tone and prices increased by Rs 35-50 per quintal on an average.

In benchmark market Delhi "Lawrence Road", the chana prices (of M.P. origin) noticed firm tone and reached at Rs.3150 per quintal amid festival demand around current levels. Chana at Indore market noticed steady tone, and reported at Rs.3100 per quintal. Australian Chana also down by Rs 4/Qtl and quoted at Rs.3271/Qtl. Moreover, chana at Bikaner market remained steady Rs.3050 per quintal.

Market participants revealed that --

- ✓ Desi Chana at Delhi market noticed firm tone in the spot market amid festival demand in the market.
- ✓ Good rainfall coupled with favorable weather during the last few weeks has brightened the prospects of chana sowing during the Rabi season.

Desi and imported peas prices witnessed firm tone during the week.

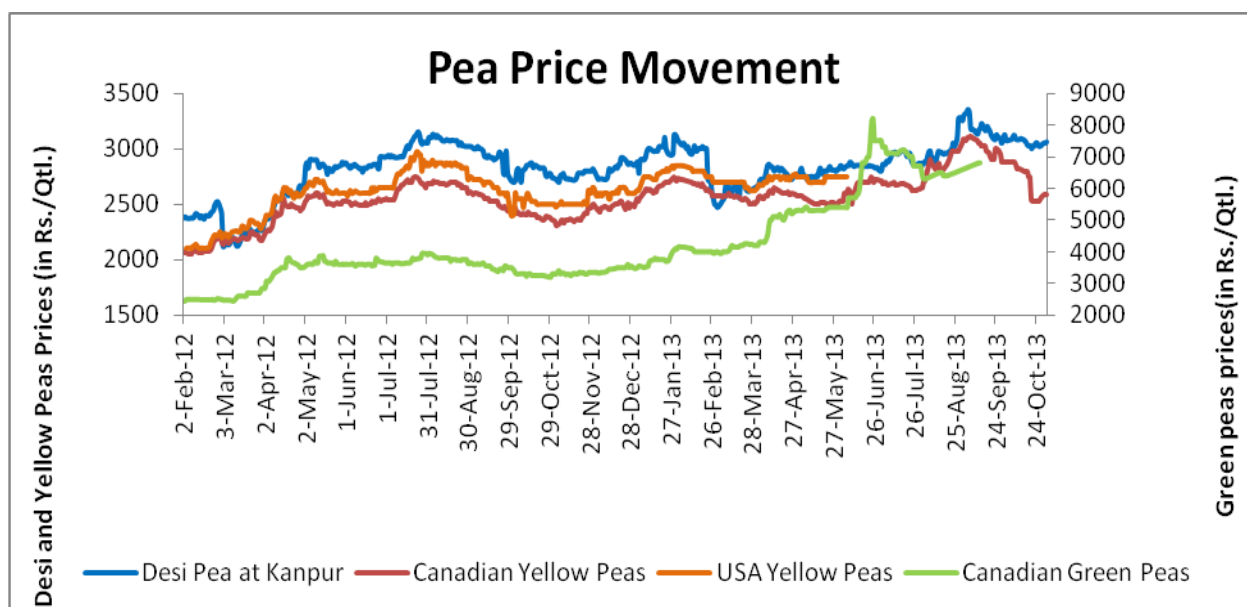
Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

