Summary

- Pulses markets noticed mostly steady to firm tone in domestic markets.
- Market participants revealed that:-.
- ✓ Desi Chana at Delhi market noticed weak tone amid lack demand from traders and millers in the market.
- ✓ Moong prices noticed steady tone in Jaipur (Raj.) amid sluggish demand in the market.
- ✓ Urad FAQ in Chennai (T.N.) opened firm on fresh buying inquiry in the market.
- Urad prices are likely to be steady to firm in the coming days amid expected lower crop output in the current season.
- The Food Ministry is likely to include pulses in the Food Security Scheme in the next few years. In this scheme, pulses will be distributed under Public Distribution System at subsidized rates.
- Tamil Nadu Civil Supplies Corporation (TNCSC) opened two tenders of pulses, their lowest bid are as follows:
 - ✓ Urad dal FAQ (split) variety at Rs.5478 per quintal for 14000 tonnes.
 - ✓ Tur dal phatka variety at Rs.6499 per quintal for 5000 tonnes.
- PEC has issued a tender for sale of 1,970 tonnes of imported pigeon pea (tur) in the domestic market. Tender will open on 27th November 2013.
- National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Ltd. (Nafed) has invited tender for sale of PSS red tur kharif 2012 -13. The sale of red tur stored in CWC, Siddipet warehouses, Andhra Pradesh will take place on every Wednesday. The tenders will be opened at 3.30 p.m. on the same day.
- Rabi Pulses Sowing in Maharashtra till 22nd November, 2013 (in '00 Ha)- Chana sowing has been done in 6917.75 hectares, Other pulses in 145.71 hectares.

- According to government of Andhra Pradesh, total pulses sowing in the state have been covered in 4.97 lakh hectares compared to 5.90 lakh hectares during the same period last year as on 20th November, 2013 in the current rabi season.
- According to weekly crop report released by government of Rajasthan, rabi pulses sowing in the state have been covered in 12.65 lakh hectares compared to 10.75 lakh hectares during the same period last year as on 18th November, 2013.
- According to Ministry of Agriculture, acreage under rabi pulses till date is reported at 75.72 lakh hectares compared to 63.23 lakh hectares during the same period previous year
- According to IBIS, imports of urad and moong in the month of October increased to 0.67 lakh metric tonnes compared to 0.48 lakh metric tonnes during the previous month.
- In October, Canadian pea export down by 62% to 1.743 lakh tonnes while, lentil exports surged by 12.6% to 0.84 lakh tonnes-Canadian Grain Commission.
- Agriculture Canada's cuts its chickpea production forecast to 1.71 lakh tonnes from 2.22 lakh acres , while well above from 1.61 lakh tonnes produced in last year.
- Production of pulses in Russia has increased to 2.17 million metric tonnes in 2012 compared to 1.29 million metric tonnes in 2007 according to USDA attaché report.
- According to USDA, production of peas in U.S. is expected to increase by 43% in the current season to 707,657 MT compared to previous year.
- Pulses markets in Burma noticed weak tone as buyers are looking for lower levels in the domestic and Indian market.
- Lentils prices in Canada noticed firm tone amid good demand in the export and domestic market.
- Peas markets in Canada noticed steady to firm tone during the previous week amid some fresh buying for shipment during next year.
- The USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation has purchased pulses for shipment as food aid. The purchases are for shipment in January and February.

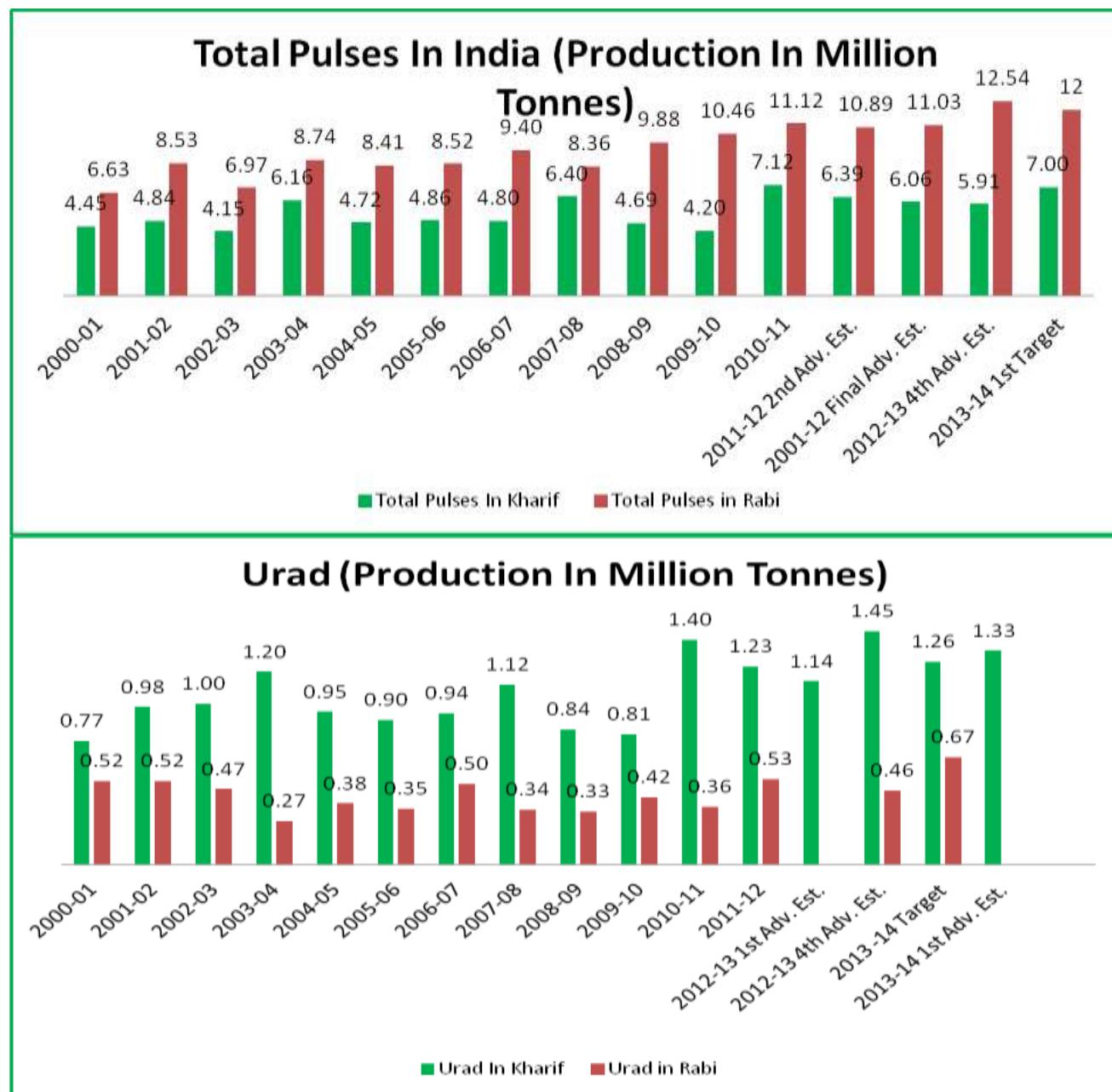
Weekly Outlook: -Pulses prices are likely to notice sideways to firm tone in the near –term amid lower arrivals of kharif crop in the market.

