

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Concern over the rising prices of pulses, government of Rajasthan has imposed stock limit to retailers and wholesalers. Retailers can have 25 quintals of pulses and wholesalers can have 2500 quintals of pulses at a time. This decision will help the prices of pulses to stay low as supply will increase in the market and market players will not be able to hold large amount of stock.

Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 4.51 lakh hectares as on 19 June this year, around 4.39% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 4.32 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has increased the MSP of Urad, Moong and Tur to Rs 4625, Rs 4850 and Rs 4625 per quintal respectively, it includes Rs 200 bonus. With emerging short supply and shooting up prices government has offered bonus of Rs 200 per quintal to pulses farmers. It will encourage farmers to grow more pulses this year.

As major pulses growing belts have received good rainfall in recent week, sowing activity for pulses got momentum. Sowing of pulses commences in many states of India like Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Haryana, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Karnataka. As per traders/farmers feedback sowing of moong in Rajasthan may increase by 5% this year and area coverage for moong in Maharashtra and Gujarat could remain same as previous year. In Andhra Pradesh under better rainfall condition and prevailing higher price for Tur area coverage is expected to increase by 5-10% this year.

Government had shown interest to buy 22629 tonnes of pulses from NAFED and import huge amount of pulses from producing countries to control prices in domestic retail market. Government has decided to float tenders to import chana from Australia, yellow peas from Canada and other pulses from Myanmar. These steps may increase International pulses market as stocks in exporting countries are limited and new arrivals are expected to come August onwards.

Department of agriculture has revised down pulses production estimate by 5.6 percent in the 3rd Adv Est. released on 13th May, 2015. Inclement weather and unseasonal rainfall affected the pulses crop adversely. It has been revised down from 18.43 MMT (2nd Adv. Est) to 17.38 MMT.

Maharashtra state govt. has removed the limit for oilseeds, edible oils and pulses on the recent recommendation by central govt. this week. The earlier limit for oilseeds and pulses were 200 tonne each under municipal limit and around 80 tonne elsewhere. It is being seen as a great relief for state trading community dealing with pulses and oilseeds. Despite removal of stock limit market may turn bullish as big traders may start cornering the stock to drag market in their own favor.

India Continue Zero Import Duty on Pulses Till Oct.1, 2015. Government of India continue the zero import duty on pulses Till Oct.1,2015.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.
- **Australian Chickpea is currently being planted and should be finished in the end of June.** Weather condition is favorable and yield may increase this year as compare to last year. Harvest is set to begin after September. Demand and prices of Australian chickpeas increased due to crop failure in India. Australia exports around 95% of its chickpea crop where India, Bangladesh and UAE are its major export destination.

- **China for the second year in a row was net importer of Pulses.** According to the latest report compiled by STAT it imported 2.50 MMT of pulses in 2014 against 5.67 MMT in 2013. In 2014 it imported 8.17 MMT of pulses against export of 5.67 MMT. China was a net exporter of pulses until the 2013 calendar year. In 2012, China exported 3.67 MMT more pulses than it imported.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender for 1000 metric tonne (MT) of yellow split pea for May -June shipment.**
- **Field pea exports from France during the month of February** totaled 10,927 metric tons (MT) which is down by 19% from the 13,700 MT shipped in the month of January, and down 11% from the 12,470 MT shipped the same month last year. Shipments so far this season are down 36% at 83,555 MT. Most peas were shipped to European destinations, with Belgium the most important, followed by Switzerland and Italy. No field pea shipments were reported to Egypt or the Indian subcontinent.