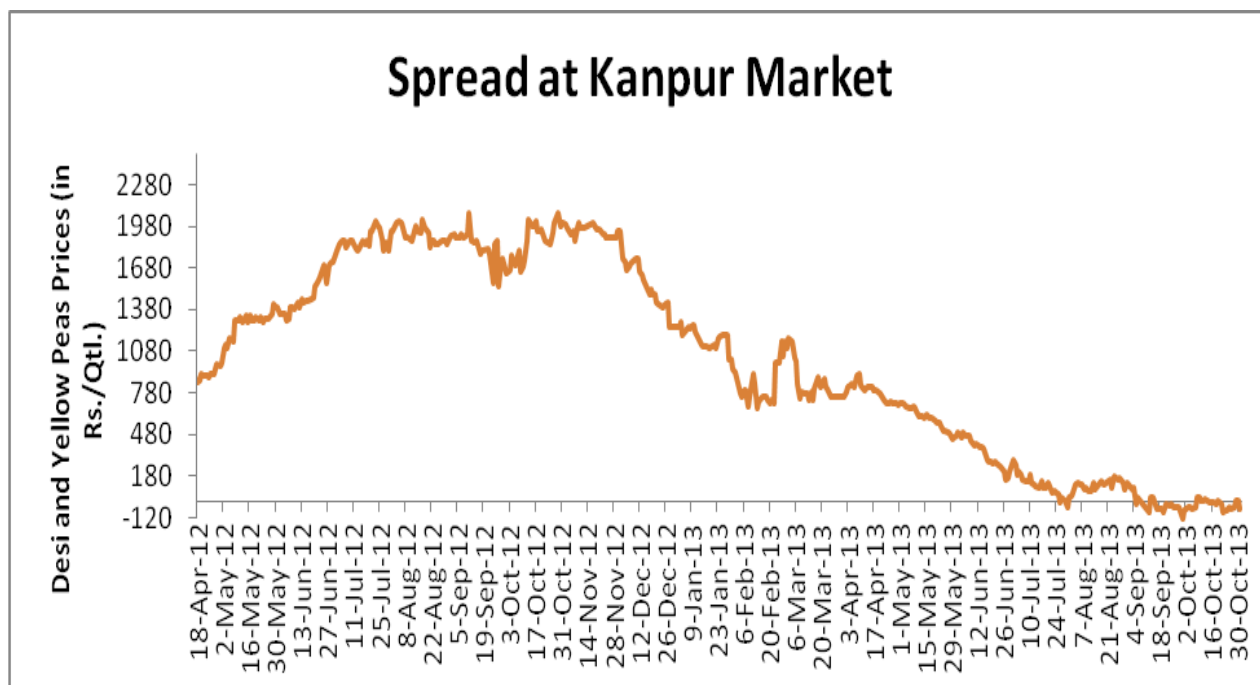
Market participants revealed that --

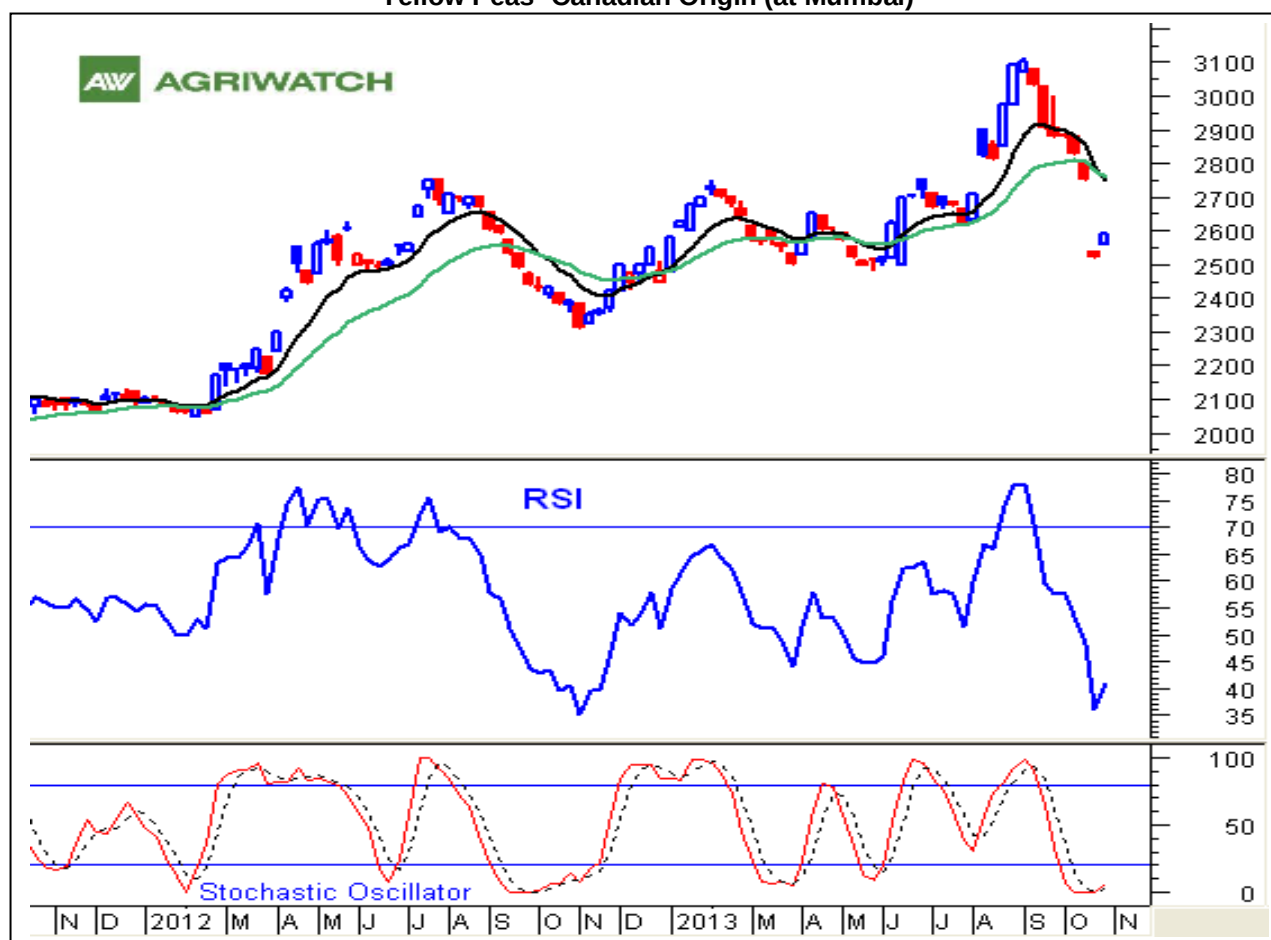

During this period, desi and imported tur witnessed firm tone during the week.

