

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Pulses market noticed mixed movement.
- **Normal 2015 Monsoon, While expected Rainfall in Next Week shall Lead to Further Damage in Rabi Crop.**
According to ASSOCHAM-Skymet Weather joint study, India is likely to get normal monsoon rainfall at 102% of long-period average during June-September this year. However some pockets that might be deficient (by a narrow margin) include Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Marathwada, Rayalseema, South Interior Karnataka, North Tamil Nadu and parts of the North East. A devolving El Nino in Monsoon 2015 will most probably not impact it negatively as droughts seem to happen where there is an evolving El Nino episode." Thus forecast of normal monsoon this year seems well distributed uniformly throughout India. The Chance of a back to back drought is 3% (2014 was a mild meteorological drought). Besides there is still no clear signal about the emergence of an Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) this year during monsoon. According to calculations (assuming an error margin of +/-4%) the following is Monsoon's risk spread over the four-month period:
 - ✓ 6% chance of excess (seasonal rainfall that is more than 110% of LPA)
 - ✓ 36% chance of above normal (seasonal rainfall that is between 105 to 110% of LPA)
 - ✓ 52% chance of normal (seasonal rainfall that is between 96 to 104% of LPA)
 - ✓ 4% chance of below normal (seasonal rainfall that is between 90 to 95% of LPA)
 - ✓ 2% chance of drought (seasonal rainfall that is below 90% of the LPA)

Meanwhile, study also states that more wet weather was expected in April and the damage to the Rabi crop would continue. A major rainfall spell is expected in the first week of April in North India.

- **Sell Urad & Moong on Harvest.** The Agro Market Intelligence and Business Promotion Centre (AMI&BPC) of the Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business has advised farmers to sell black gram and green gram upon harvest. In Tamil Nadu, black gram was mainly cultivated in Cuddalore, Nagapattinam, Villupuram, Thanjavur, and Tiruvarur districts. Green gram was grown in Nagapattinam, Tiruvarur, Thiruvallur, Thoothukudi, and Salem districts. At present, the price of black gram was Rs. 54 a kg and green gram was ruling at Rs. 64 a kg at the Villupuram regulated market. Now, harvesting season has commenced for green gram and black gram, especially in the rice fallows areas. As per the analysis the price of black gram is expected to hover in the range of Rs. 57 to Rs. 59 a kg and green gram would be in the range between Rs. 64 and Rs. 65 a kg between March and May. There was no chance for increase in the price for green gram in June and July. (Source-The Hindu)
- The West Bengal government has decided to encourage cultivation of pulses and oilseeds to meet the deficit of these agri-products in the State.
- According to the consumer affairs ministry officials, Government is considering the continuation of zero import duty on pulses due to expected lower output and high demand. There is zero duty on import of pulses till March 31. India imports nearly 3-4 million tonnes of pulses annually to meet domestic demand. (Source-Economics Times)

Pulses International Fundamental:

- According to the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), The country's pulses import mounted by 37% to 254.557 million dollars in July-February 2014-15. In term of volume, pulses import went up by 131, 293 metric tons (44 percent) to 429,977 metric tons in July-February 2014-15 from 298,684 metric tons in July-February 2013-14.
- USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation release purchase tender 8,040 metric tonne of pulses for May-June shipment as food aid.

Outlook: - Pluses prices are likely to remain range-bound.