Weekly Port Updates

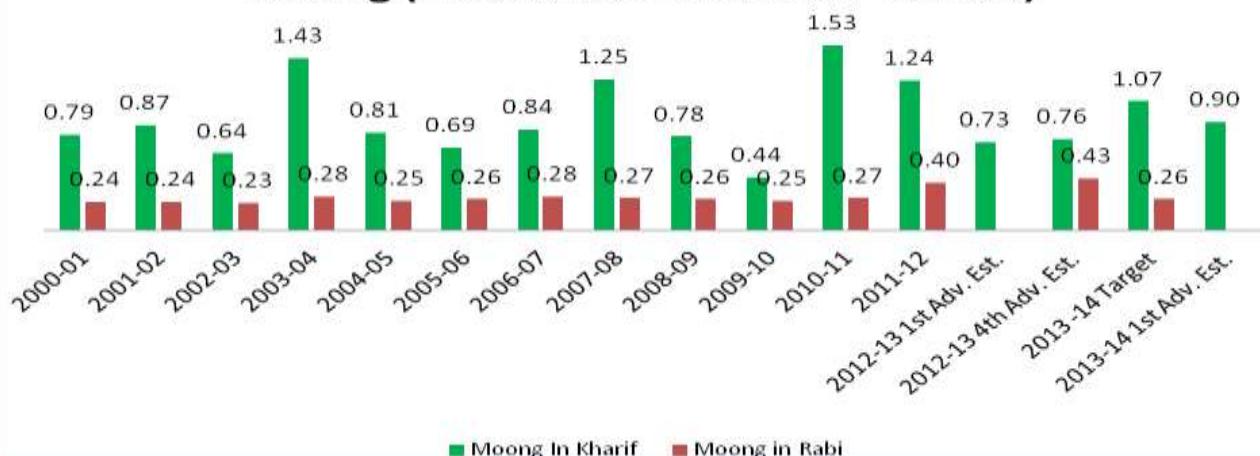
- At Mumbai port, 45 containers of Chickpeas (Chana), 61 containers of Lentils (Masoor), 44 containers of Green peas, 3 containers of yellow peas, 8 containers of Green gram (moong), 128 containers of Pigeon Pea (Tur), 58 containers of tur dal and 247 containers of Black Mapte (Urad) have arrived.
- At Chennai port, 231 containers of urad and 30 containers of tur have arrived.

1st Advance Estimates by MOA: Pulses output at 19.00 mn tonnes

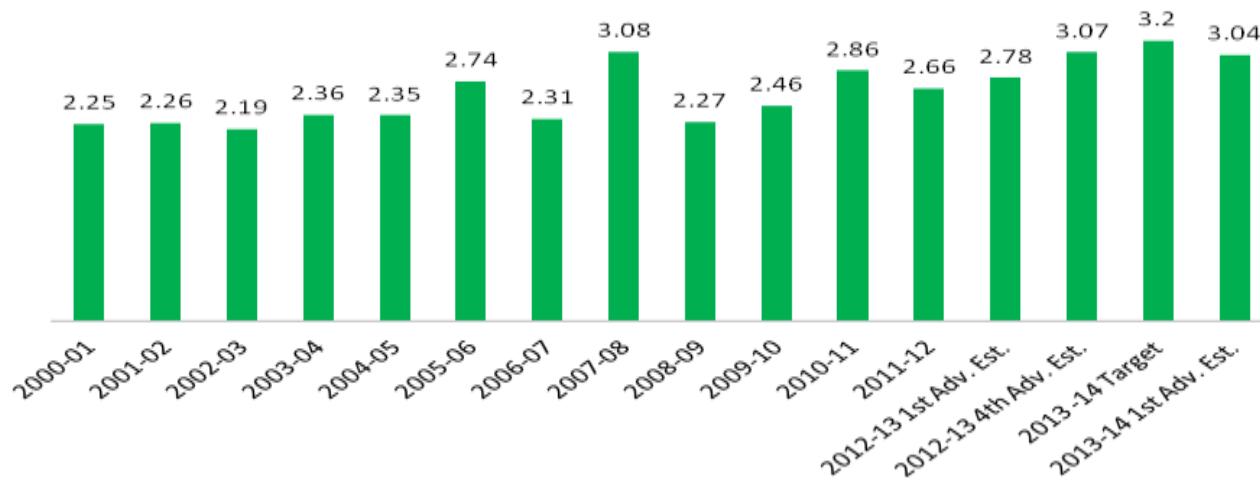
- MOA revealed that the country's pulses production in 2013-14 is estimated to be 19.00 million tonnes according to 1st advance estimates.
- In the 1st advance estimates, Tur production is estimated at 3.04 million metric tonnes compared to 3.07 million metric tonnes, urad prod is estimated at 1.33 million metric tonnes compared to 1.45 million metric tonnes and moong production is estimated at 0.90 million metric tonnes compared to 0.76 million metric tonnes during the previous season. The graph below shows the 1st advance estimates.
- The target for pulses had been set at 19.00 million tonnes during the year.
- India needs to import as its required pulses domestic production is insufficient to meet the rising demand. The country's import bill on pulses stood at \$1.83 billion in 2011-12.