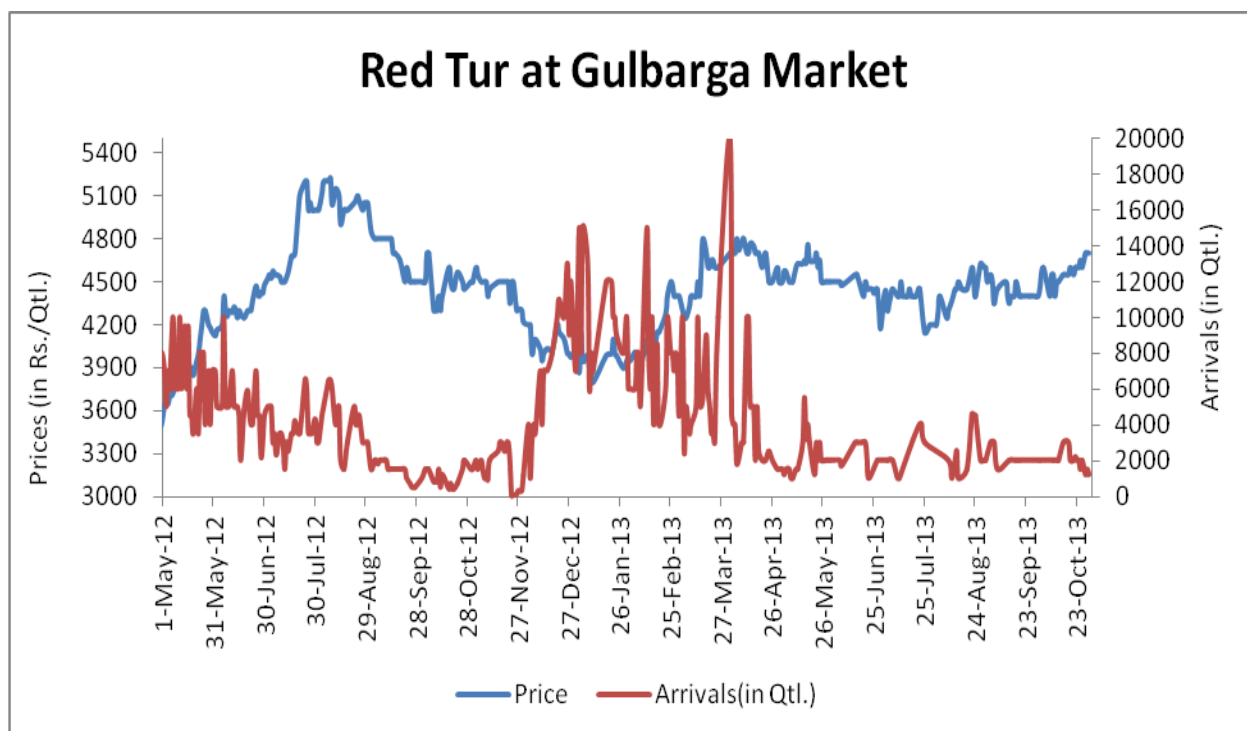
Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

