

Wheat Daily Report

27th February 2013

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- Bulk Wheat buyers have reduced their purchasing by 25-30% from government stock under OMSS in the second half of this month. Off take may fall further as new crop is round the corner.
- No rake loading has been reported from Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. FCI and state agencies are gearing up to ensure smooth procurement in M.P, and Gujarat scheduled to start on 15th March 2013.
- No major loss was reported from recent rains to Wheat belt in M.P., Rajasthan, Punjab and Haryana. Harvesting is expected from second week of March. Most of the private exporters are out of the market and are waiting for the new crop. Fresh buying for exports by private traders is expected by Late March.
- Arrivals in Saurashtra region are reaching mandi but in much lower quantities.
- Thailand feed millers have bought 40,000 MT Indian wheat during the week as prices are declining. Purchases were made around USD 315/T CNF.
- In January 2013, 400,674 MT of wheat was exported from government stock through PSU's and it is expected that in February 2013, this could reach 500,000 MT.
- Government has set target of procuring around 44 million tonnes wheat this year. Punjab is likely to be the largest contributor towards wheat central pool stock, Madhya Pradesh may takeover Haryana as second largest contributor with around 11.5 million tonnes wheat as sown area has increased by 3 lakh hectares in M.P.

International Market Update:

- According to Agriculture Minister Nikolai Fyodorov, Russia may extend duty free grain imports till August 2013, giving importers an additional month to bring in grain. This move can make import attractive from US and EU.
- According to Agriculture and food department report, for 2012-13 Durum Wheat exports are expected to increase by 16% from previous year to 4.15 million tonnes. Durum Carryover stocks are forecasted to decrease by 14% to 1.3 million tonnes. Canada is expected to export 14.6 million tonnes of all wheat excluding Durum Wheat in 2012-13, which is 5% more than previous year.
- Canadian wheat seeded area is forecasted to increase by 7% in 2013-14 from 2012-13 as carryover stocks are lower, international prices are high and farmers are expected to shift from Canola and lentils.
- According to Egypt ministry official, GASC is expected to procure 4 million tonnes wheat from local farmers by May 2013 end and it is expected that imports will be cut. GASC has enough wheat in stocks till June 2013 and domestic crop will ensure supply till November 2013.

Domestic market Outlook: We expect wheat Cash and future market to trade steady to weak as government is augmenting supply to offload huge stocks.