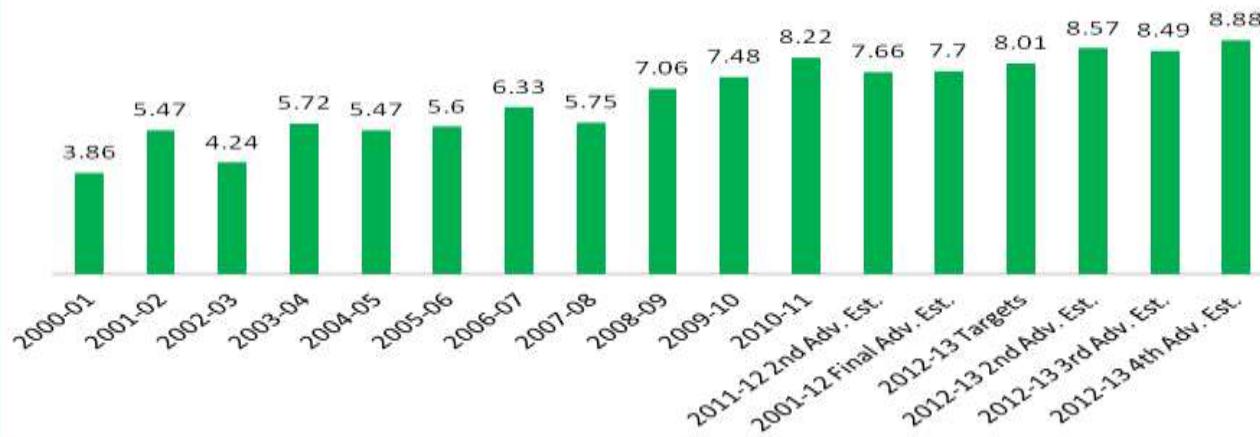
Moong (Production In Million Tonnes)

Market Recap:

Chana prices witnessed steady to weak tone during the week.

Current Scenario:

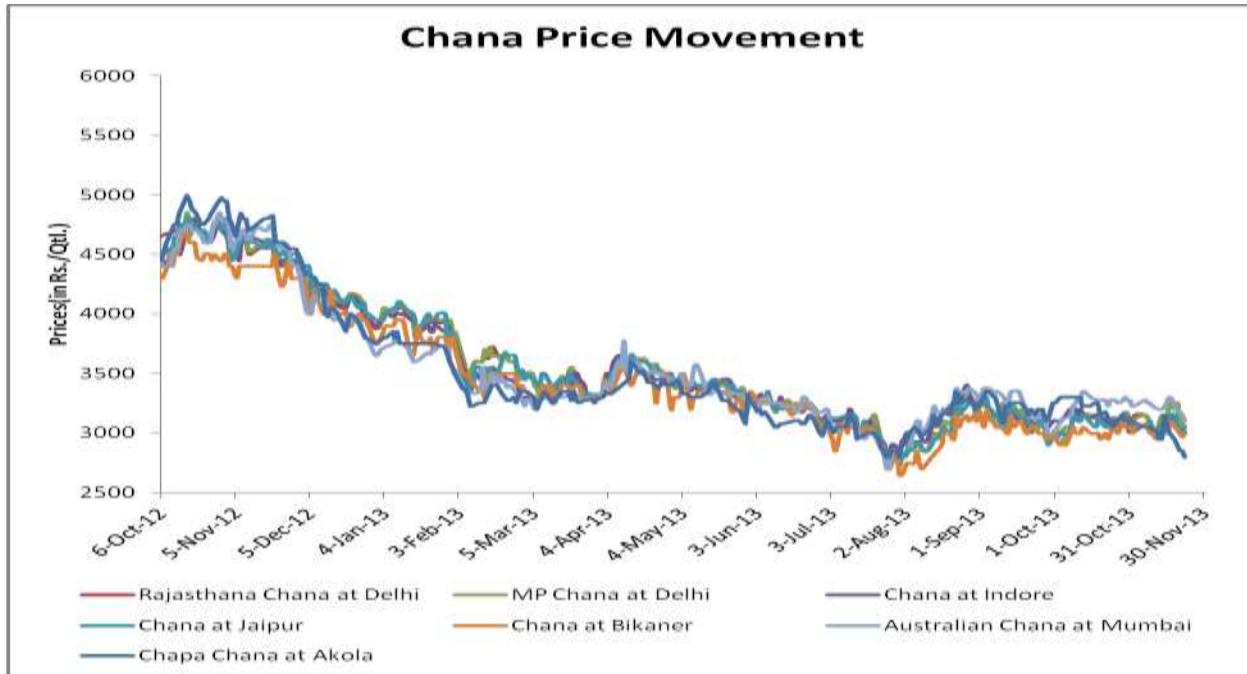
In this week, prices at key centers noticed steady tone and prices declined by Rs 20 per quintal on an average.