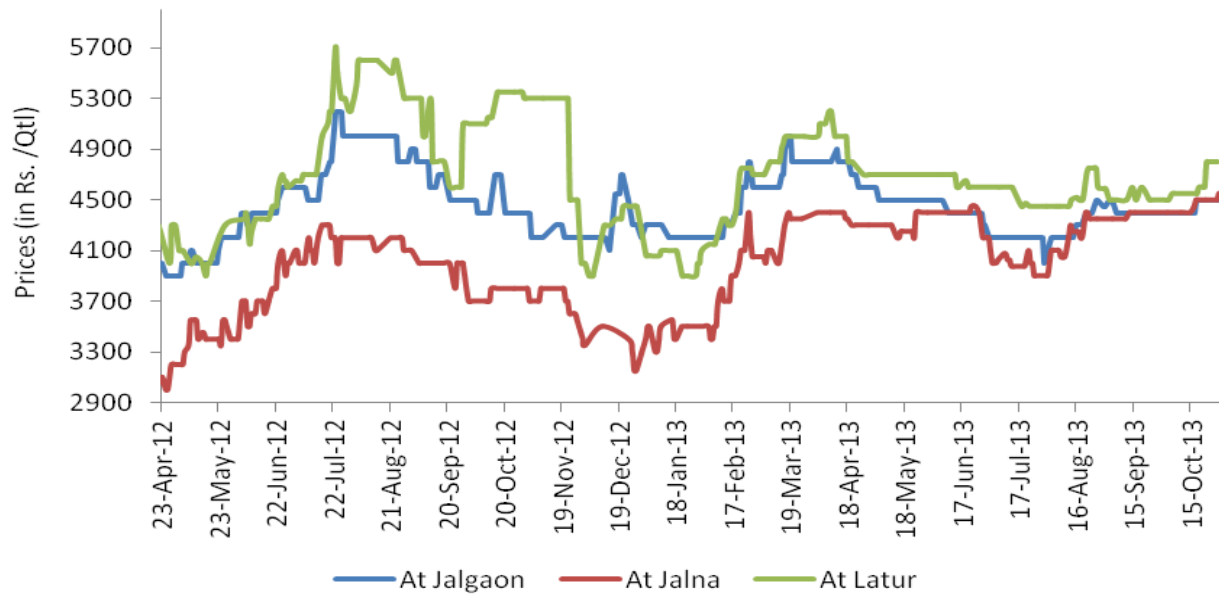

- ✓ Burmese lemon tur prices noticed firm tone in Mumbai amid fresh buying inquiry in the market.

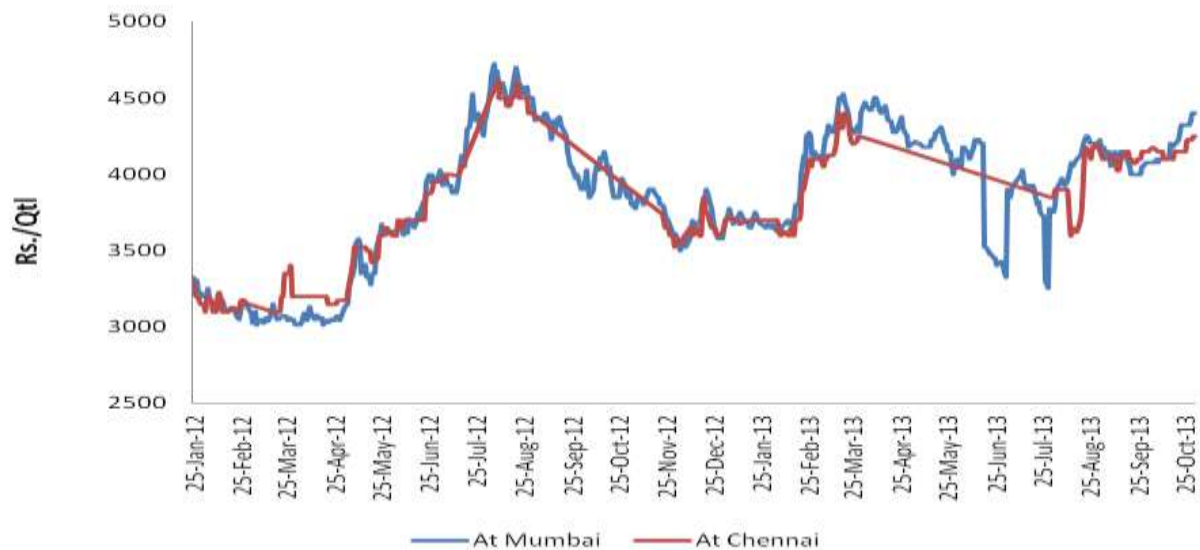

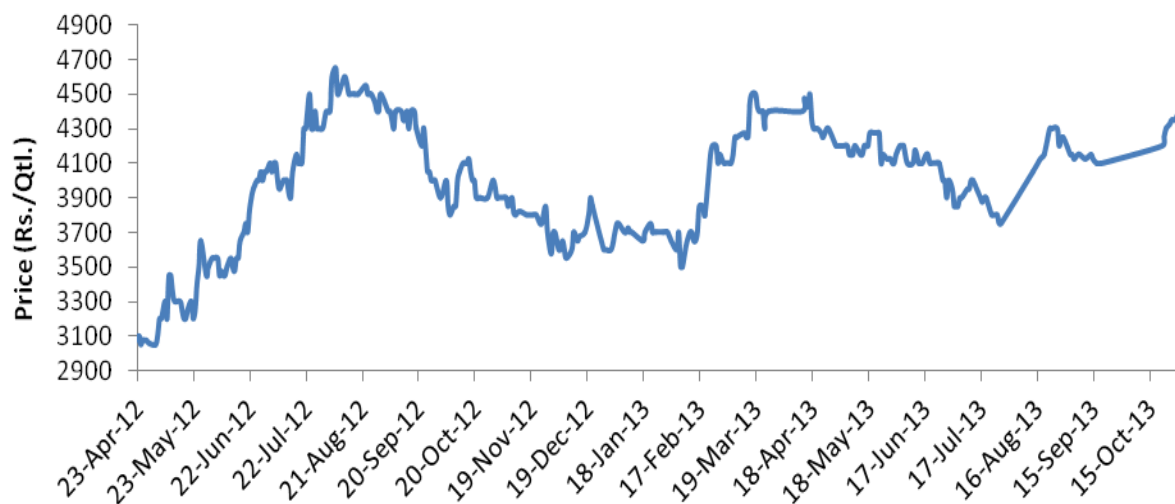

Current Scenario:

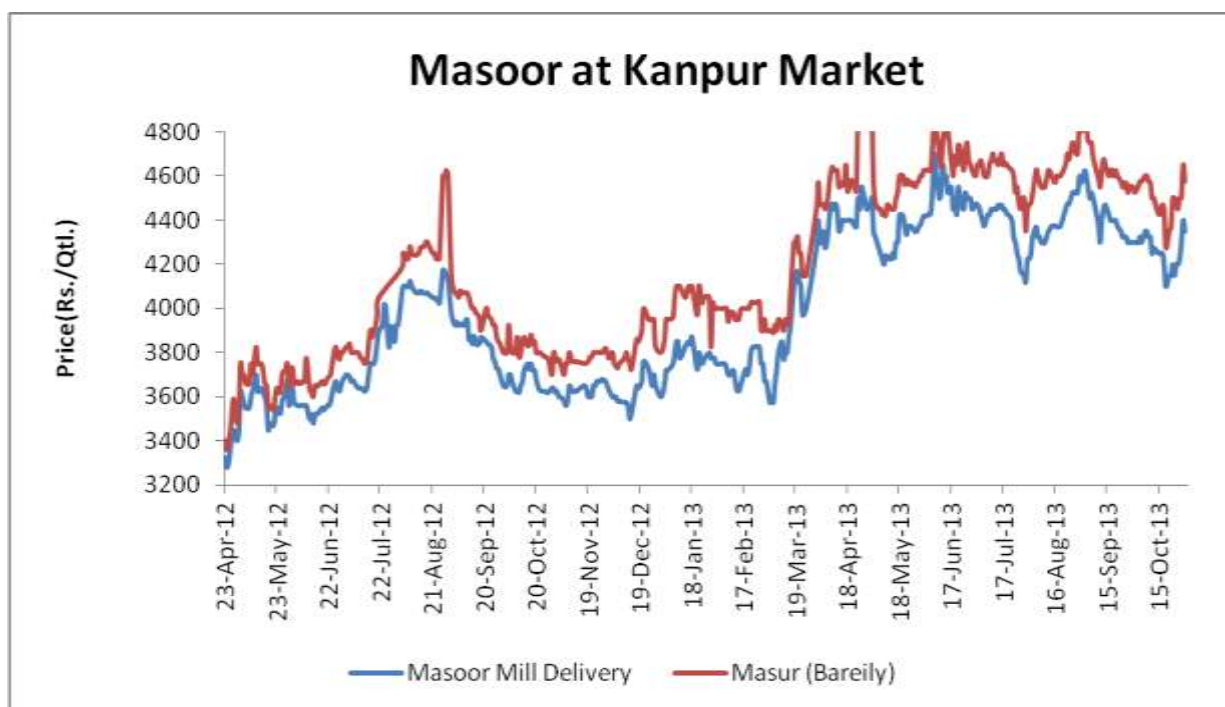

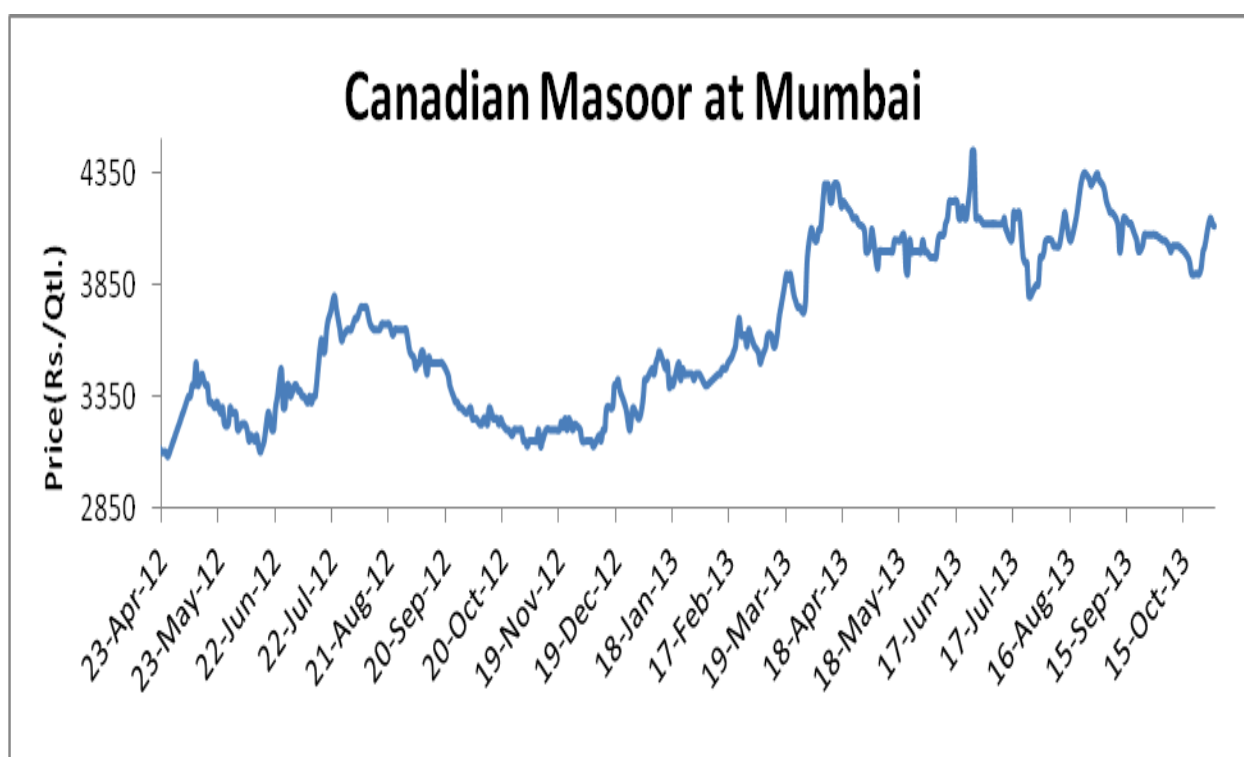
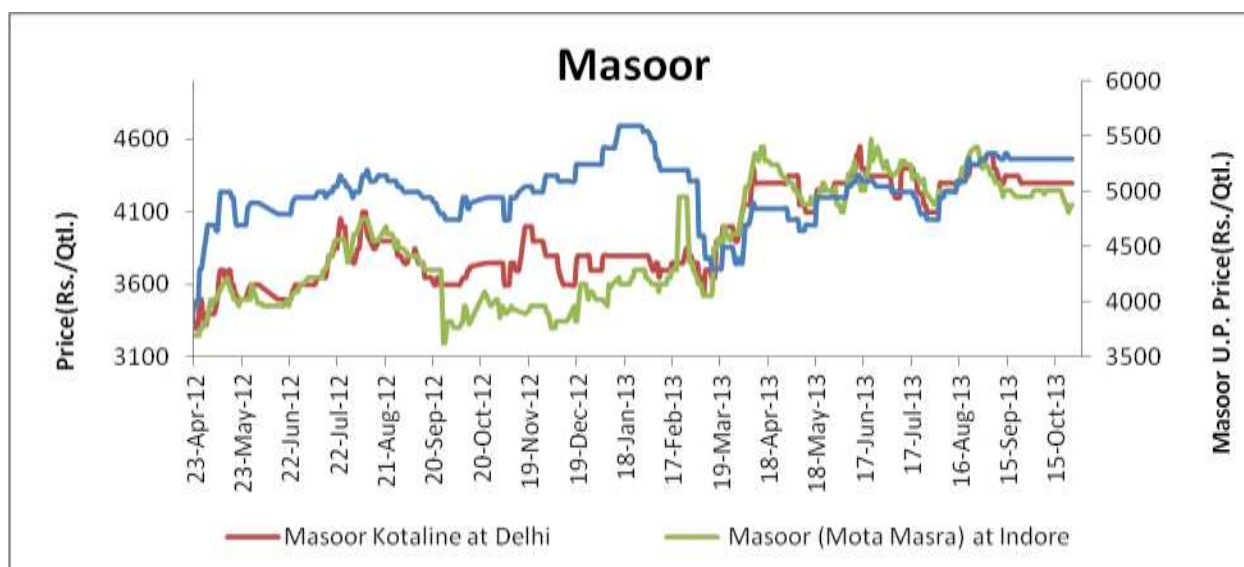
At Delhi prices remained weak at Rs.4250/Qtl. Moreover, prices remained firm at Rs.4300 per quintal at Indore market.

