

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

This year pulses prices are ruling higher and farmers intend to grow more pulses this year. In normal weather condition acreage is likely to increase by 20 percent. However, as farmers opine that lower rainfall can change farmer's intention and they may go for another lucrative cash crop. If growing areas receives normal rainfall, production and productivity are bound to increase. Under lower rainfall condition, increase in acreage could be restricted. However, in any condition pulses area in kharif would be higher in comparison to last year.

Central Government has asked all state governments to submit details of their demand for pulses and details of this year crop and availability of pulses from last year's stock. The information will help central government to analyze the situation and decide the action plan to control the increasing prices of pulses. They can meet the demand by getting additional supply from surplus states or can import from other countries. A meeting regarding pulses supply-demand situation and likely price trend is scheduled next week to take the stock of the situation.

As per latest update from market participants some forward deals of Chana from Australia have been struck at Rs4550 this week to be shipped during October-November. Masoor and Yellow peas deals too have been struck from Canada at Rs 5950-6000 and Rs 2550-2575 respectively for October-November shipment.

In a latest measure to keep pulses market under control government has directed traders to update their stock of imported pulses every fortnight. The immediate effect of this order worked as a cap on firming up pulses market at this point of time. Traders and importers have started releasing imported pulses stock at regular intervals and it has made supply side easy in domestic market. Importers are not retaining stock in large quantity as they would have to give stock position twice in a month. Besides, Government has started thinking on import option through MMTC. Government may allow MMTC to import higher quantity of pulses and release it whenever prices in domestic market start firming up. These developments have restricted pulses market fundamentals. In brief, market is unlikely to show any spike in the short term.

As per latest update from market participants some forward deals of Chana from Australia has been struck at \$785-90 last week to be shipped during July-August and \$775-80 for October-November shipment this year. At present Australia Chana is being imported at \$790. Forward deals at slightly lower price hints range bound movement in physical market. Australian Chickpea is currently being planted and should be finished by the end of June. Weather condition is favorable and yield may increase this year as compare to last year. Harvest is set to begin after September.

Department of agriculture has revised down pulses production estimate by 5.6 percent in the 3rd Adv Est. released on 13th May,2015. Inclement weather and un seasonal rainfall affected the pulses crop adversely. It has been revised down from 18.43 MMT (2nd Adv. Est) to 17.38 MMT.

Odisha government had set the production target of 0.587 MT of pulses in Kharif season. It includes 0.19 MT of Arhar, 0.15 MT of Mung and 0.176 MT of Biri. According to them pulses will be cultivated on about 0.965 million hectares with yield of 609 kg /Ha.

Maharashtra state govt. has removed the limit for oilseeds, edible oils and pulses on the recent recommendation by central govt. this week. The earlier limit for oilseeds and pulses were 200 tonne each under municipal limit and around 80 tonne elsewhere. It is being seen as a great relief for state trading community dealing with pulses and oilseeds. Despite removal of stock limit market may turn bullish as big traders may start cornering the stock to drag market in their own favor.

Tanzania Pulses Arrival at JNPT port (Mumbai) on 22nd April was 04 container of Tanzania Chana Dal, 96 container of Tanzania Green Mung, 2 containers of Tanzania Pigeon Peas.

India Continue Zero Import Duty on Pulses Till Oct.1, 2015. Government of India continue the zero import duty on pulses Till Oct.1,2015.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.
- **Australian Chickpea is currently being planted and should be finished in the end of June.** Weather condition is favorable and yield may increase this year as compare to last year. Harvest is set to begin after September. Demand and prices of Australian chickpeas increased due to crop failure in India. Australia exports around 95% of its chickpea crop where India, Bangladesh and UAE are its major export destination.
- **China for the second year in a row was net importer of Pulses.** According to the latest report compiled by STAT it imported 2.50 MMT of pulses in 2014 against 5.67 MMT in 2013. In 2014 it imported 8.17 MMT of pulses against export of 5.67 MMT. China was a net exporter of pulses until the 2013 calendar year. In 2012, China exported 3.67 MMT more pulses than it imported.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender for 1000 metric tonne (MT) of yellow split pea for May -June shipment.**
- **Field pea exports from France during the month of February** totaled 10,927 metric tons (MT) which is down by 19% from the 13,700 MT shipped in the month of January, and down 11% from the 12,470 MT shipped the same month last year. Shipments so far this season are down 36% at 83,555 MT. Most peas were shipped to European destinations, with Belgium the most important, followed by Switzerland and Italy. No field pea shipments were reported to Egypt or the Indian subcontinent.