In benchmark market Delhi "Lawrence Road", the chana prices (of M.P. origin) noticed steady tone and reached at Rs.3154 per quintal amid irregular demand around current levels. Chana at Indore market noticed steady tone, and reported at Rs.3054 per quintal. Australian Chana down by Rs 30/QtL and quoted at Rs.3191/QtL. Moreover, chana at Bikaner market declined to Rs.3020 per quintal.

Market participants revealed that --

- ✓ Desi Chana at Delhi market noticed steady tone in the spot market amid irregular demand in the local pulses market.
- ✓ Good rainfall coupled with favorable weather during the month of October has brightened the prospects of chana sowing during the Rabi season.
- ✓ Sowing of rabi chana has started in the growing regions.
- ✓ Australian chana noticed weak tone amid lack of fresh buying inquiry in the market.

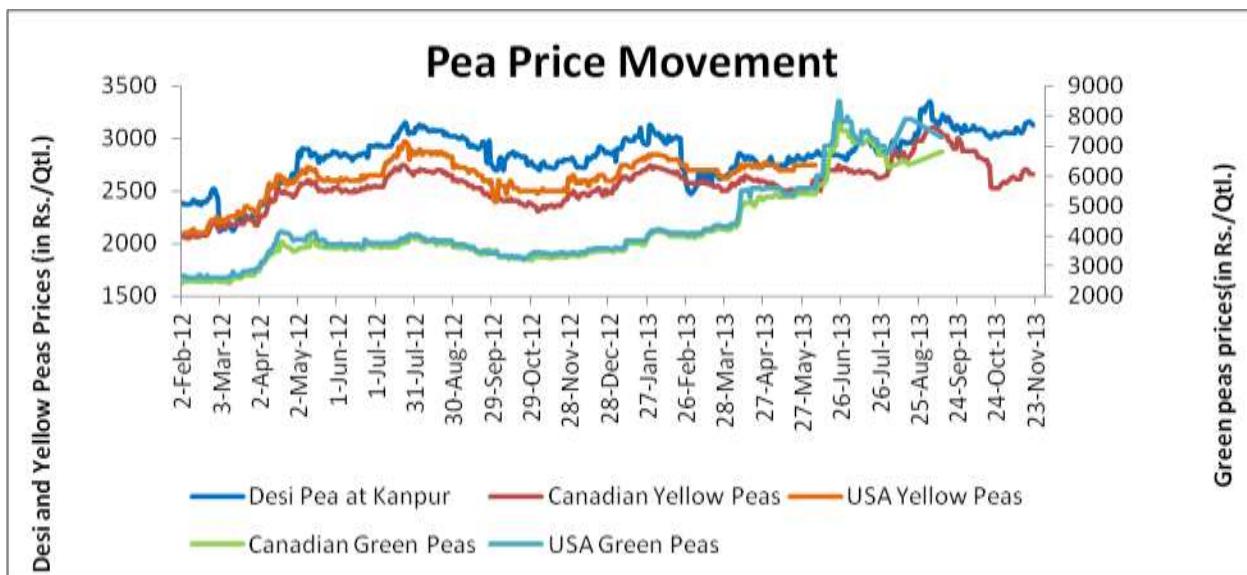

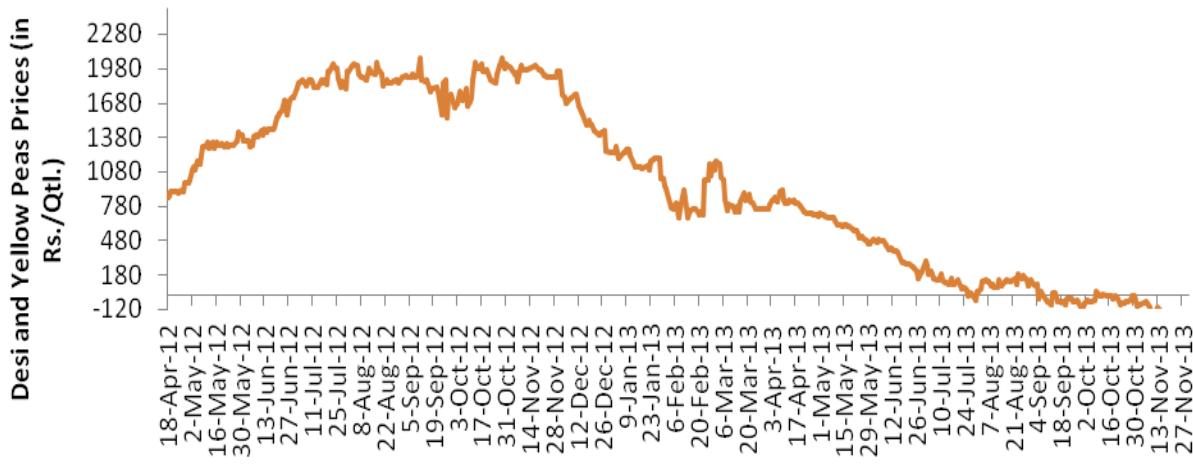
- ✓ Kanpur (U.P.), spot market noticed firm tone amid good demand in the market.