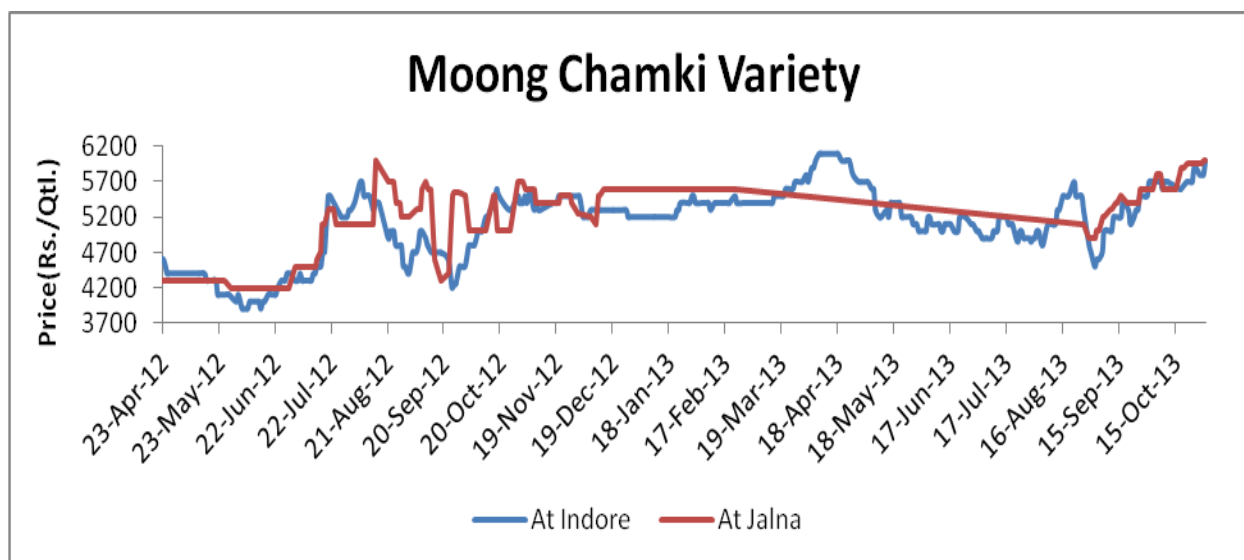

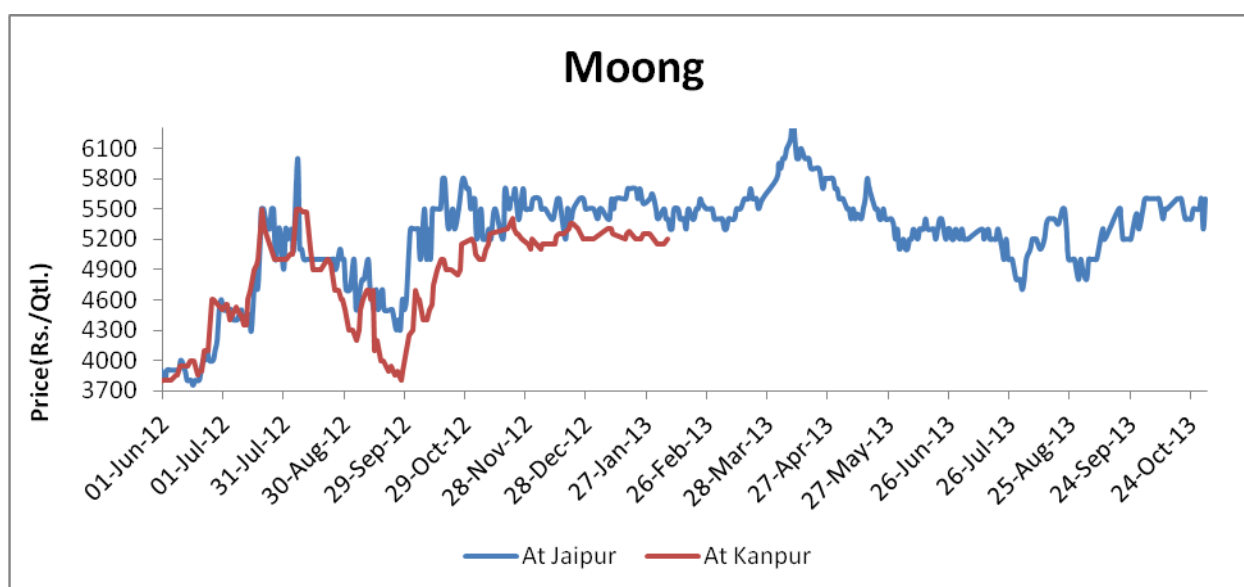