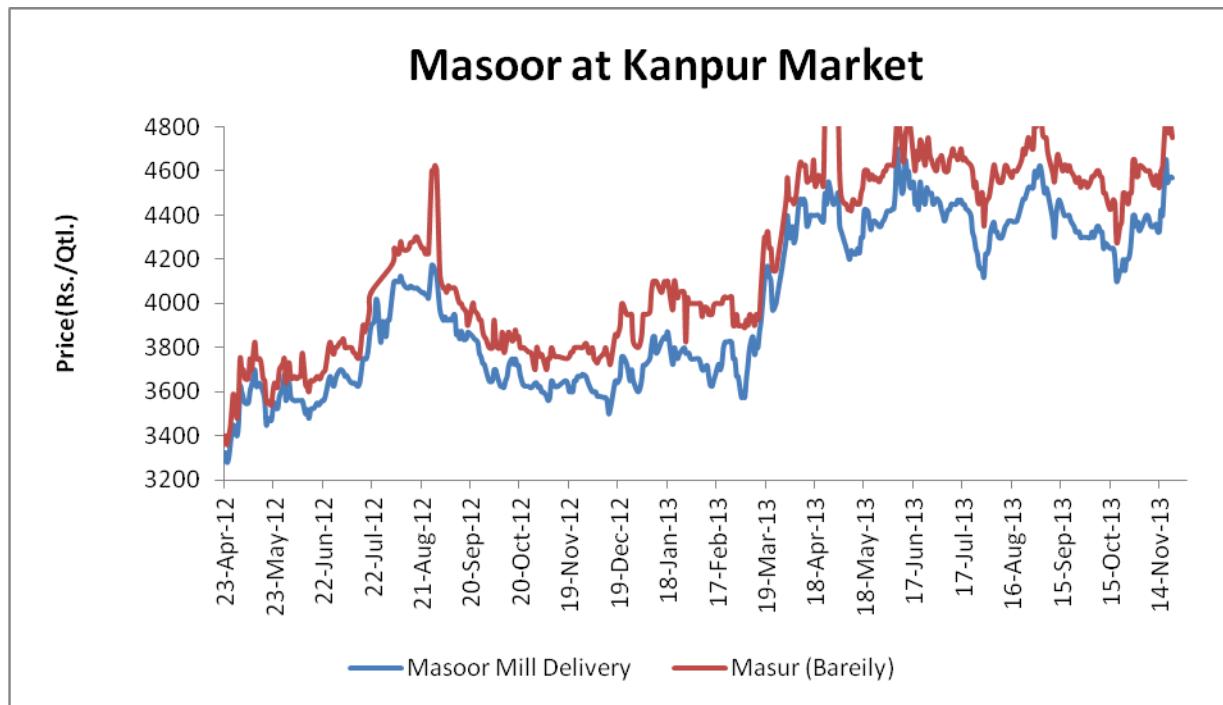
At Delhi prices remained firm at Rs.4660/QtL. Moreover, prices remained steady at Rs.4275 per quintal at Indore market.

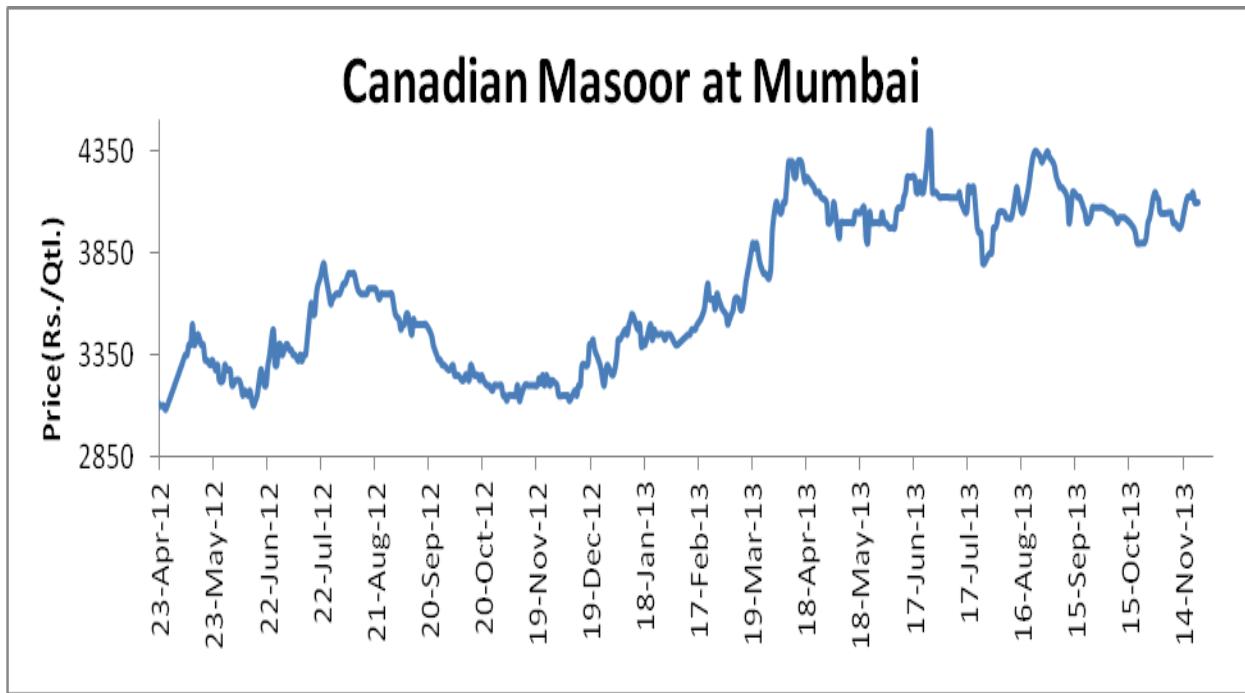
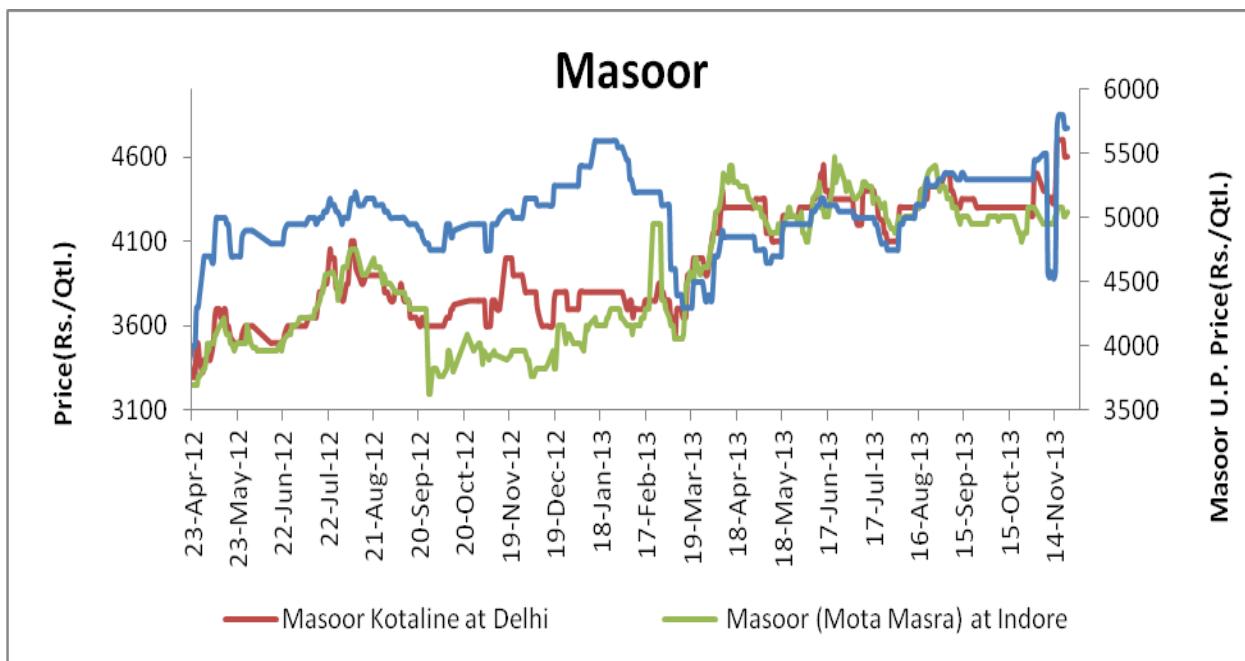
Moreover, the imported Canadian red lentils noticed steady tone and prices remained at Rs.4056 per quintal.

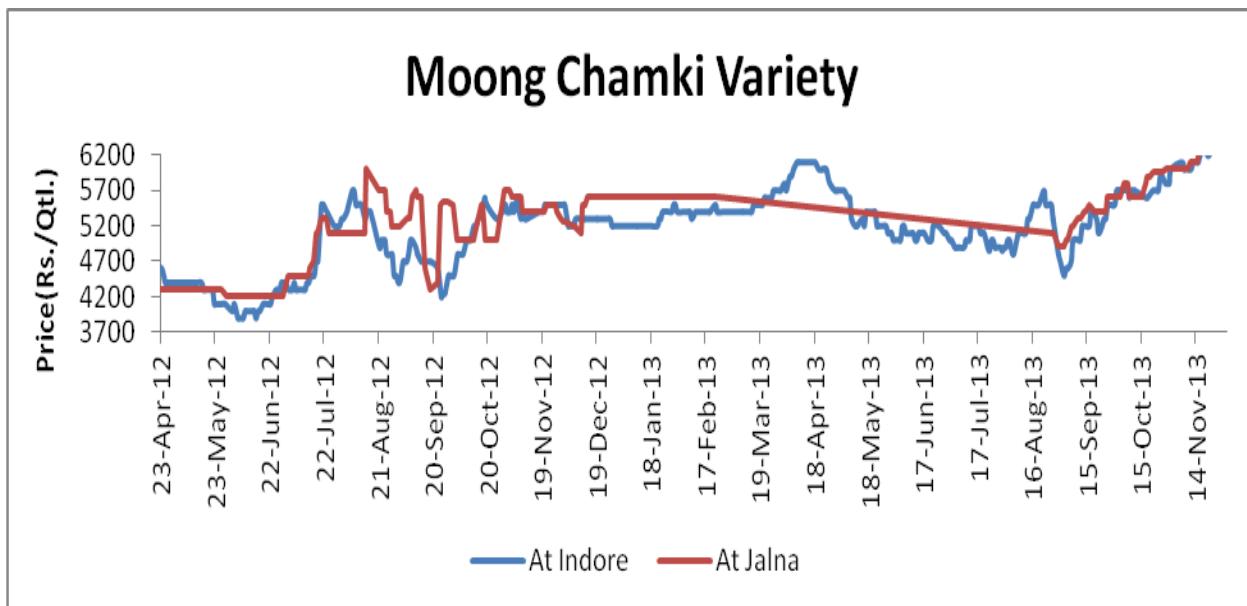
There is no arrival and prices available of moong pedisheva in Mumbai market during the week and moong (Tanzania origin) remained weak at Rs.5760/QtL respectively.