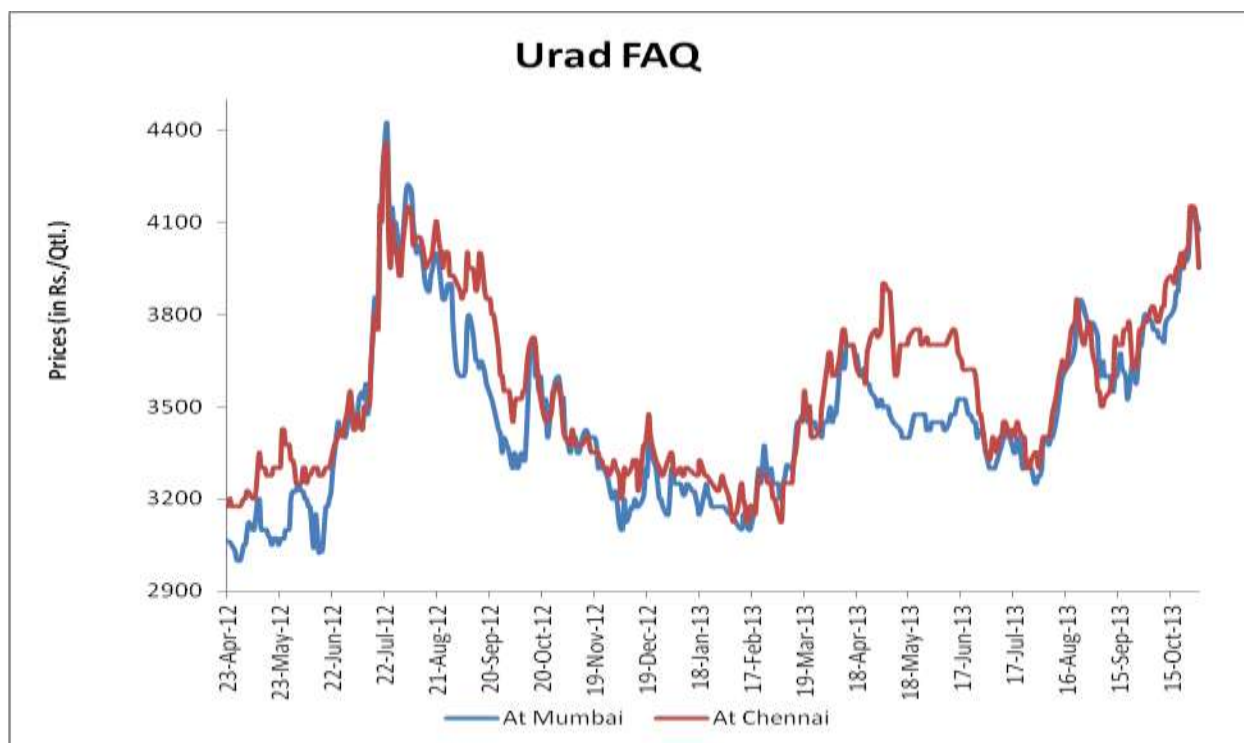

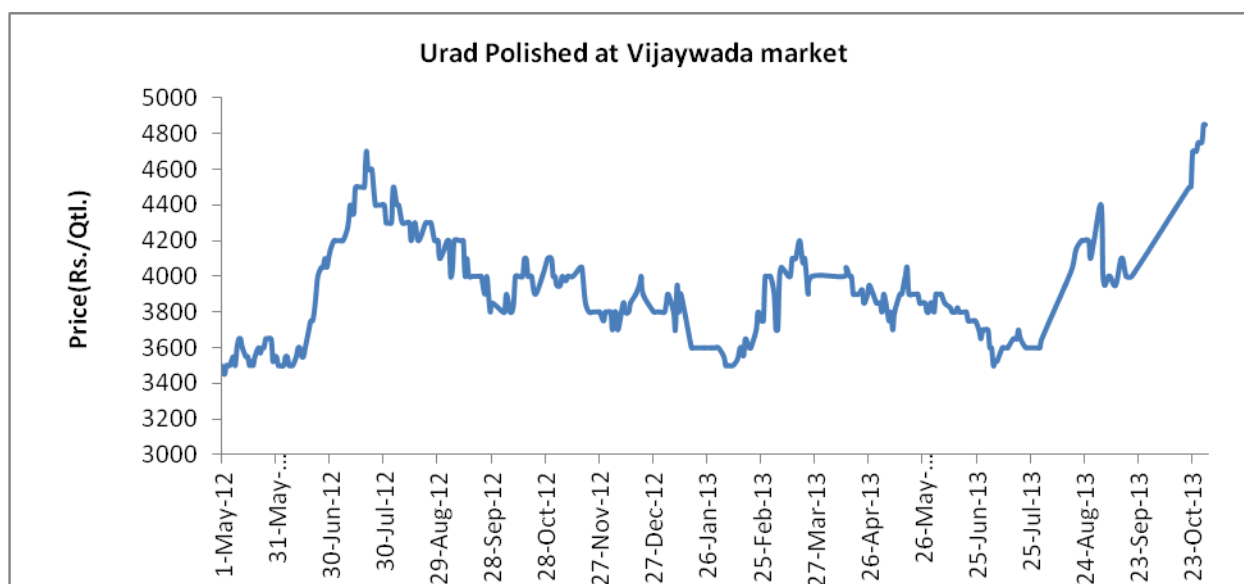