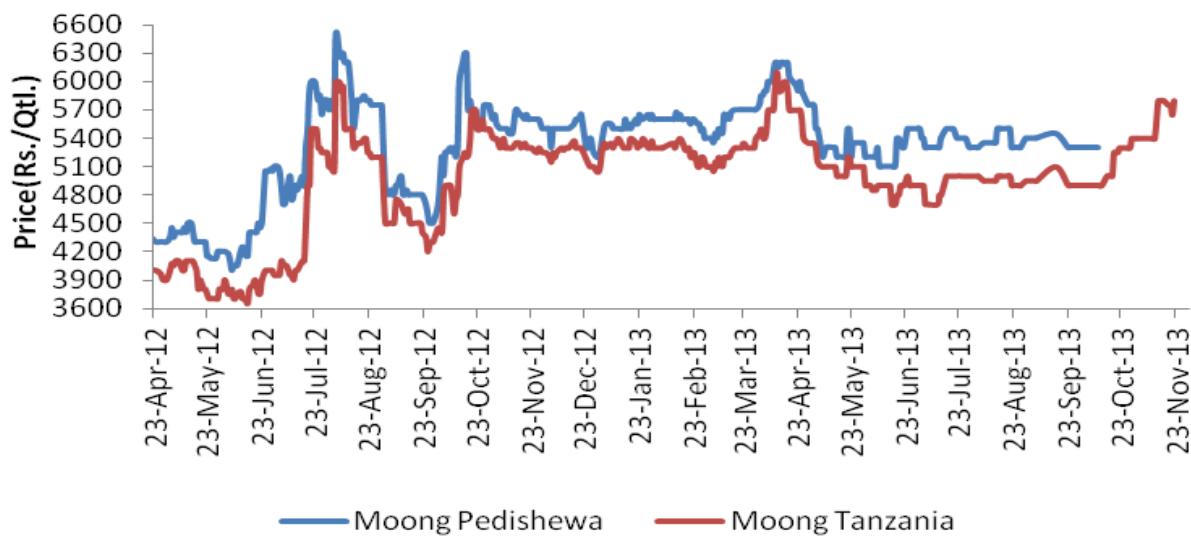
- ✓ Indore (M.P.) cash market, noticed firm tone amid good demand in the market.

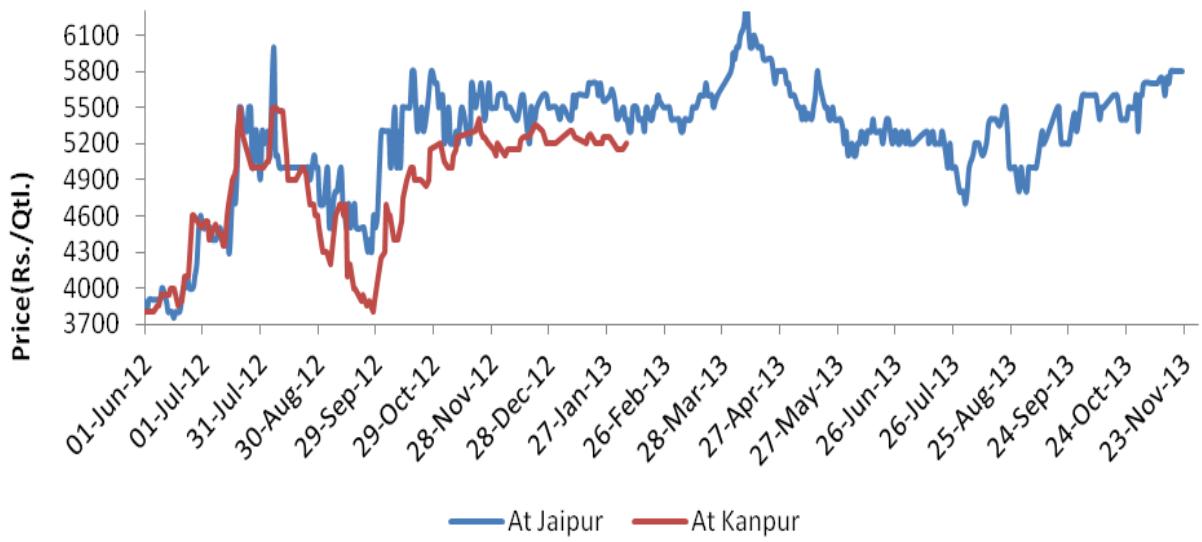




Imported Moong at Mumbai

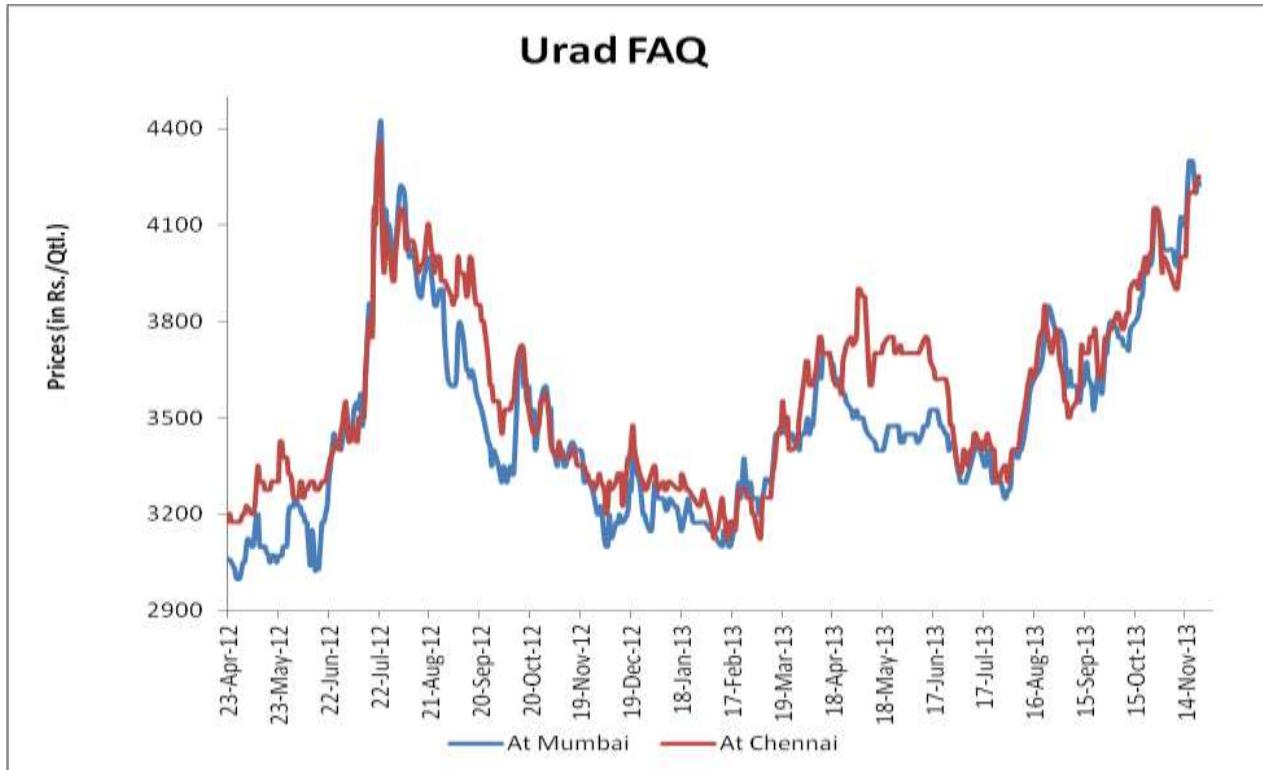

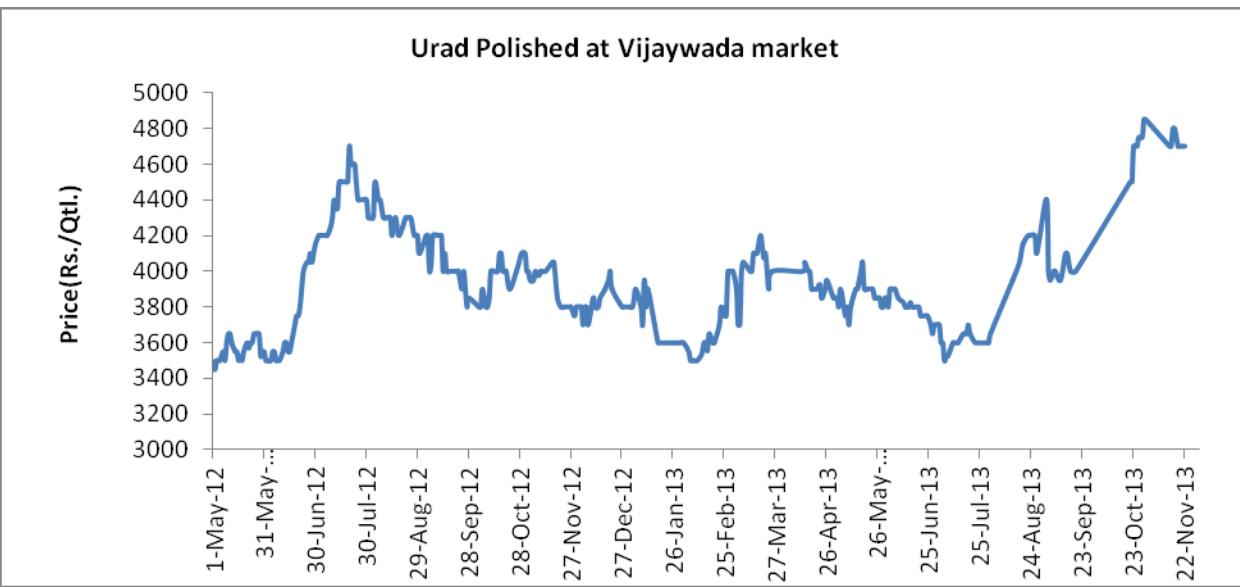
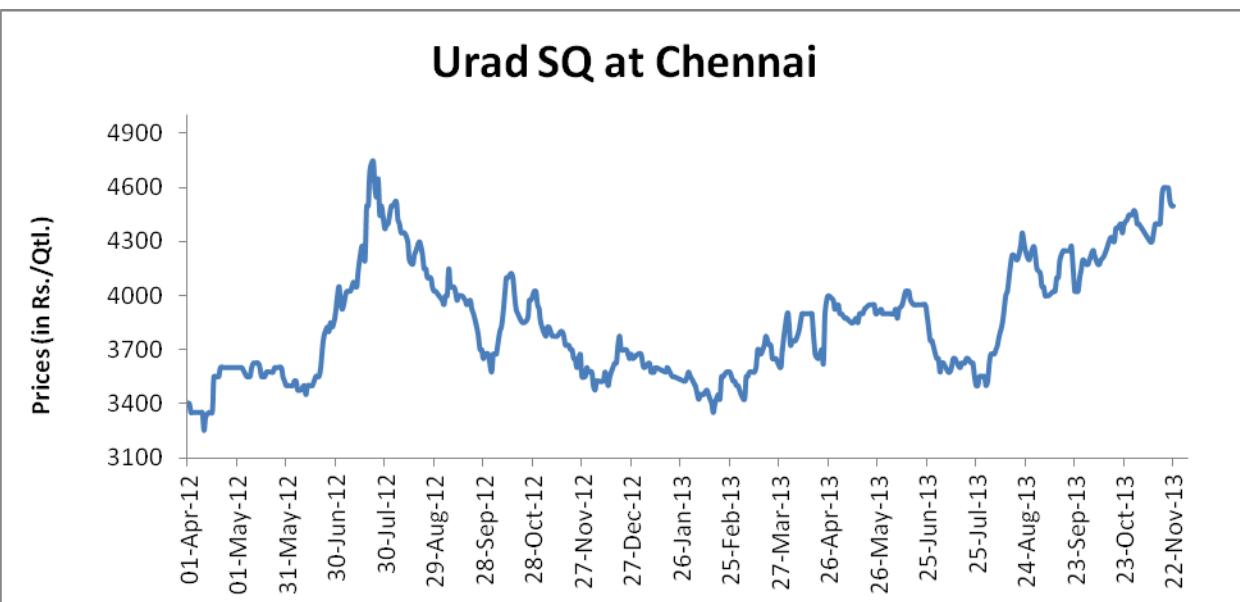
